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CATEGORICAL EXCLUSION SUMMARY AND NOTIFICATION

Purpose

This memo documents for the project file the justification for granting a Categorical Exclusion.

Background

The City of North Little Rock, (Project No. 22-036), located in Pulaski County, is proposing the construction of a new bar screen and pump station to replace the existing Maumelle pump station and comminutor. The new pump station will pump screened wastewater with variable speed drives to the White Oak Bayou wastewater treatment facility in North Little Rock. Other included items include the installation of yard piping, manholes, generator, electrical and control systems needed to operate the pumps and bar screen, construction of two flow meter vaults, site grading, rehabilitation of an existing manhole, and rehabilitation of a 24" gravity interceptor via cured-in-place pipe technology. All work will take place in previously disturbed areas, and all property is already owned by North Little Rock Wastewater Utility.

This CE decision is exclusive to and only applies to Phase I of the proposed project, research, testing and possible planning and design actions, as needed. This CE does not include any other construction activities other than the installation of groundwater monitoring wells, as described above.

This project qualifies as a CE in that is an action relating to existing infrastructure systems (such as sewer systems; drinking water supply systems; and stormwater systems, including combined sewer overflow systems) that involve minor upgrading, or minor expansion of system capacity or rehabilitation (including functional replacement) of the existing system and system components (such as the sewer collection network and treatment system; the system to collect, treat, store and distribute drinking water; and stormwater systems, including combined sewer overflow systems) or construction of new minor ancillary facilities adjacent to or on the same property as existing facilities. This category does not include actions that: involve new or relocated discharges to surface or ground water; will likely result in the substantial increase in the volume or the loading of pollutant to the receiving water; will provide capacity to serve a population 30% greater than the existing population; are not supported by the state, or other regional growth plan or strategy; or directly or indirectly involve or relate to upgrading or extending infrastructure systems primarily for the purposes of future development.

No extraordinary circumstances found in 40 Code of Federal Regulations (CFR) §6.204 apply to this proposed action.
