## Arkansas Beef Council Accepting Research and Promotion Project Proposals

**LITTLE ROCK, AR** – The Arkansas Beef Council is accepting grant proposals for beef research and promotion projects. Research proposals must be submitted by April 25, 2025 and promotion proposals must be submitted by April 30, 2025.

Proposals should not exceed five pages and must:

- State the goals and objectives of the proposed project.
- State the expected benefits to the Arkansas beef industry from the proposed research or promotion.
- Include a budget and explain how the entity will be accountable for its use of the requested funds.
- Date(s) or duration of the proposed project- only projects that are executed during fiscal year 2026 (July 1, 2025-June 30, 2026) will be considered.
