**In the Matter of Joshua Harvey, DVM
License No. 3132**

Complaint No. 2025-37

CONSENT ORDER

The Arkansas Board of Animal Health (Board) and Joshua Harvey, DVM, (Licensee), in lieu of formal proceedings, enter the following Consent Order concerning his license to practice veterinary medicine in the State of Arkansas. The parties, being well and truly advised of the facts, relevant law, and their duty and rights under Arkansas law, agree as follows:

Findings of Fact

1. Licensee is a resident of Texas and is licensed to practice veterinary medicine in Arkansas, holding Certificate of License number 3132.
2. On October 21, 2025, the Texas Board of Veterinary Medical Examiners and Licensee entered an Agreed Order (Texas Order) after an investigation revealed that Licensee committed eleven (11) violations of Texas law related to the practice of veterinary medicine.
3. The terms of the Texas Order are as follows:
 - a. Licensee's Texas Veterinary License was suspended for five (5) years from July 1, 2025, with the suspension stayed after February 15, 2026, and thereafter, Licensee is placed on probation for the remainder of the suspension period;
 - b. Licensee was formally reprimanded by the Texas Board of Veterinary Medical Examiners;
 - c. Licensee was assessed an administrative penalty in the amount of \$150,000;
 - d. Licensee must complete fifteen (15) additional hours of continuing education within six (6) months of the date of the order; and

- e. Licensee must comply with all Texas laws and cooperate with the Texas Board of Veterinary Medical Examiners in any investigation of his compliance with the order.
4. On December 5, 2025, the Oklahoma State Board of Veterinary Medical Examiners and Licensee entered an Agreed Order (Oklahoma Order) in which it was determined that the Licensee's conduct outlined in the Texas Order would constitute violations of the Oklahoma Veterinary Practice Act.
 5. The terms of the Oklahoma Order are as follows:
 - a. Licensee's Oklahoma Veterinary License is suspended for six (6) months beginning on February 15, 2026, and thereafter Licensee is placed on probation for five (5) years from the effective date of the order;
 - b. Licensee was assessed an administrative fine in the amount of \$5,000 and probation fees totaling \$3,000;
 - c. Licensee must complete ten (10) additional hours of continuing education by December 31, 2026.
 6. Licensee has one (1) prior disciplinary action in Arkansas in which he entered a Consent Agreement with the Board's predecessor, the Arkansas Veterinary Medical Examining Board, on September 9, 2022, and agreed to pay a civil penalty in the amount of \$1,500 for failure to properly maintain patient records.

Conclusions of Law

7. The Board has authority to investigate conduct that violates the Arkansas Veterinary Medical Practice Act (Act) and Veterinary Medicine rules and to take disciplinary action against the license of a veterinarian. Ark. Code Ann. §§ 17-101-203 and 17-101-305.
8. Under Ark. Code Ann. § 17-101-305(a)(13), the Board may deny, suspend, or revoke the license of any veterinarian, or impose a civil penalty for revocation, suspension, surrender, or other disciplinary sanction of a license to practice veterinary medicine by

another state, territory, or district of the United States on grounds other than nonpayment of a registration fee or suspension of privileges by any other regulatory agency including the failure to report any such adverse action to the board within sixty (60) days of the final action.

9. Licensee has the right to a hearing before the Board on the alleged violations contained herein and before the Board takes action against Licensee for any violation of law, and Licensee waives his right to a hearing and accepts informal disposition of the matter by entering a Consent Order, as provided in Ark. Code Ann. § 25-15-208(b).


Terms of Disposition

10. By signing this Consent Order, Licensee acknowledges his rights under Arkansas law, understands that the Consent Order affects his license to practice veterinary medicine in Arkansas, and accepts the following conditions:

- a. Licensee was advised of his right to seek the advice of counsel prior to signing this Consent Order;
- b. Licensee acknowledges that he has the right under Ark. Code Ann. §§ 17-101-305, 25-15-208 and 25-15-211 to a formal hearing before any disciplinary action may be taken against his license, has the right under Ark. Code Ann. § 25-15-213(1) to be accompanied and advised by counsel at a hearing of this matter, and has the right under Ark. Code Ann. § 25-15-212 for judicial review of the Board's action following a hearing of this matter.
- c. Licensee waives the right to a formal hearing before the Board and judicial review of any decision by the Board;
- d. Licensee admits to the Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law contained herein and waives his right to contest such Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law and any disciplinary action imposed under this Consent Order;
- e. Licensee consents to suspension of his license to practice veterinary medicine in Arkansas for a period of two (2) years from the date of this Consent Order during which time he will not practice veterinary medicine in Arkansas.
- f. Licensee acknowledges that any violation of the terms of this Consent Order constitutes grounds for further disciplinary action, including revocation of his license.


WHEREFORE, the Arkansas Board of Animal Health and Joshua Harvey, DVM, enter this Consent Order in lieu of formal proceedings and agree to the suspension of Dr. Harvey's license to practice veterinary medicine in Arkansas for a period of two (2) years from the date of this Consent Order, which is effective on the date it is signed by the Chairman of the Arkansas Board of Animal Health.

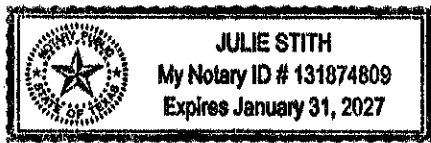
