2. Arkansas Plant Industries Division is authorized under the Warehouse Act to administer the Act and license Warehouses.
3. Warehouse Act requires a Warehouseman to post a bond. Instead of posting a Corporate Surety Bond, Warehouse is transferring, assigning, and pledging a Certificate of Deposit.
4. Warehouse assigns and negotiates all rights, title, and interest of the Warehouse in Certificate of Deposit number _____ in the amount of \$ _____ issued by _____

5. Warehouse grants to the Arkansas Plant Industries Division, Grain Warehouse Section a perfected security interest, lien, and title to the Certificate of Deposit.
6. Certificate of Deposit shall serve as collateral and security for any and all obligations (including but not limited to grain shortages) of the warehouse under the Warehouse Act.
7. Arkansas Plant Industries Division shall have the authority at any time to negotiate, renew, cash in, or transfer the Certificate of Deposit.
8. Prior notice of negotiation, transferring, or cashing the Certificate of Deposit is not necessary. However, the Plant Industries Division shall furnish written notice to the warehouse of any actions taken in regard to negotiating, cashing in, or transferring the Certificate of Deposit.
9. Warehouse shall have no rights to encumber, transfer, or negotiate the Certificate of Deposit.
10. The Certificate of deposit (and renewals of the Certificate of Deposit) shall remain pledged and transferred to the Arkansas Plant Industries Division until all obligations of the Warehouse have been satisfied under the Warehouse Act.
11. At maturity of the Certificate of Deposit, and if the principal of Certificate of Deposit is adequate to secure the bonding obligations of the Warehouse, the Warehouse shall receive (within a reasonable time) accrued interest on the Certificate of Deposit.
12. Certificate of Deposit shall be issued in a negotiable form and shall be issued to the order of the Arkansas Plant Industries Division, Grain Warehouse Section, Little Rock, Arkansas.
13. Acceptance of pledged Certificate of Deposit does not prevent the security from time to time to meet the obligations of the warehouse under the Warehouse Act.

COLUMN

2. Enter the total quantity of all grain received (including handling only grain).
3. Enter the total of all grain loaded out (including handling only grain).
4. Enter the inventory adjustments occasioned by shrink, drying, cleaning, etc. Supporting records, footnotes or other annotations must explain the reason for any adjustments.
5. Entry is derived by adding grain received (column 2), and subtracting load outs and adjustments (columns 3 and 4) from the previous day's balance.
6. Enter the total of un-receipted producer-owned open storage grain remaining in store in forwarded positions at the end of each business day.
7. Enter the total quantity of grain for which warehouse receipts were issued.
8. Enter the total quantity of grain for which warehouse receipts were canceled.
9. Entry is derived by adding warehouse receipts issued (column 7) and subtracting warehouse receipts canceled (column 8) from the previous day's balance.
10. Enter the total quantity of grain received and stored or handled for others on which warehouse receipts have not been issued. If receipts are canceled and the grain is not purchased by the warehouseman or shipped, include these quantities.
11. Entry should reflect any decrease in open storage liability through issuance of warehouse receipts (either local or terminal), purchases by the warehouseman, or delivery back to the depositor against the open storage account.
12. Entry is derived by adding the increase (column 1) and subtracting the decrease (column 11) from the previous day's balance.
13. Enter the total quantity of grain in the warehouse for which payment has been made. Entry is derived by adding the quantity of grain paid for today plus collateral warehouse receipts canceled and subtracting the quantity of warehouse-owned grain shipped and collateral warehouse receipts issued from the previous day's balance. Paid grain includes grain received into the warehouse on this date and unpaid accounts (i.e. Deferred Price, Priced Not Paid, etc.) for which payment was made.
14. Enter the total quantity of grain in the warehouse that has been purchased but payment has not been made. Entry is derived by adding the quantity of grain purchased today, but payment was not made (i.e. Deferred Price, Priced Not Paid, etc.) and subtracting the quantity of grain paid for that which was previously shown as unpaid from the previous day's balance.
15. Entry is derived by adding the paid (column 13) and unpaid (column 14).
16. Entry is derived by adding columns 9, 12 and 15. This total should equal the total of columns 5 and 6.

**** NOTES to columns 13, 14 and 15.**

These items relate only to grain actually received into or in the warehouse.

All company-owned shipments from the warehouse and grain used for issuance of collateral warehouse receipts shall be deducted from Paid (column 13). Collateral warehouse receipts should be added to column 9.

A warehouseman as the result of company-owned shipments or issuance of collateral warehouse receipts, may have a "red" or minus figure in "Paid" grain (column 13) but "Total" (column 15) Warehouse Owned should never reflect a "RED" or minus figure. If it does, the warehouseman is in an over-obligated or "short" position. This is a violation of the Agreement.
