Directions for Arkansas Owner-Shipper Statement (OSS)

The OSS is to be used to cross the Arkansas border with live animals in specific situations in lieu of an Interstate Certificate of Veterinary Inspections (ICVI).

The primary use of an OSS will be to move livestock from a farm outside of Arkansas to an approved livestock market in Arkansas. The form must be completely filled with the owner/shipper's information and the livestock market or buying station to which the livestock is moved. If the animals already have official ID, the official ID must be listed. If the livestock is going directly to a livestock market or buying station, and the owner/shipper is unable to read the ID, the livestock do not have ID, or the owner/shipper is unable to apply the ID, the ID will be read or applied at the livestock market or buying station.

To be official, tags must be an 840 tag or have the US shield on the tag. For more information on what constitutes official ID for each species, please contact the State Veterinarian at (501) 225-1598.
