CATEGORICAL EXCLUSION SUMMARY AND NOTIFICATION

Purpose

This memo documents for the project file the justification for granting a Categorical Exclusion.

Background

The City of Sparkman, (Project No. TBA), located in Dallas County, is proposing the Grand purchase of a backup generator for the Dalark Pumping Station (DPS) and the installation of upgraded water meters throughout the water service area. The purchase of the backup generator is urgent because loss of the pump station during power outages can lead to low or negative pressure in the water distribution system. Water quality risks posed by pressure loss necessitate boil water orders and other emergency situations regarding the water supply. The purchase and installation of new water meters, along with a modern meter reading and billing system, will provide accurate, real-time data on water usage, system performance, and potential issues such as leaks.

This project qualifies as a CE in that is an action relating to existing infrastructure systems (such as sewer systems; drinking water supply systems; and stormwater systems, including combined sewer overflow systems) that involve minor upgrading, or minor expansion of system capacity or rehabilitation (including functional replacement) of the existing system and system components (such as the sewer collection network and treatment system; the system to collect, treat, store and distribute drinking water; and stormwater systems, including combined sewer overflow systems) or construction of new minor ancillary facilities adjacent to or on the same property as existing facilities. This category does not include actions that: involve new or relocated discharges to surface or ground water; will likely result in the substantial increase in the volume or the loading of pollutant to the receiving water; will provide capacity to serve a population 30% greater than the existing population; are not supported by the state, or other regional growth plan or strategy; or directly or indirectly involve or relate to upgrading or extending infrastructure systems primarily for the purposes of future development.

No extraordinary circumstances found in 40 Code of Federal Regulations (CFR) §6.204 apply to this proposed action.
