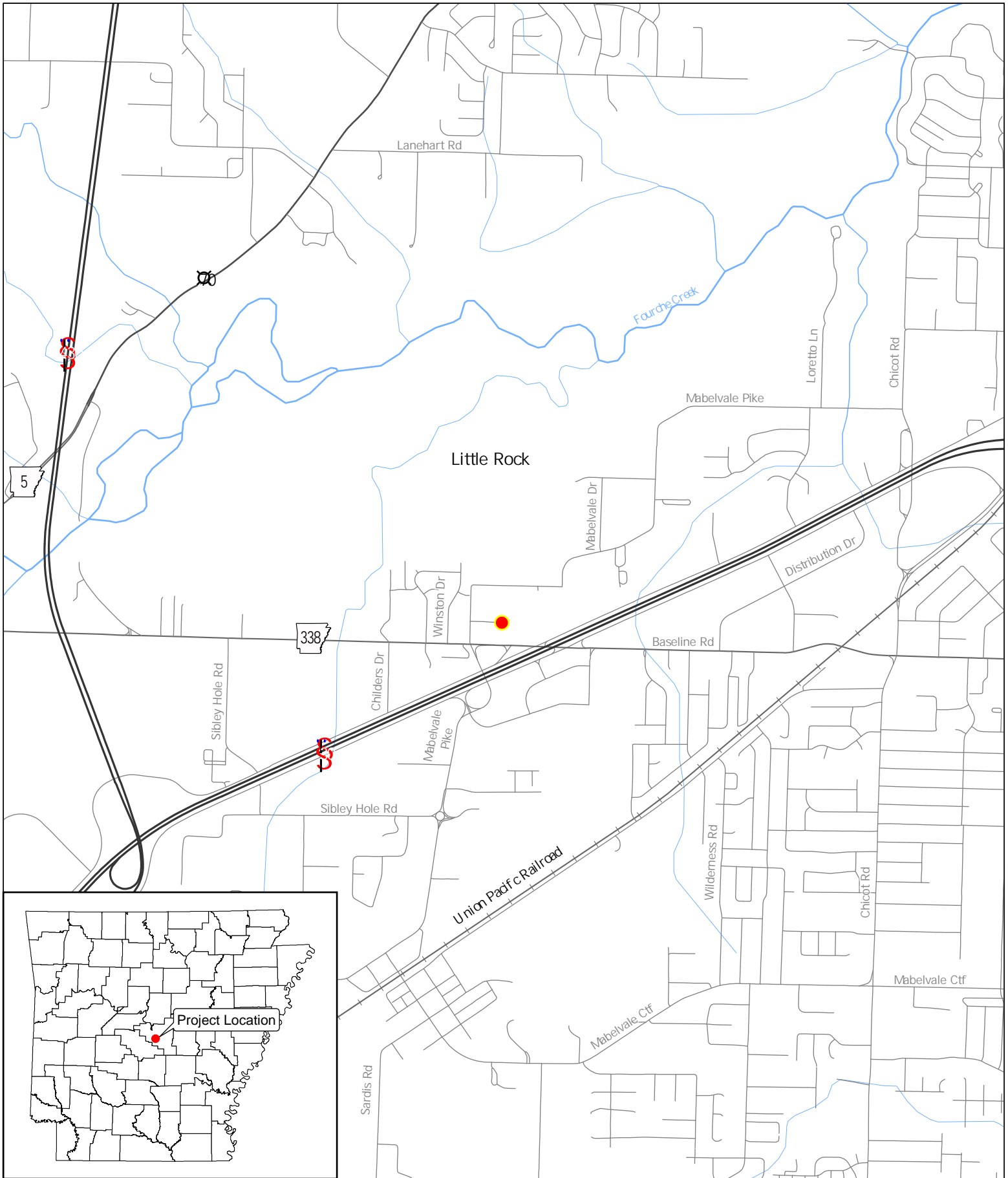
The purpose of the project is to remove the existing brick façade and treat the underlying surface of the ARDOT Central Office Administration Building in Little Rock.

After appropriate environmental review it has been determined that the subject project will not affect any natural resources. The Central Office Administration Building is eligible for inclusion in the National Register of Historic Places (NRHP). The building has been photo-documented and will be laser-scanned prior to work beginning. The project requires no federal funds or permits; therefore, it is not considered an undertaking under Section 106 of the National Historic Preservation Act. The cultural resources review memo is attached. The job is exempt from Section 7 of the Endangered Species Act as there is no federal nexus for this project. Waters of the United States will not be impacted by this project; therefore, a Section 404 permit will not be required.

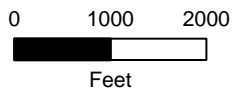

The Arkansas Department of Transportation (ARDOT) proposes to modify the ARDOT Central Office Administration Building located at 10324 Interstate 30 in Little Rock, Pulaski County, Arkansas. These modifications will include the removal of the existing brick facade and treatment of the underlying surface. The Central Office Building has been determined as eligible for inclusion in the National Register of Historic Places. The headquarters includes three other contributing buildings: the Annex Building, the Planning Building, and the Facilities Management Building. Other buildings on the campus are non-contributing.

The modifications will compromise the integrity of materials, design, and workmanship of the Central Office Building. It should still retain the original location, setting, and feeling of a mid-century building. All work will occur in previously disturbed areas and will involve no new ground disturbances. The building has been photo-documented and will be laser-scanned prior to work beginning.

This project requires no federal funds or permits; therefore, it is not considered an undertaking under Section 106 of the National Historic Preservation Act. This review and data collection are being completed to document the project and building as a good-faith effort. No further Section 106 work is required.
