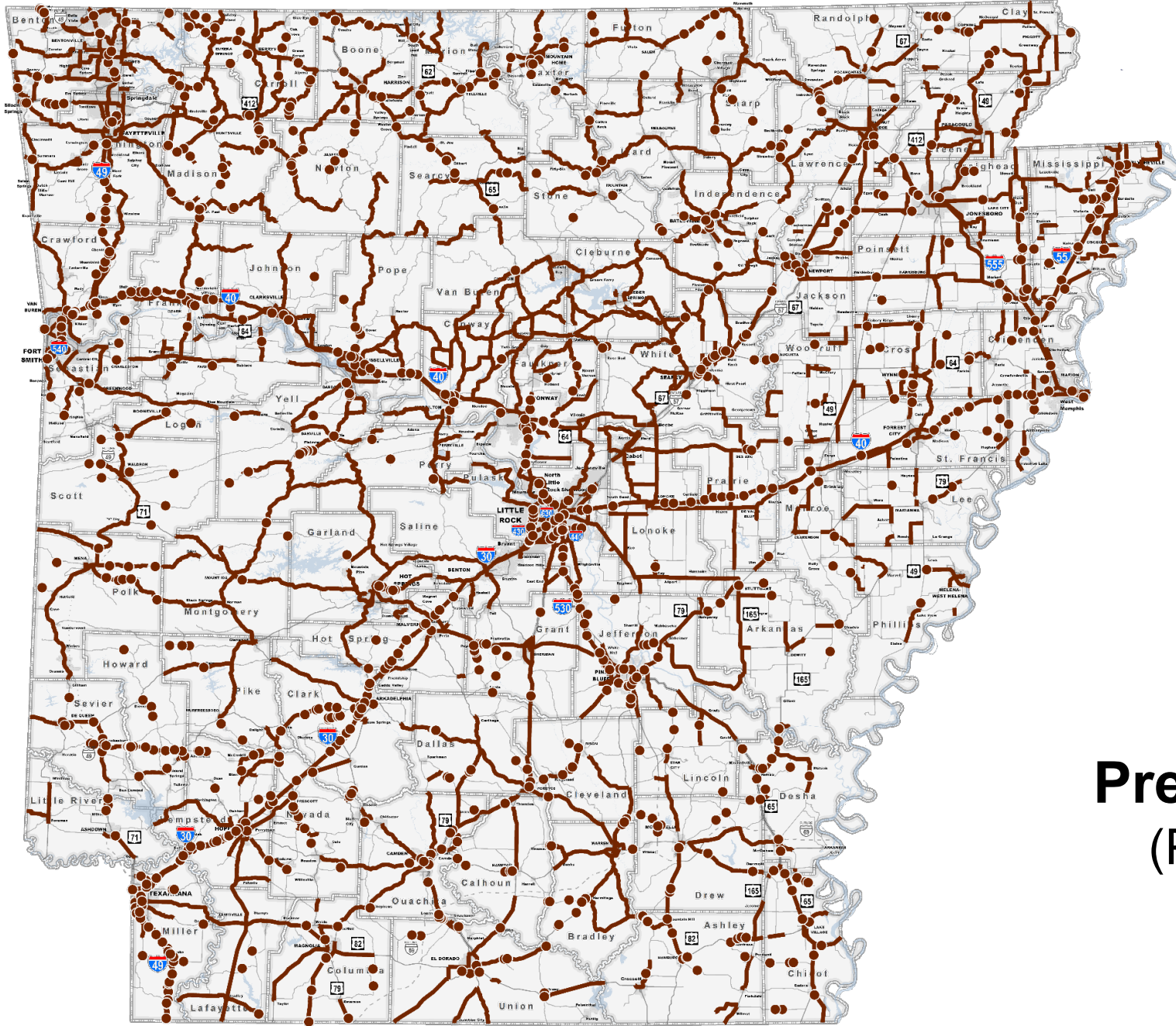




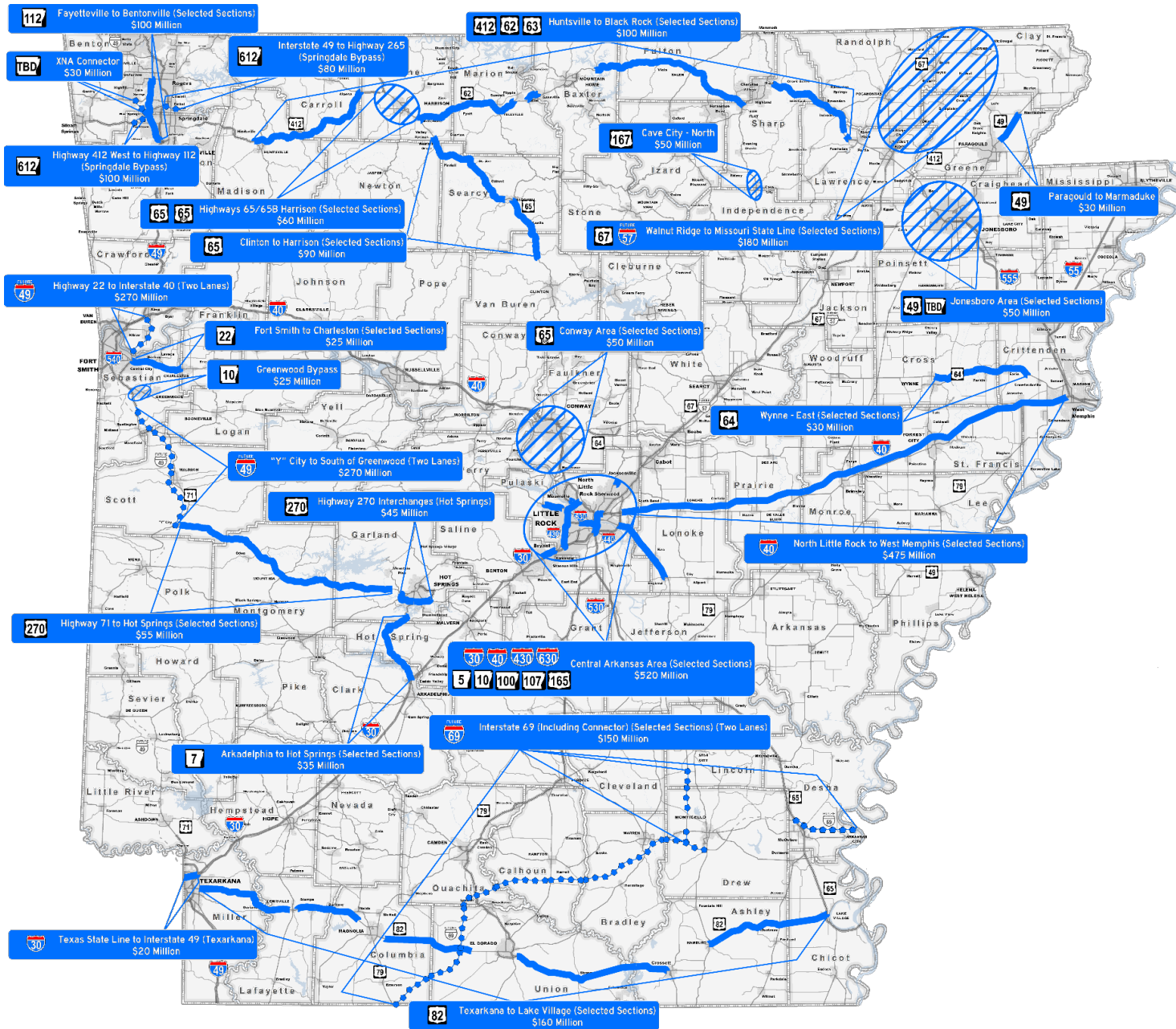
ISSUE 1

- July 2023

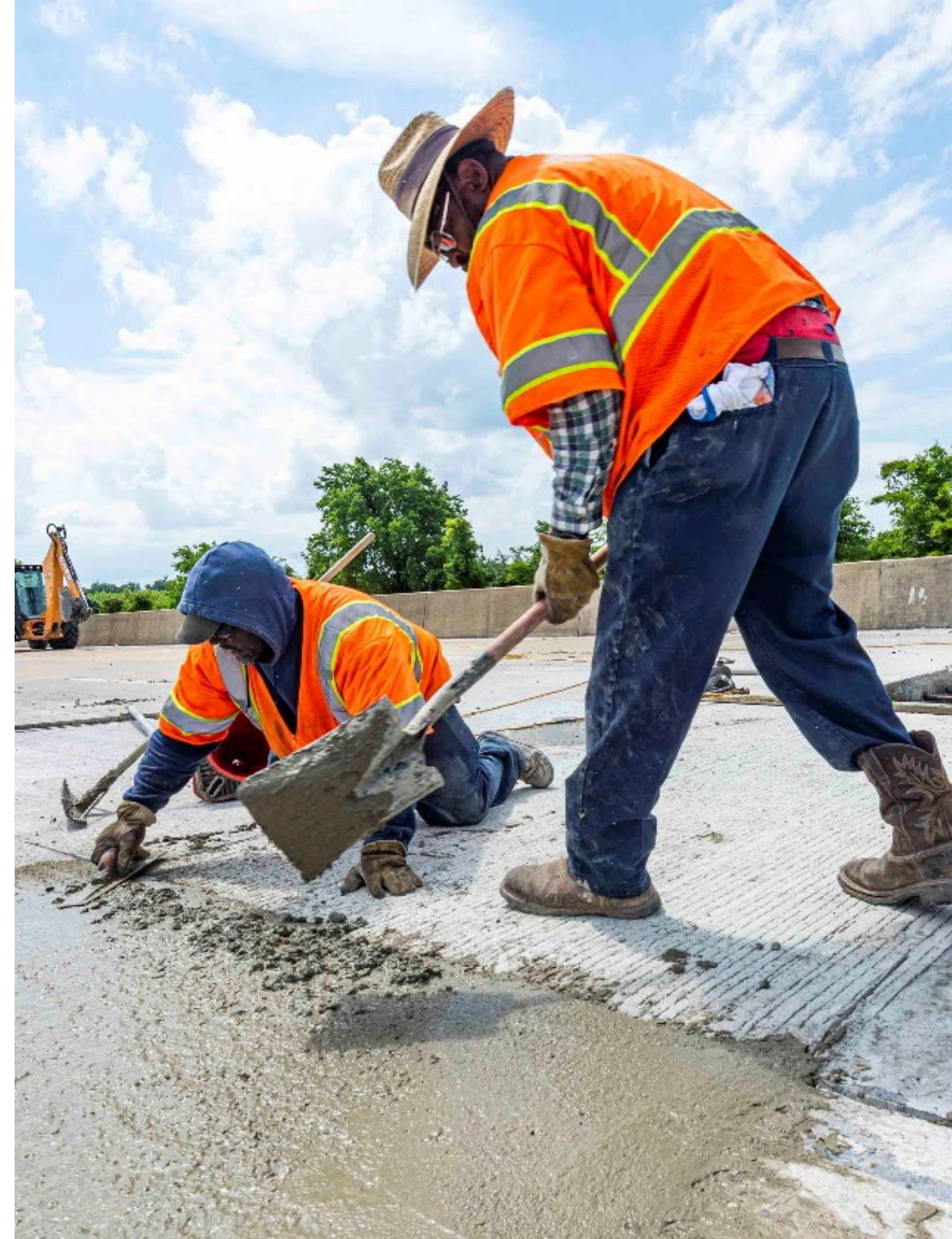

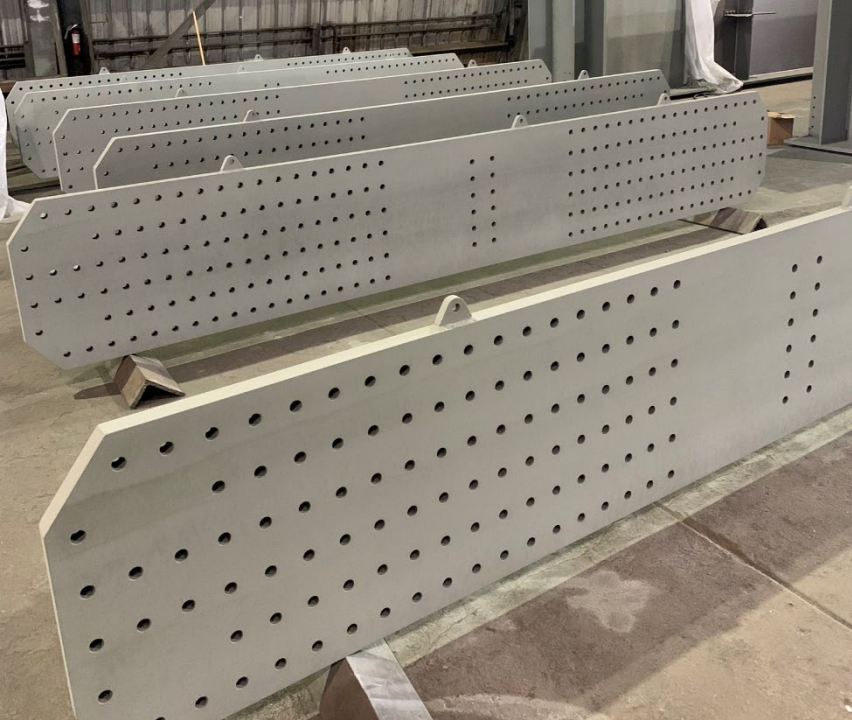

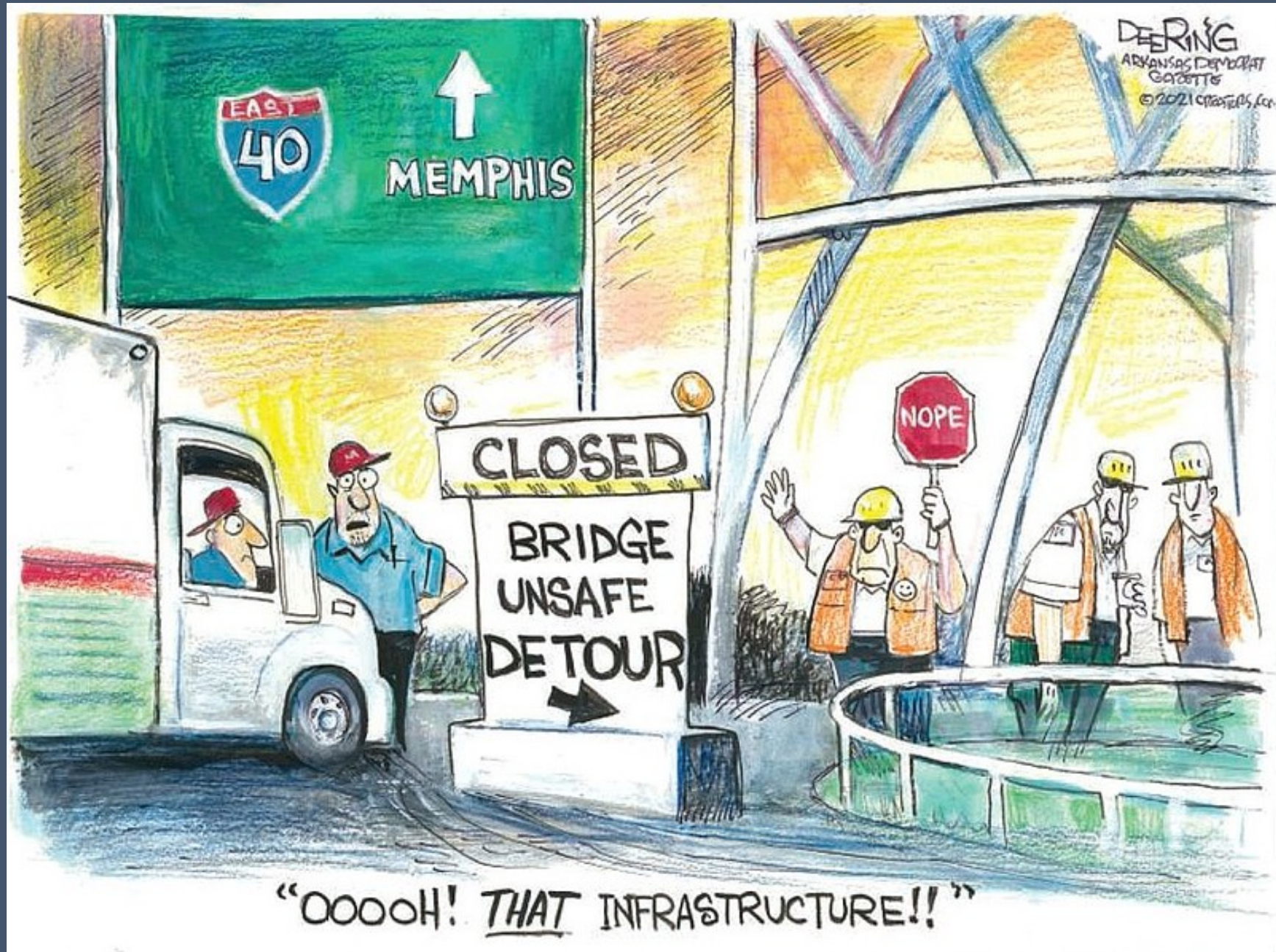

Federal Funding for Transportation

INFRASTRUCTURE INVESTMENT AND JOBS ACT - IIJA

- Passed out of the U.S. Senate
- Currently under consideration by the U.S. House
- \$304 billion for roads, bridges and safety
- Totals just under \$1 trillion over 5-years
- Arkansas' share is \$3.6 billion over 5-years
- 37 calendar days remain in current fiscal year
