# Jail Inmate Litter Pick-up Program

- Task force formed in 2003 to seek new strategies to combat roadside litter.
- Highway Commission passed Minute Order 2007-075 for a pilot program in May 2007.
- 13 Counties agreed to participate in pilot program with pay of \$2.00/hour.
- That pay is a means to reimburse a county for providing security and transportation to the inmates.



# Our Responsibilities



- Provide signs and supports for placement in the vicinity of roadside litter pick-up activities, safety vests, trash bags and collection & disposal.
- ARDOT retains the right to perform reasonable audits of the activities and reimbursements of the Jail-Inmate Litter Pick-up Program and to examine all records of the county relating to the program.

# County Responsibilities

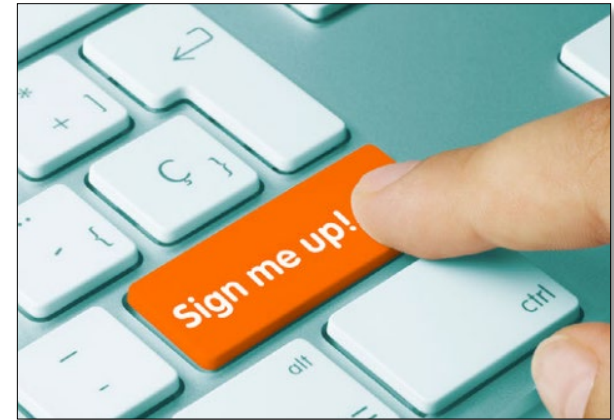
- On-Site oversight & supervision of jail inmate crew (unless work-release or community service inmates).
- Coordinate daily litter pick-up activities with ARDOT
- Maintain and submit documentation relative to reimbursement requests.
- The needs of the inmates and the security & protection of the public.



# How to Participate

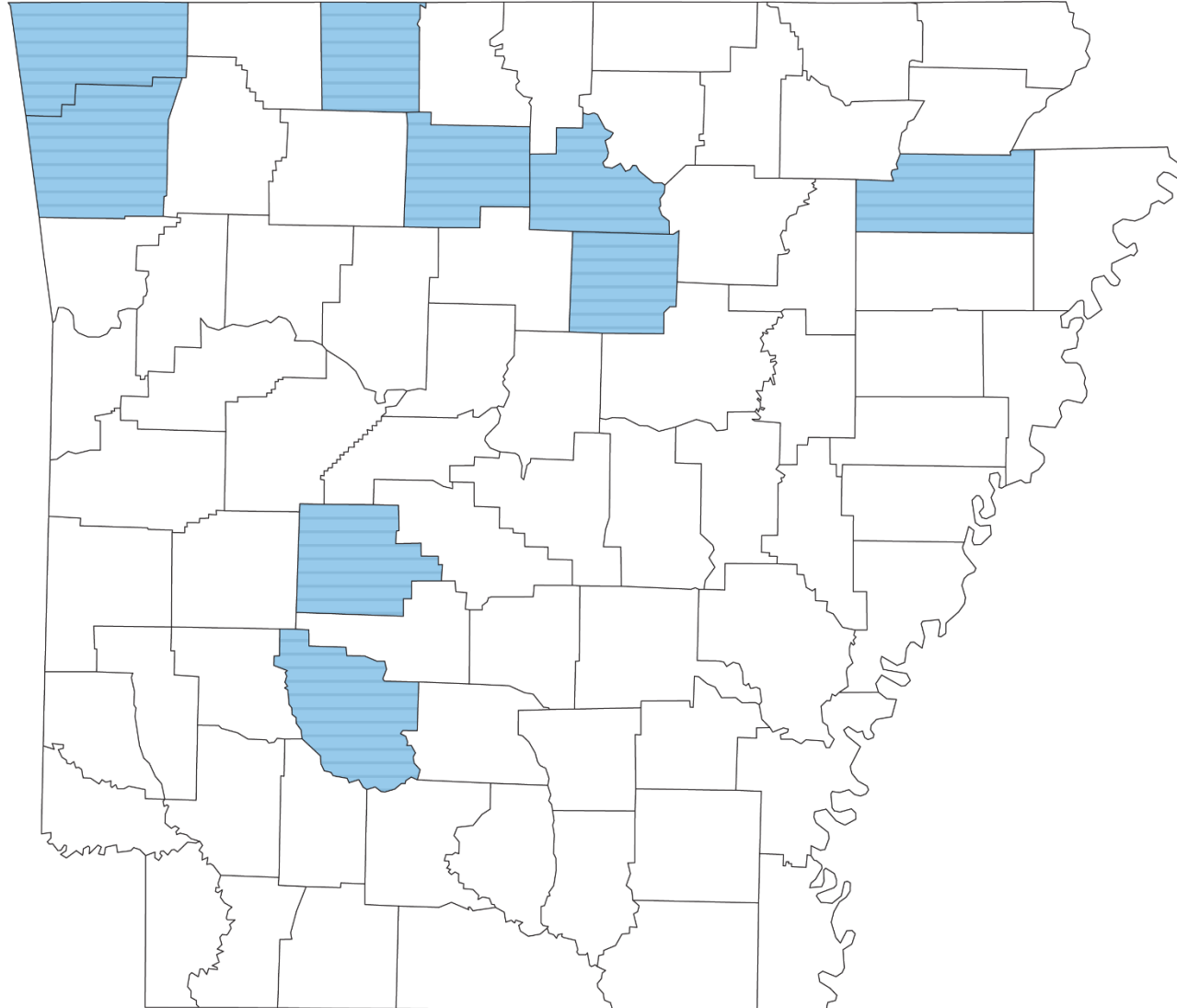
1. County Sheriff or Judge contacts ARDOT
2. County Official meets with District Engineer
3. District Engineer provides paperwork
  - a) Agreement
  - b) Sample Resolution
  - c) Labor Time Record Form
  - d) Reimbursement Request Form

**Bargain!**

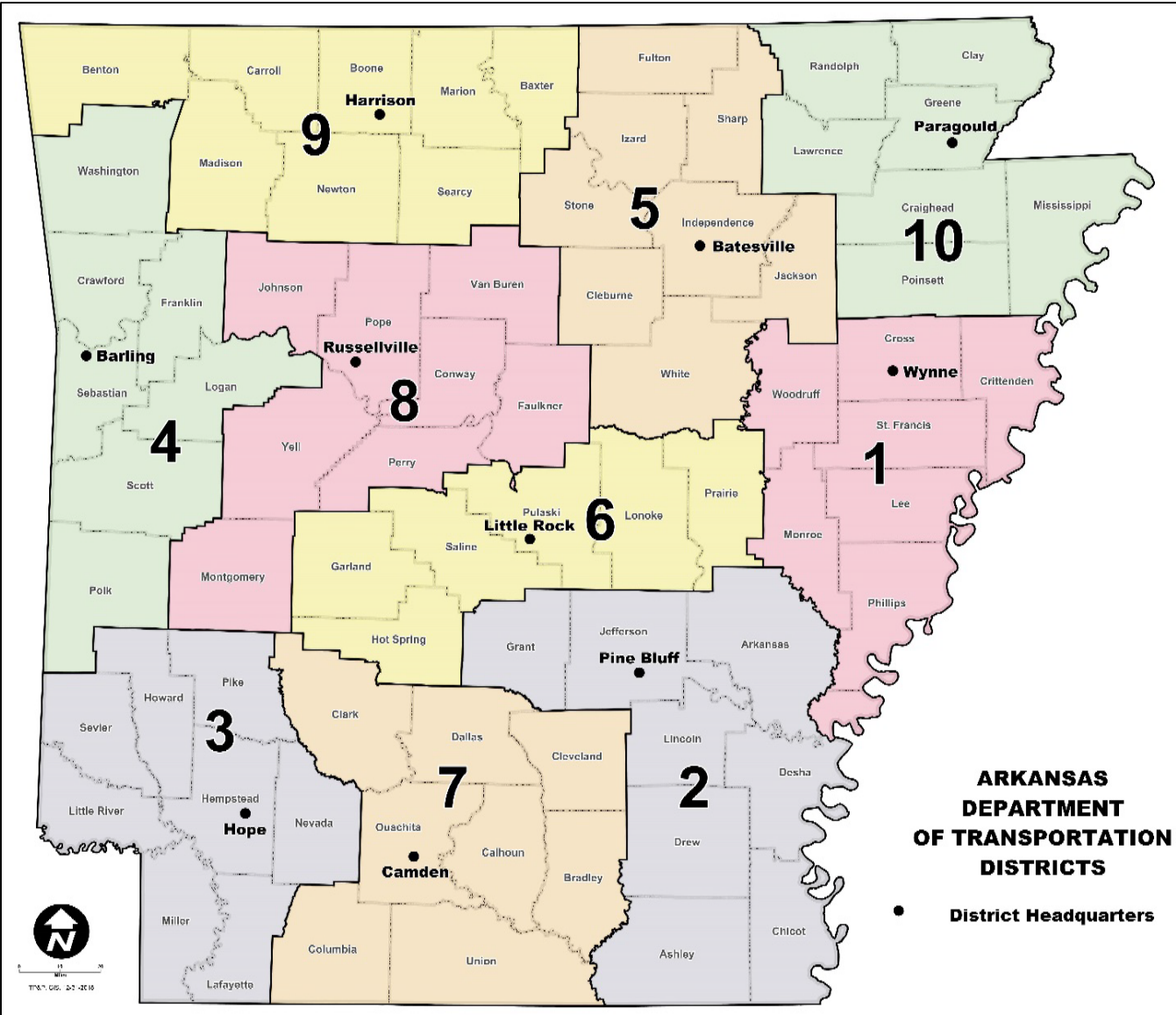


4. After Resolution & Agreement signed by County Official, sent to ARDOT Director for signature.
5. After Director signature, Agreement distributed to County Officials, the District Engineer and the ARDOT Assistant Chief Engineer – Operations.
6. To request reimbursement, the County submits the Reimbursement Request Form to the ARDOT Area Maintenance Supervisor.

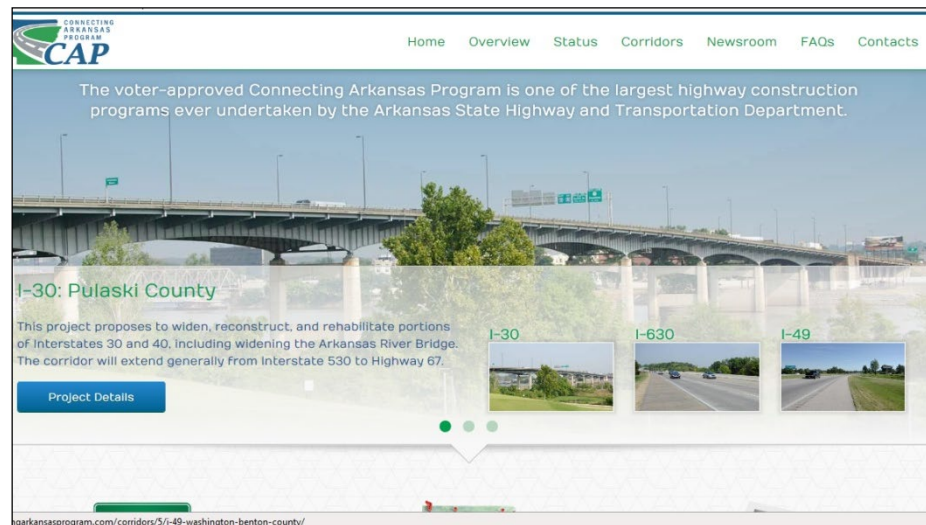
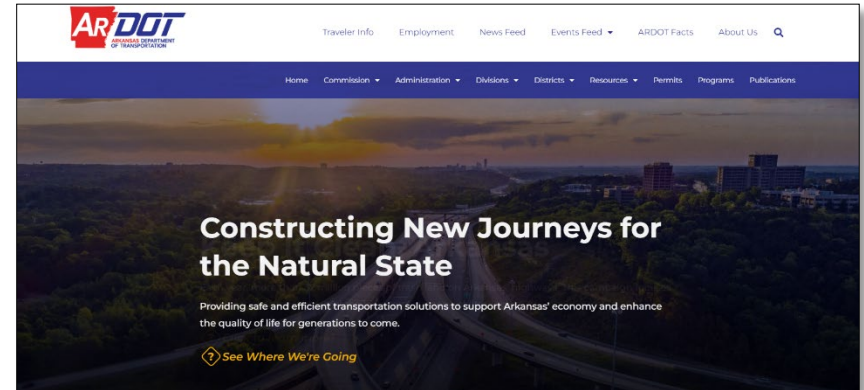
