

**REQUEST FOR LETTERS OF INTEREST FOR ALTERNATIVE DELIVERY SERVICES (2027)  
QUESTIONS AND CLARIFICATIONS**

**Question:**

Has ARDOT determined how many contracts will be awarded from this procurement?

**Response:**

At this time, there is not a predetermined or fixed number of firms that will be selected. The final number will depend on the needs identified during the evaluation process. For reference, the Department selected three firms during the previous procurement.

**Question:**

Could you please provide further clarification on the evaluation criterion regarding “experience with projects of a similar nature to those advertised”? Specifically, does this refer to the RFPs currently posted on the ARDOT website?

**Response:**

No. "Experience with projects of a similar nature to those advertised" refers to a proposer's demonstrated experience performing services comparable to those identified in the General Scope of Services. This may include work with state DOTs, local agencies, or other public entities involving Alternative Delivery.

**Question:**

For proposers who do not have prior experience working with the Department, could you clarify how their submissions will be evaluated and scored?

**Response:**

Please share experience your firm has with other agencies. ARDOT will check the references provided.

**Question:**

In the RFLOI for On-Call Alternative Delivery Services 2027, the Submission Instructions state that a “Certification of adherence to applicable State Laws” is required for inclusion with our response. However, the link to that form seems to not be working. Can you provide an updated link to the form or the form itself?

**Question:**

Will the Contract and Grant Disclosure Certification Form and the Certification of adherence to applicable State Laws count toward the 30 pages?

**Response:**

Yes, the forms are included in the 30-page limit.

**Question:**

Do we need to include relevant project experience in the body of the LOI and in the SF330?

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**Response:**

Project experience should be detailed in the SF330s.

**Question:**

Do we need to provide all services listed in Section 1. General Scope of Services, or can we submit on certain services?

**Response:**

Firms should submit services that can be provided through your firm or subconsultant partners.

**Question:**

Is the Alternative Delivery on-call for DOT projects alone, or does it also apply to supporting local municipalities who are interested in Alternative Delivery methods of delivery?

**Response:**

The On-Call Alternative Delivery solicitation is for ARDOT projects alone.

**Question:**

What is ARDOT's expectation for subconsultants? Should we partner with a contractor, surveyor, Geotech, or ROW firm?

**Response:**

ARDOT does not require firms to include subconsultants for this advertisement. Teams should be structured based on the firm's approach to delivering the services identified in the General Scope of Services.
