



ARKANSAS DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION REQUEST FOR LETTERS OF INTEREST ON-CALL ALTERNATIVE DELIVERY SERVICES 2027

Notice is hereby given that the Arkansas Department of Transportation (ARDOT) is seeking Letters of Interest from qualified entities to provide Alternative Delivery Services on an as-needed basis for a term of three (3) years with the option to extend.

1. GENERAL SCOPE OF SERVICES

The selected firm(s) will provide alternative delivery services that may include, but are not limited to:

- Supporting and supplementing the Department's Alternative Project Delivery Division staff in project and program management activities
- Risk assessment and management
- National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA) and permitting support
- Contract document development
- Procurement process development
- Project controls
- Constructability services

2. SUBMISSION INSTRUCTIONS

Submissions must be received in PDF format no later than **4:00 p.m. on May 19, 2026**. Late submissions will not be considered. Responses must be emailed to ConsultantContracts@ardot.gov subject line "**ALTERNATIVE DELIVERY 2027.**" To be given further consideration, responses to this solicitation must include:

- A one-page cover letter with primary contact information addressed to:
 - **Jessie Jones, Chief Engineer – Preconstruction.**
- A description of relevant experience with similar projects or services.
- Demonstration of a clear understanding of the service requirements.
- Approach and methodology for delivering the proposed services.
- References, recommendations, or testimonials, if available, including contact information.
- Completed forms, including:
 - [Architect-Engineer Qualifications Standard Form \(SF\) 330 Parts I and II](#). SF330 forms shall be provided for key personnel proposed to work on the project and will be counted toward the total page limit for the submittal. Accordingly, respondents should limit submissions to personnel who are critical to the project.

Submissions should be concise and focus on the firm's approach, key personnel, and relevant alternative delivery experience. Only personnel with direct roles should be listed in SF330. Submissions of fewer than



30 total pages are strongly encouraged. The font size shall be no smaller than size 11, and all pages must be formatted as 8 1/2" x 11".
