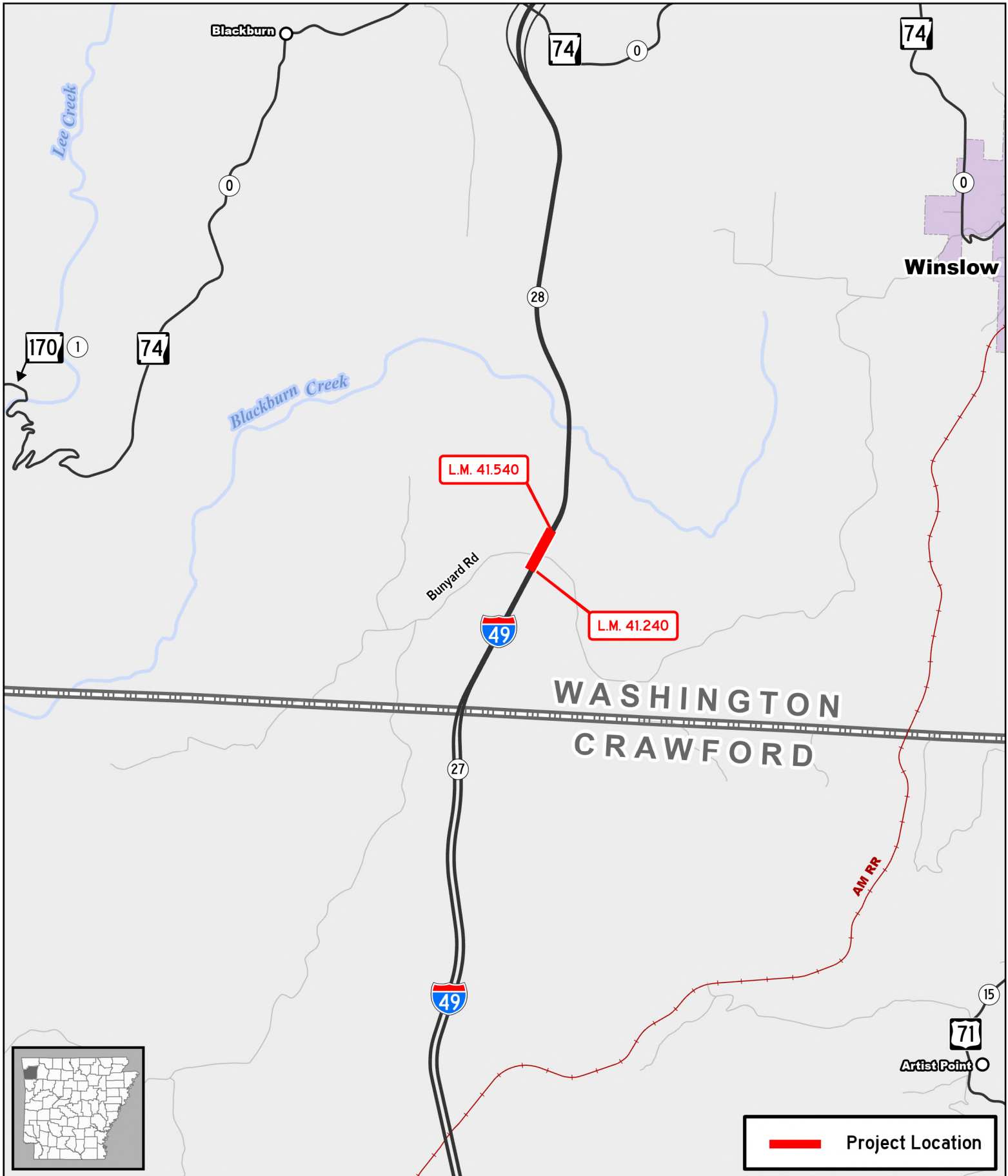

The purpose of this project is to add longitudinal grooving to the travel lanes in the Bobby Hopper tunnel on I-49 in Washington County in order to improve friction and increase safety.

After appropriate environmental review it has been determined that the subject job would not involve any relocations, impacts to underground storage tanks, hazardous materials, public water supplies, wellhead protection areas, floodplains, wetlands, or streams. A Section 404 permit is not required.

The project is exempt from Section 106 review and Section 7 of the Endangered Species Act, as there is no federal nexus for this project.
