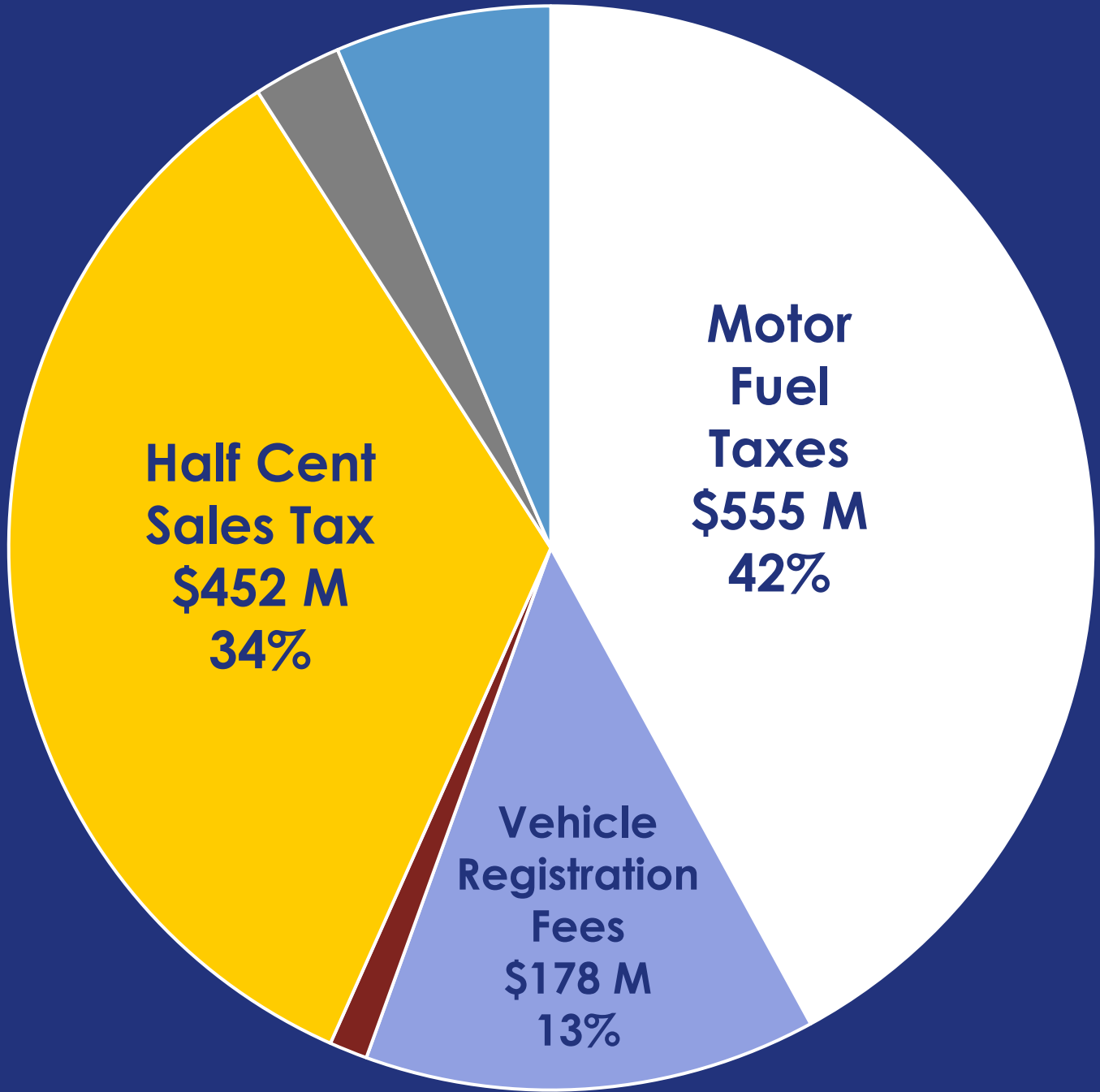

Average for State Fiscal Years 2027-2028**



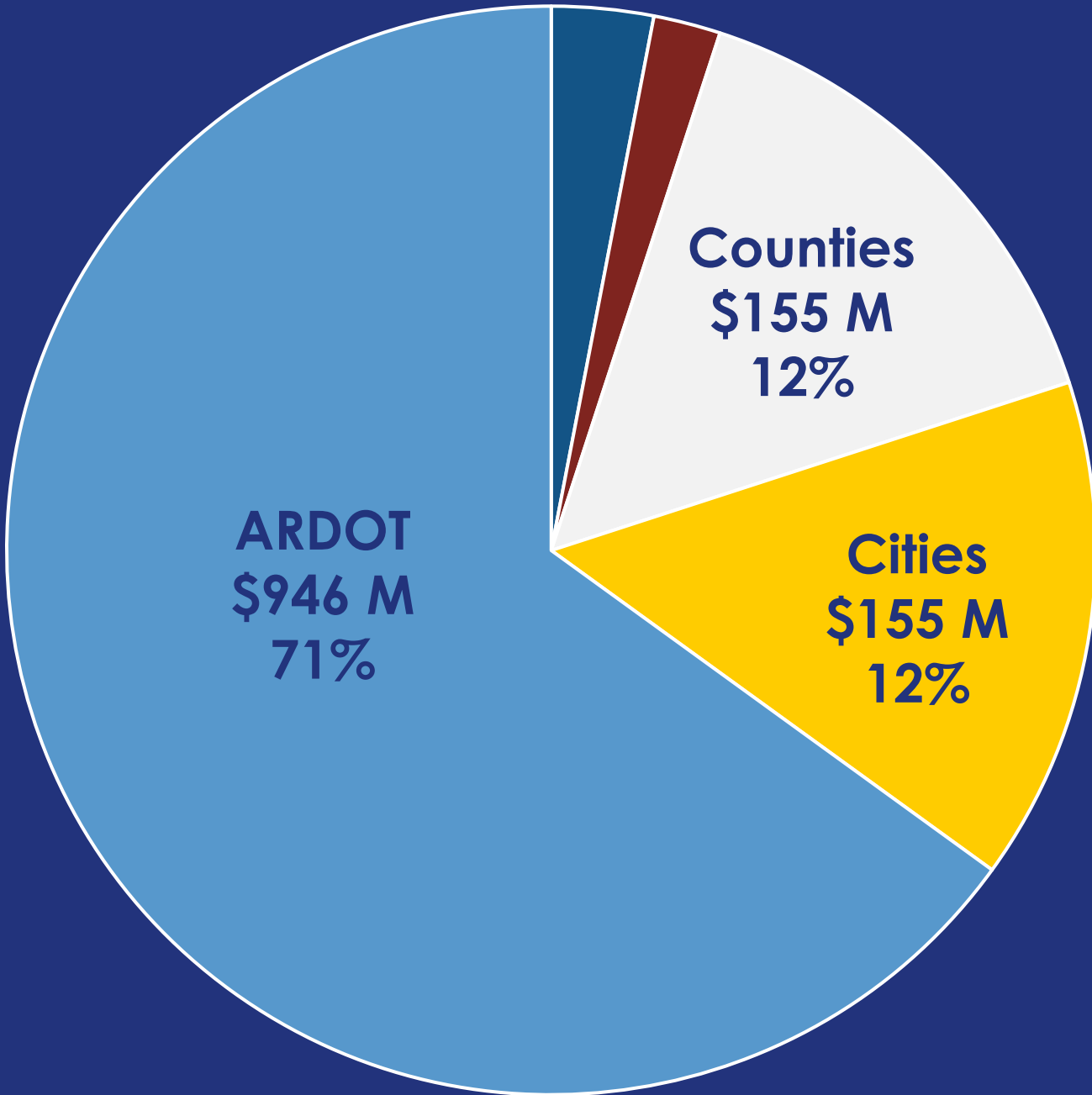

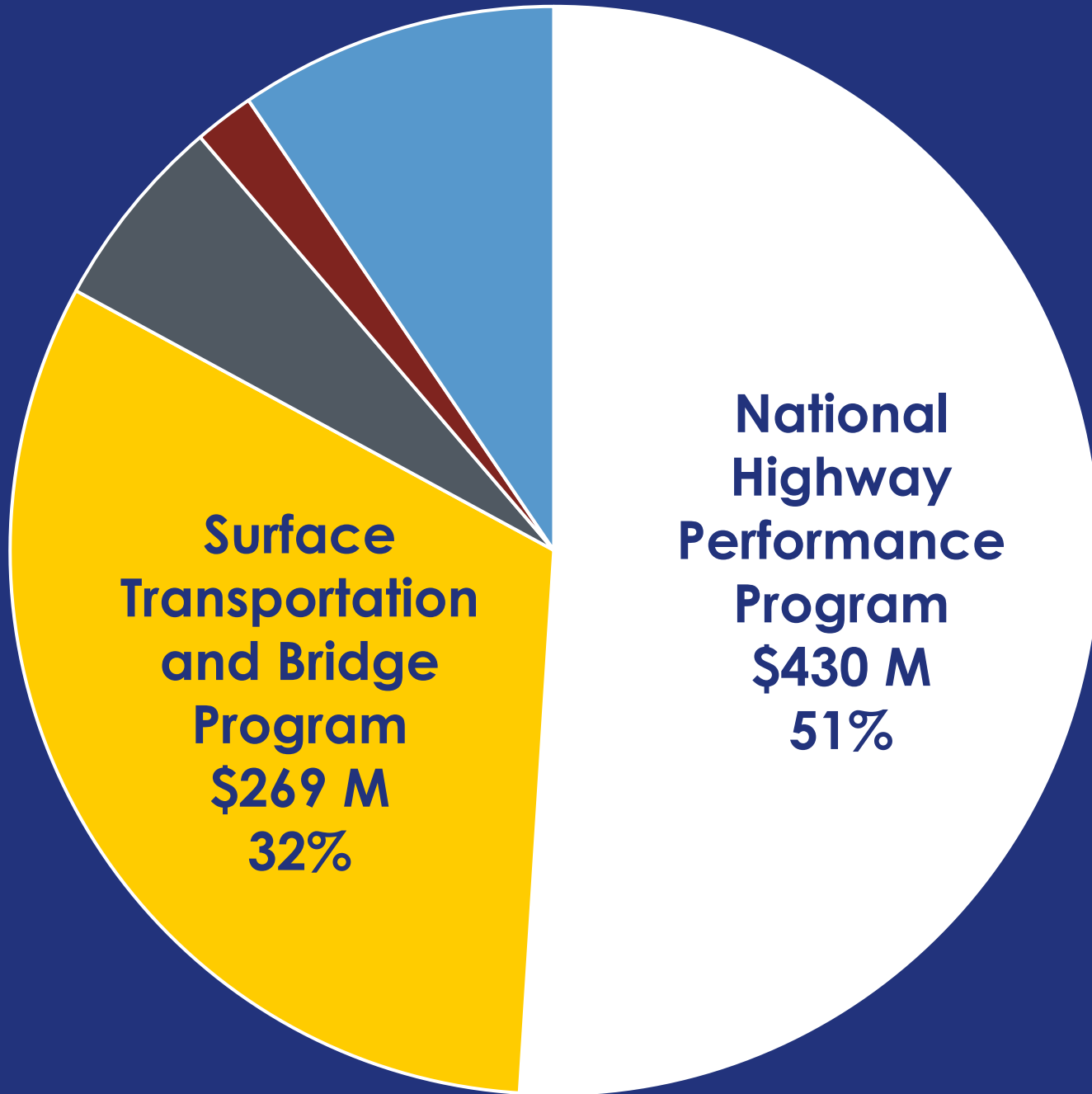

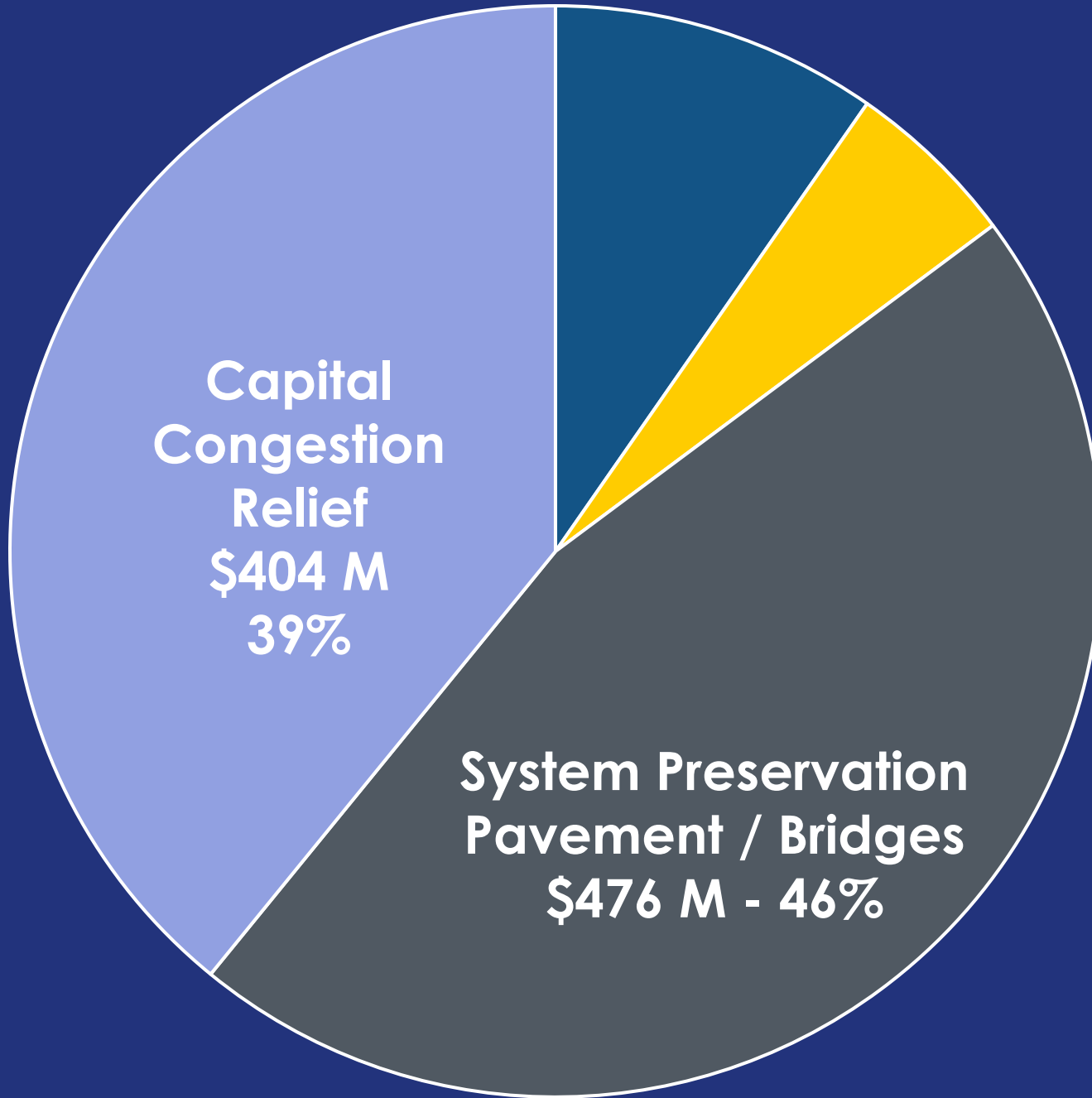

## WASHINGTON COUNTY

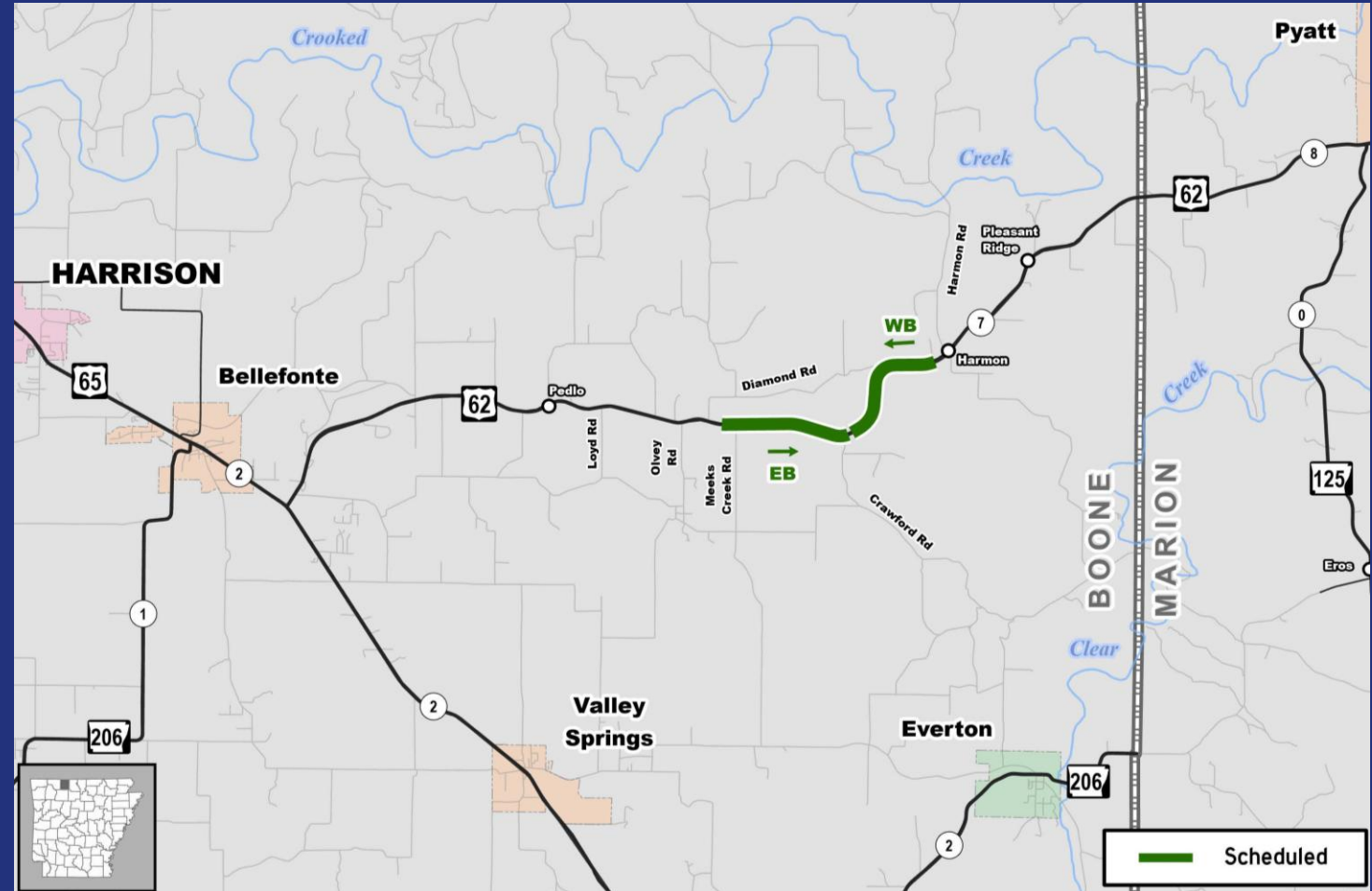


- **Objective:** Widen 1 mile of Hwy. 112

## BOONE COUNTY

- **Objective:** Construct 2 miles of passing lanes along Hwy. 62
- **Estimated Cost:** \$20-30M
- **Timeline:** Shovel ready in mid-2025



# HIGHWAY 82

## COLUMBIA COUNTY



- **Objective:** Replace UPRR underpass with an overpass on new location
- **Estimated Cost:** \$30-40M
- **Timeline:** Shovel ready in late 2025
