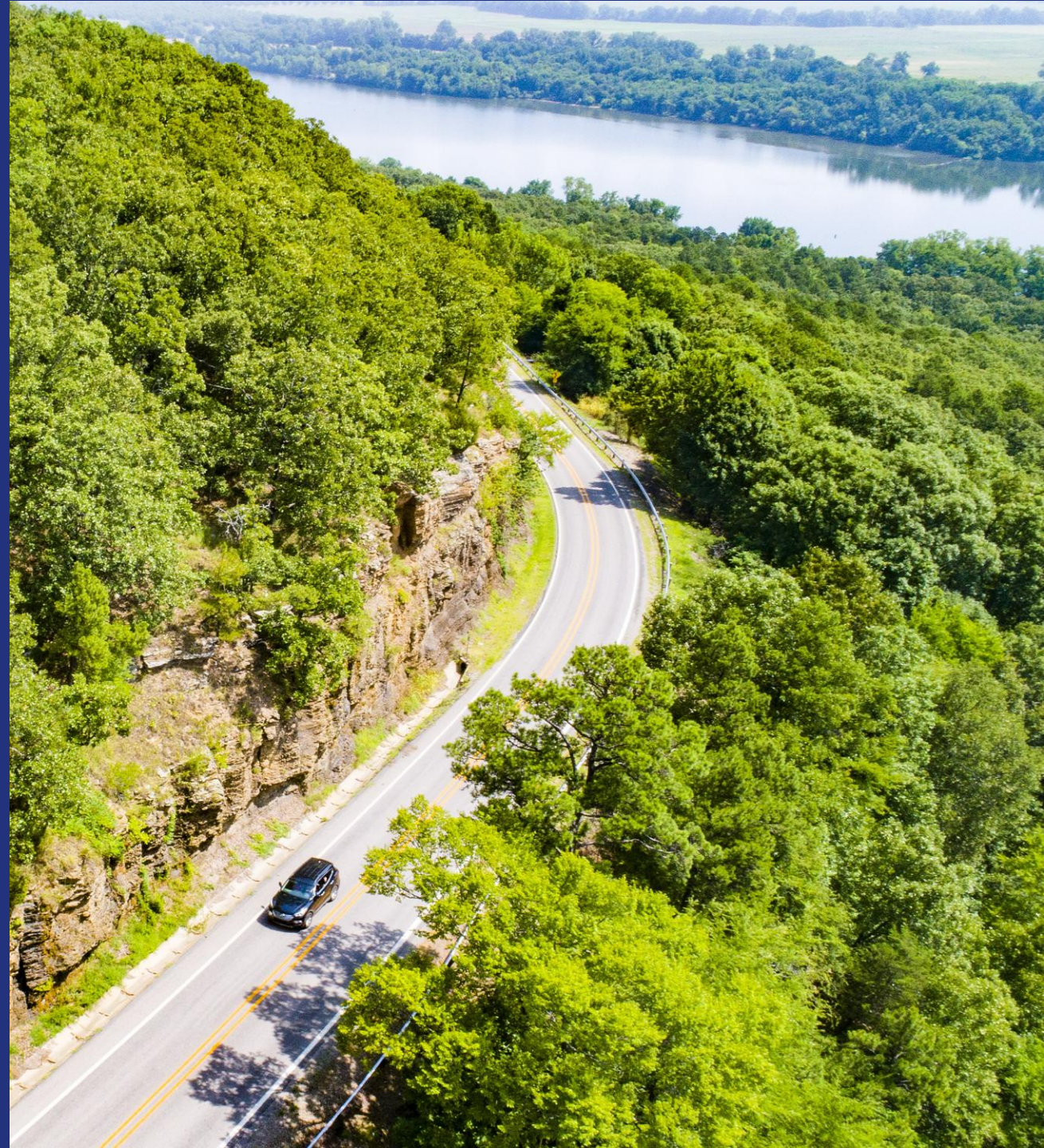

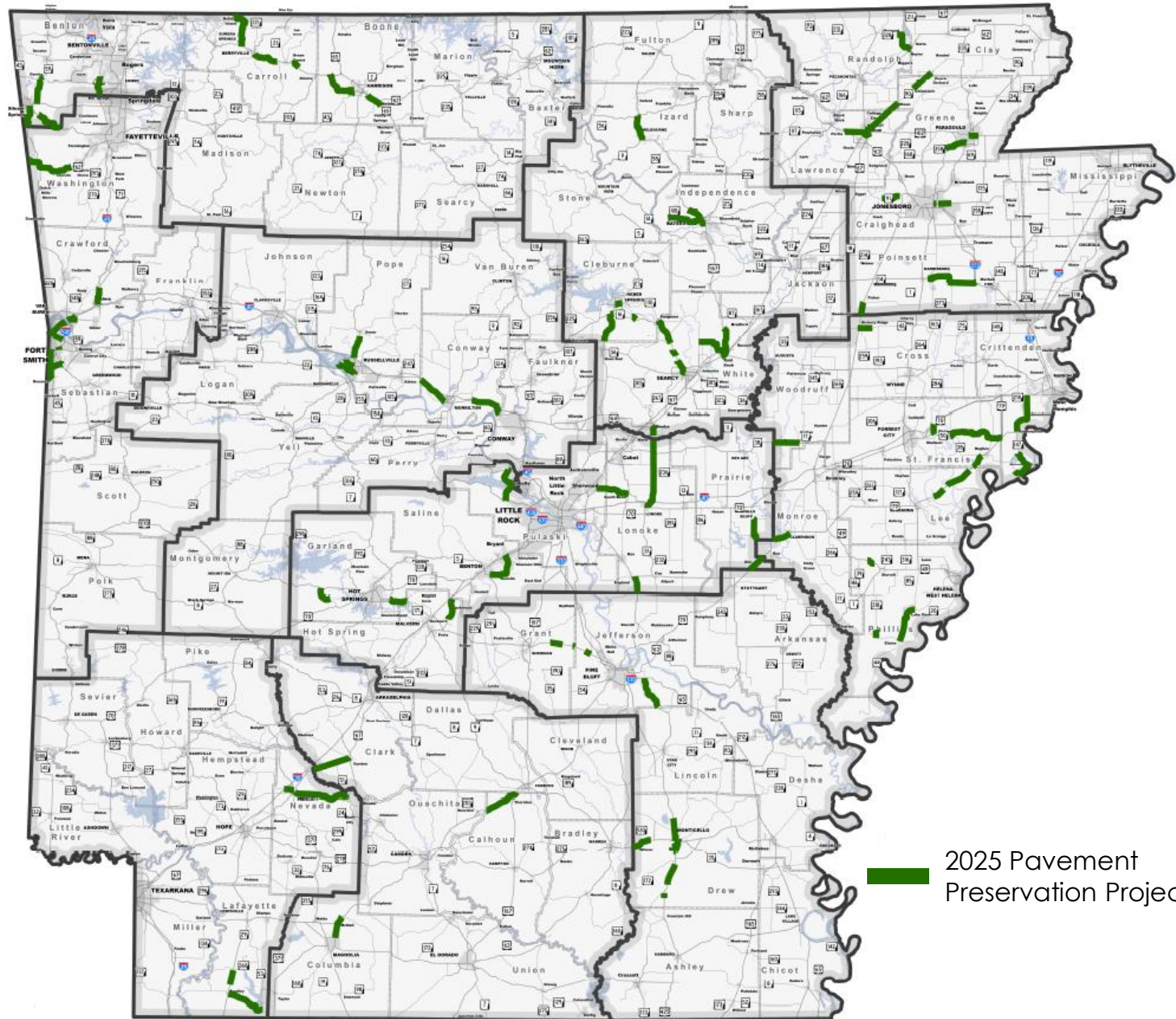

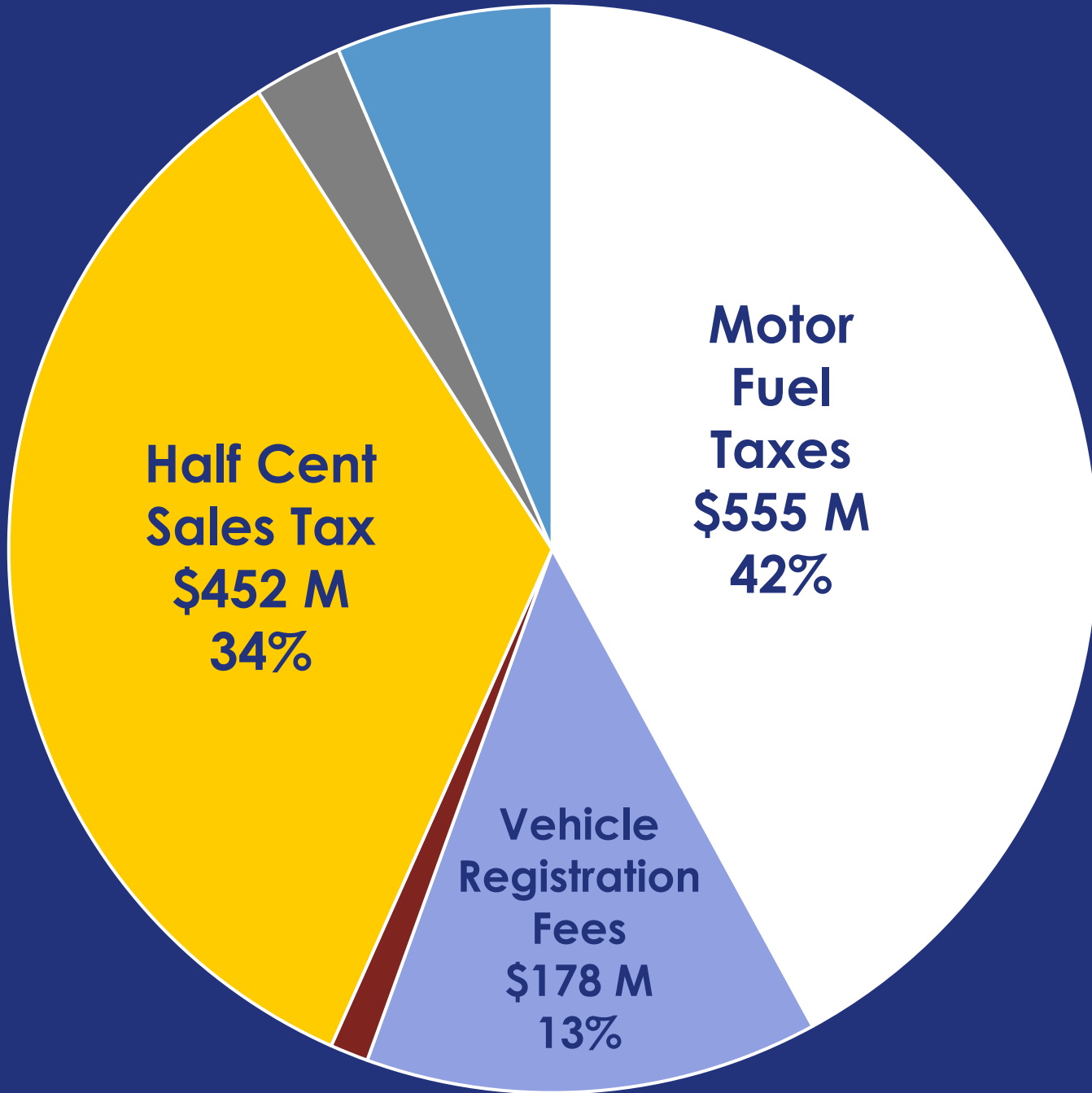

Average for State Fiscal Years 2027-2028**



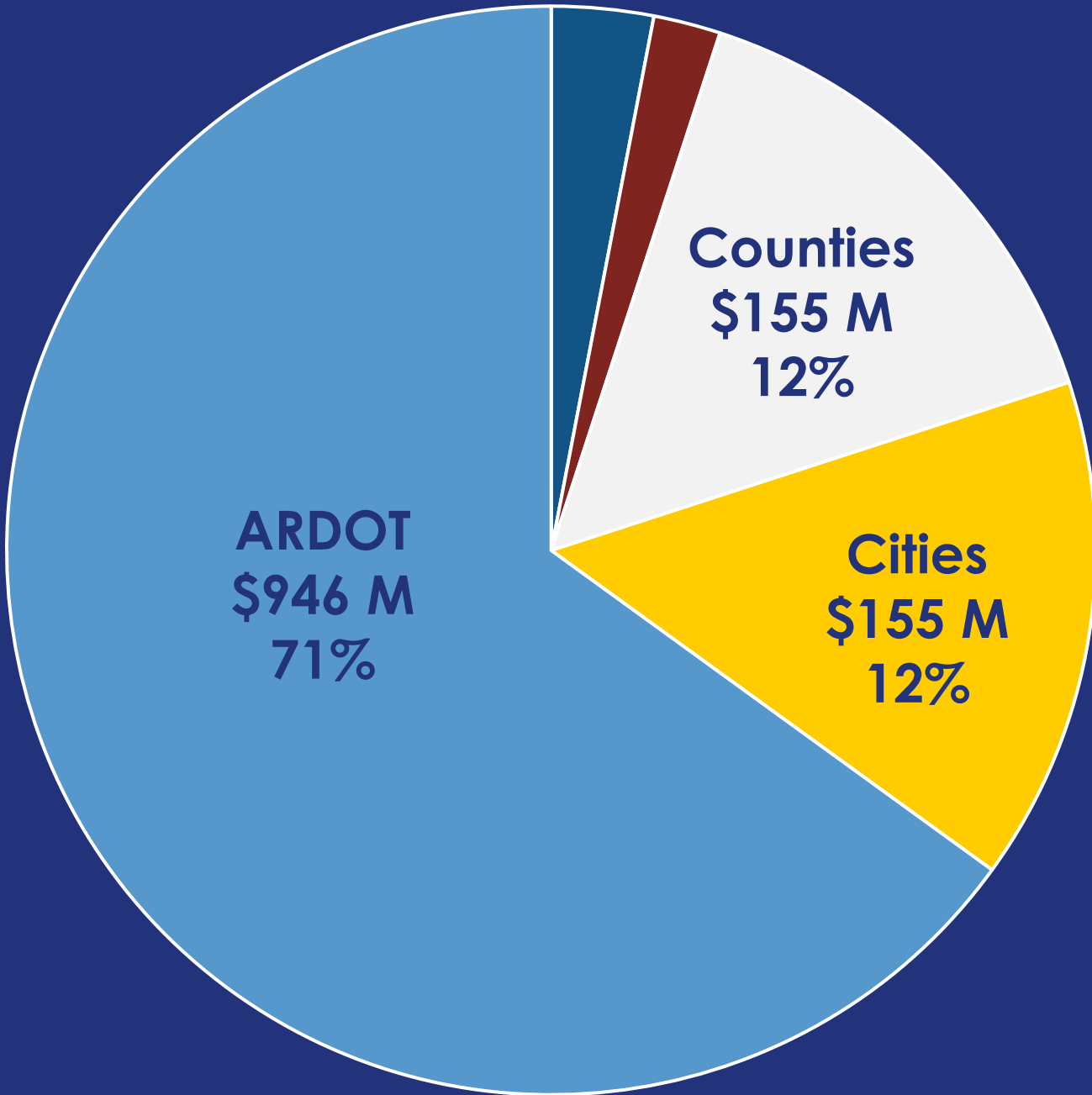

Average for State Fiscal Years 2027-2028**

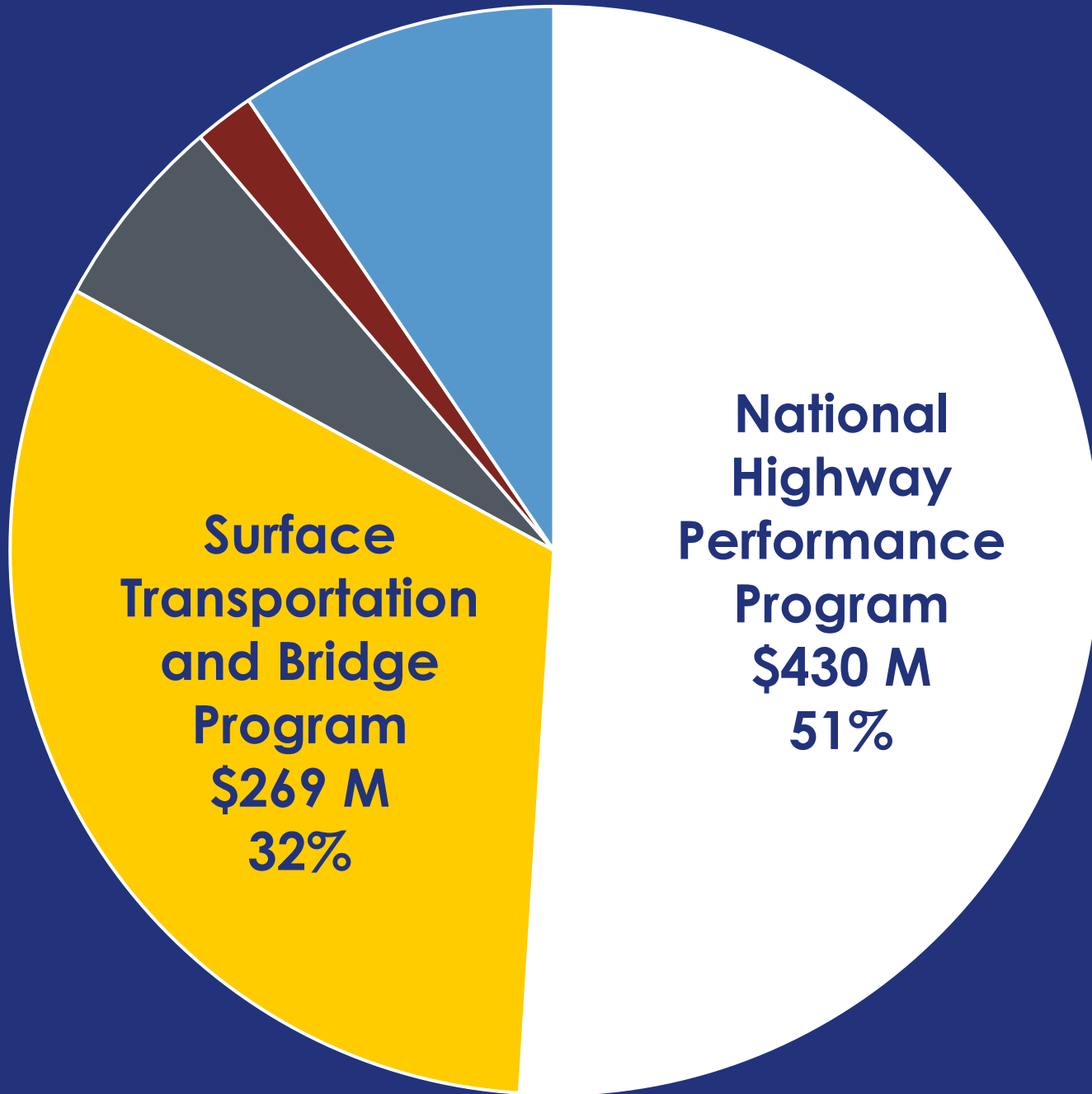

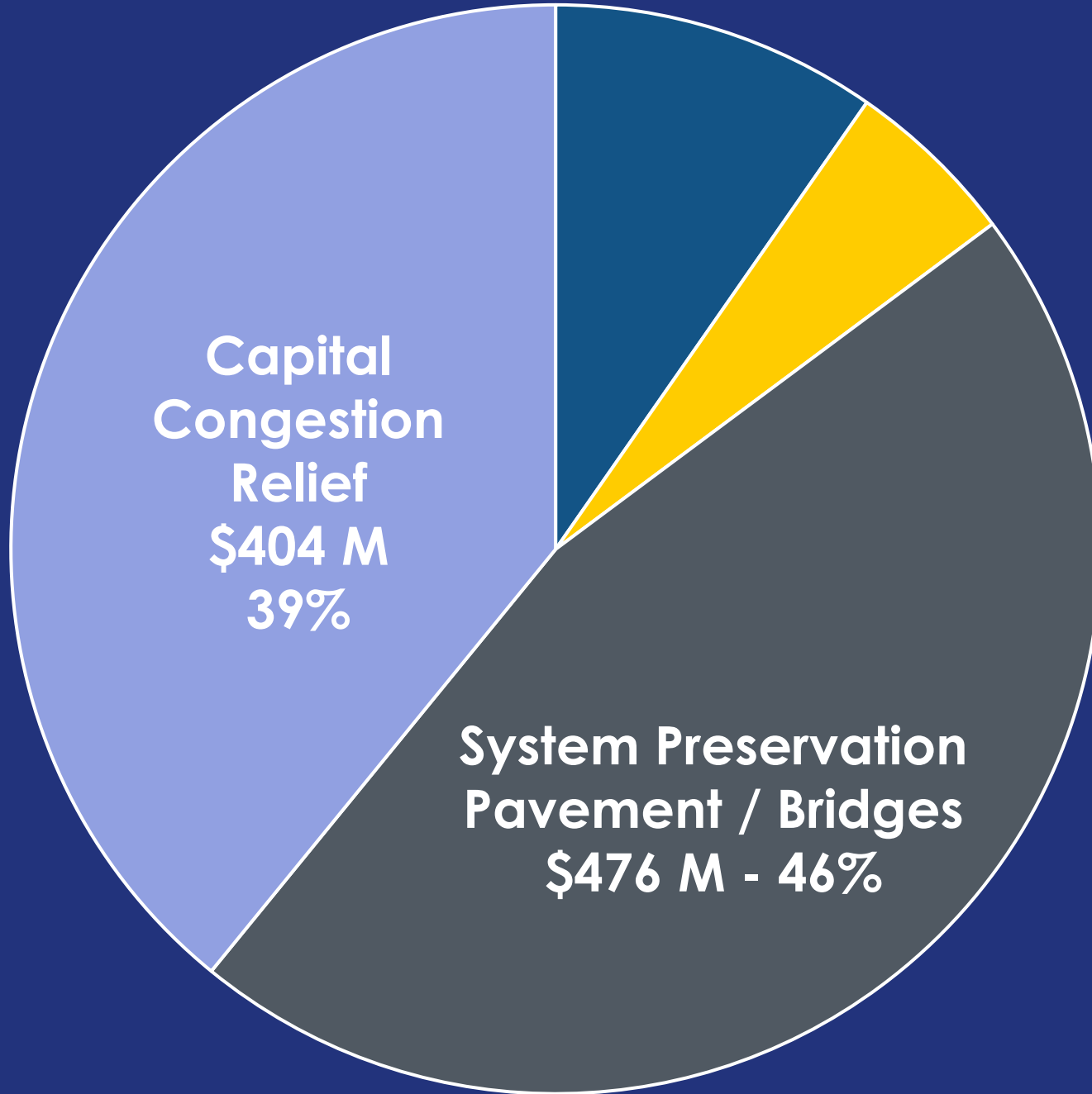

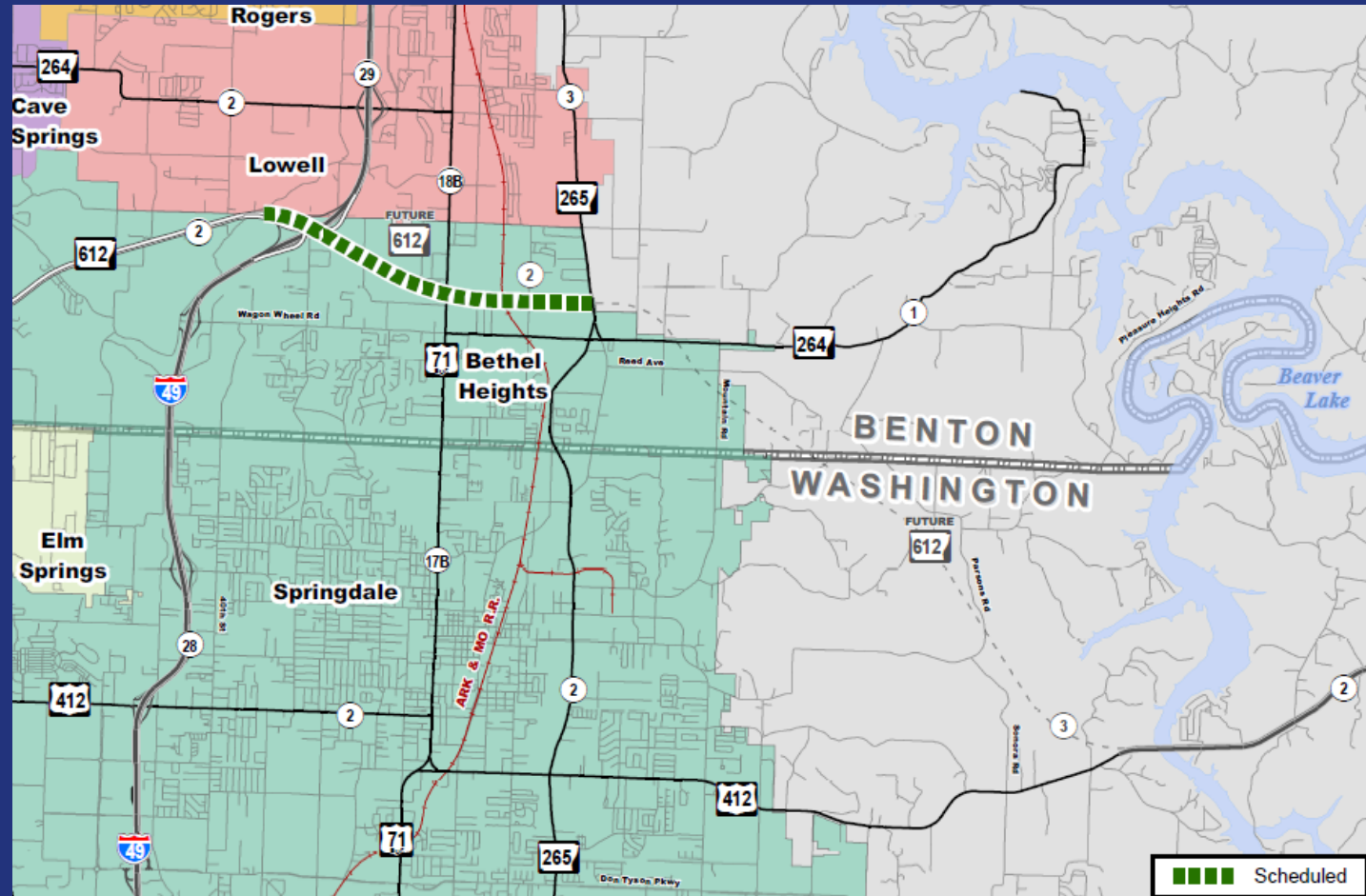

SPRINGDALE BYPASS

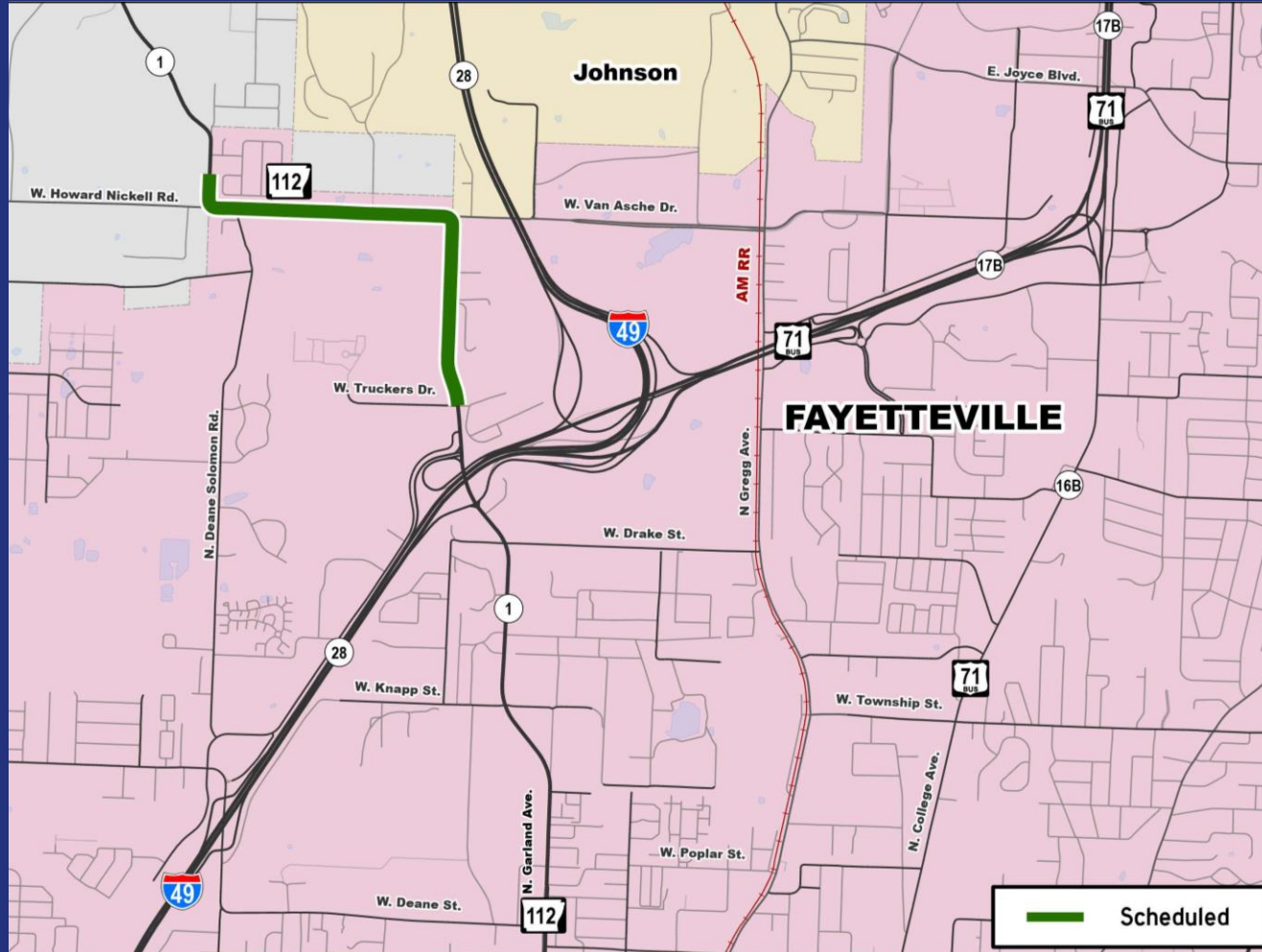
BENTON COUNTY

WASHINGTON COUNTY

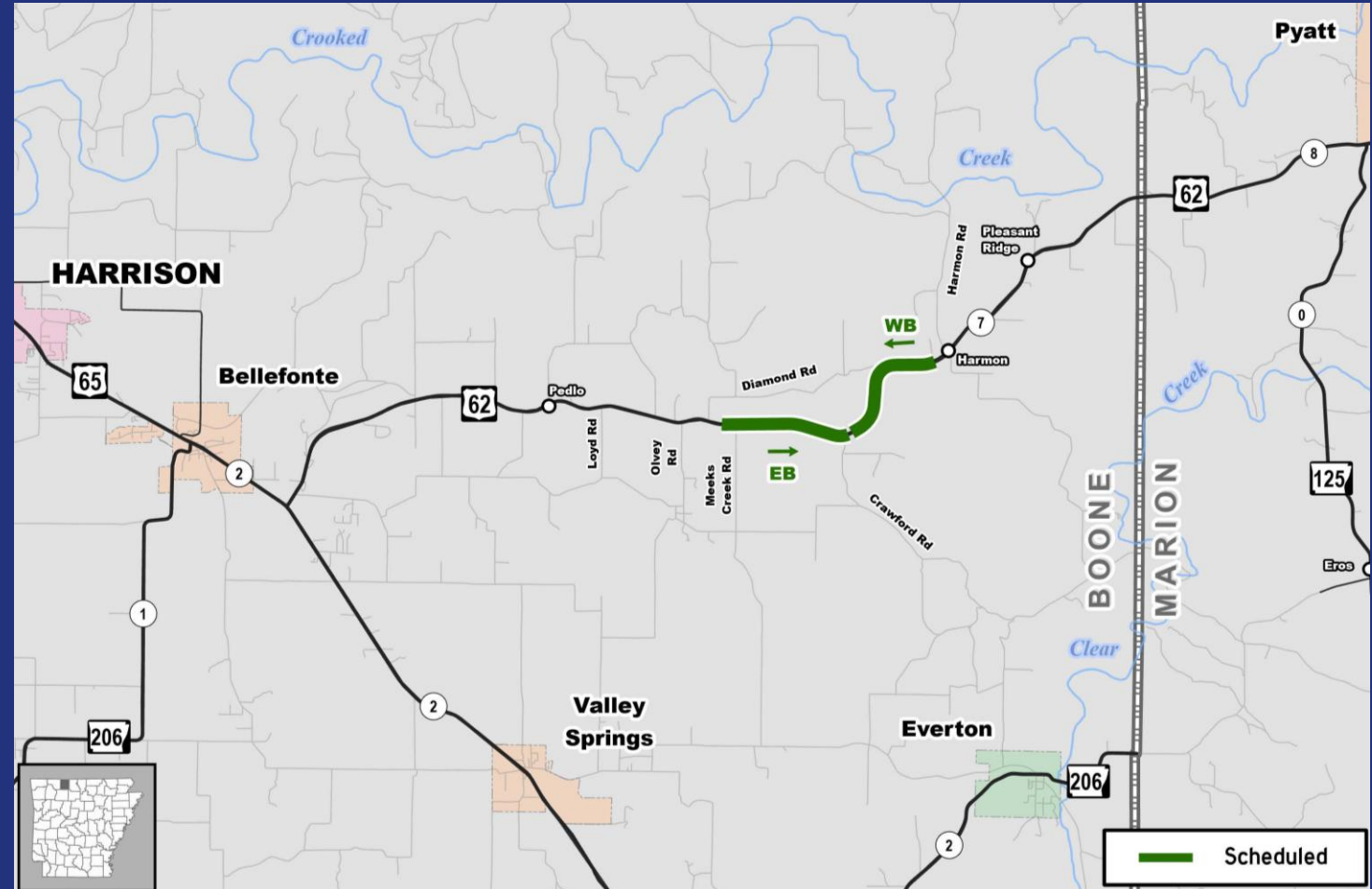


- **Objective:** Widen 1 mile of Hwy. 112

HIGHWAY 62

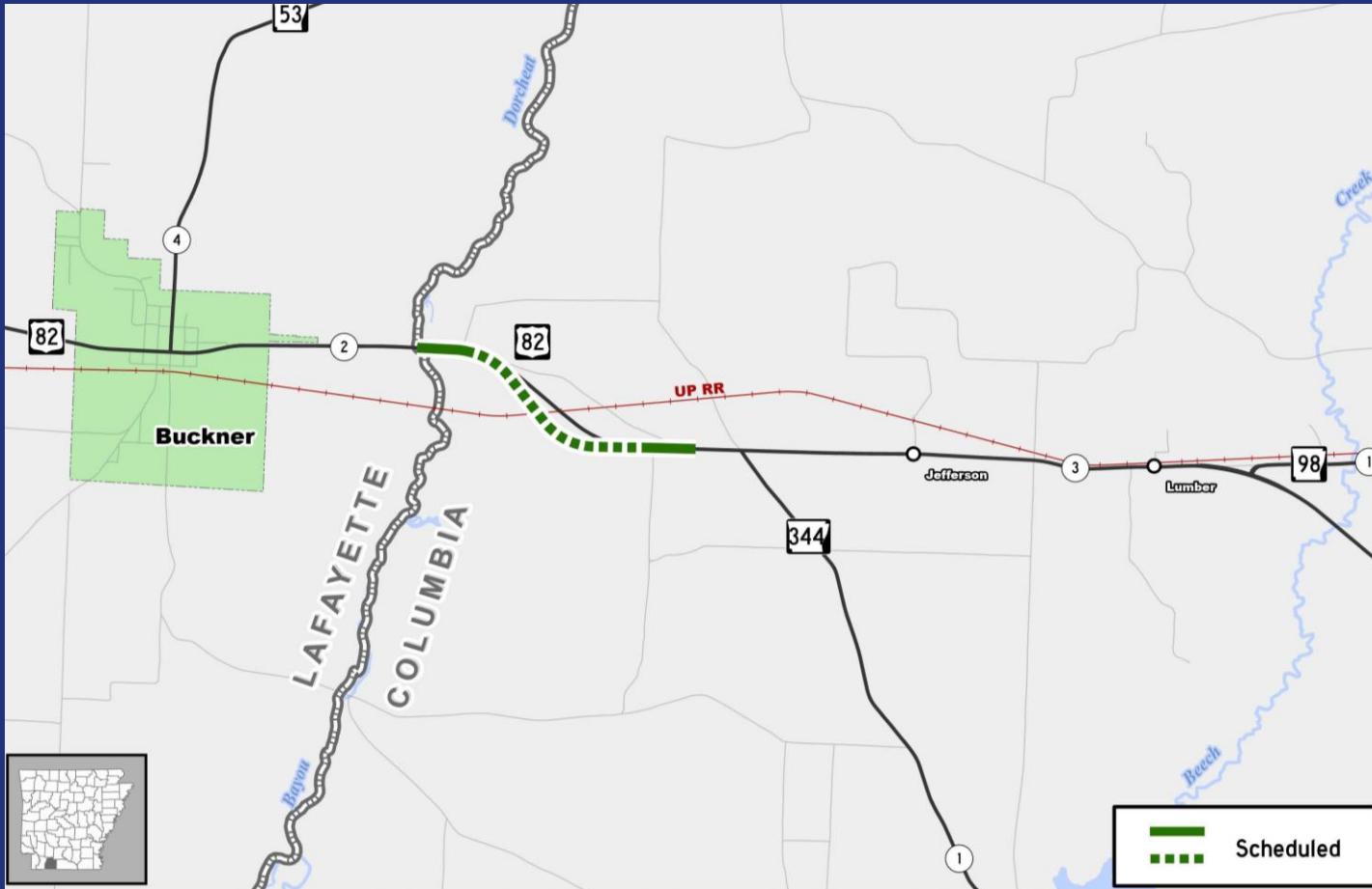
BOONE COUNTY
