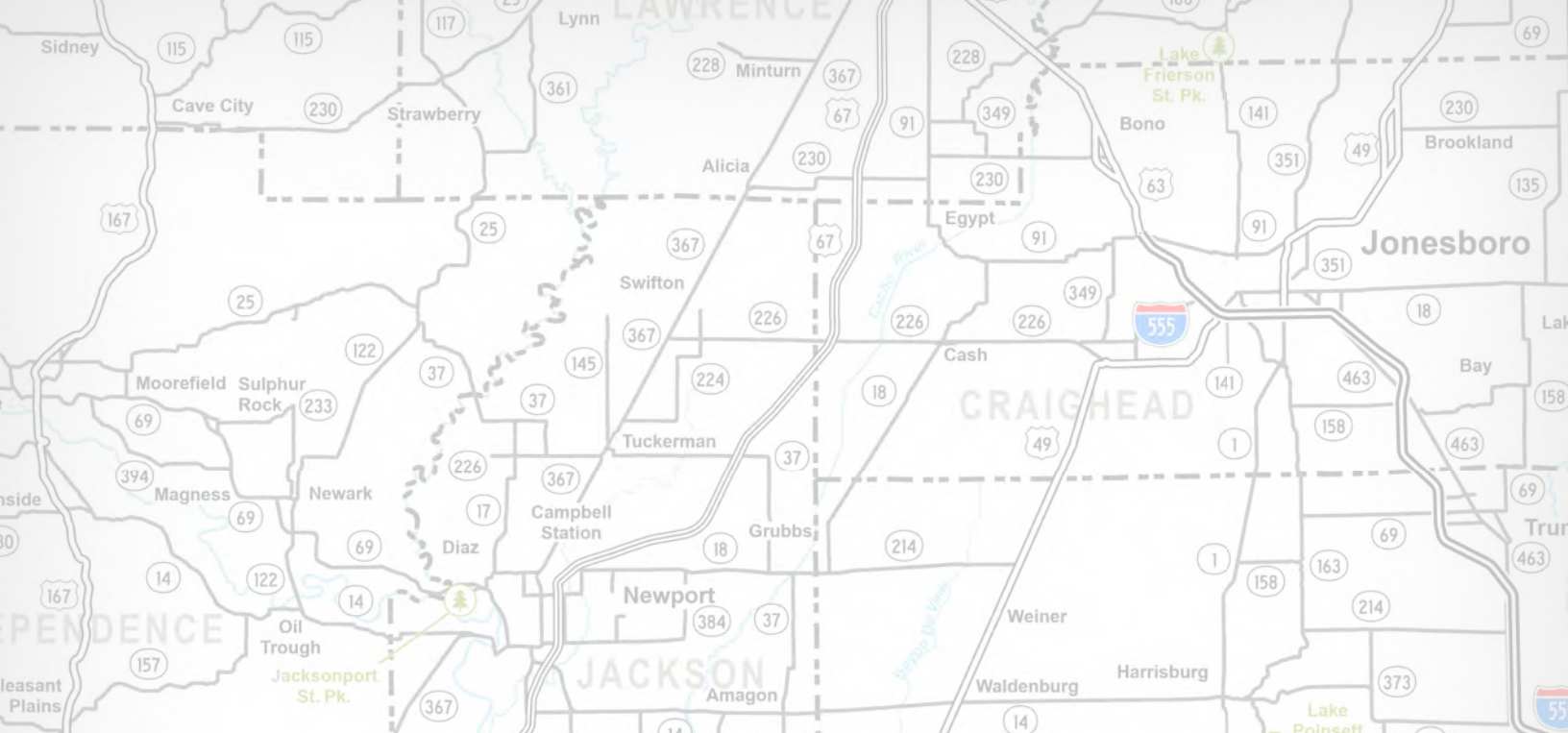

OTHER ASSETS INCLUDE:

- **Office Equipment**
Printers, computers, scanners, laptops, etc.
- **IT – Software**
Computer software and annual software as service contracts (e.g. UKG)
- **Office Furnishings**
Desks, chairs, bookshelves, tables, etc.
- **Rolling Fleet – Vehicles Under 6,000 lbs**
Cars, SUVs, light-duty vehicles, etc. (e.g. Ford Explorer).
- **Maintenance Equipment and Vehicles Over 6,000 lbs**
Heavy-duty vehicles, etc. (e.g. Dodge Ram 3500)
- **Other Equipment**
Forklifts, epoxy machines, falling weight deflectometers, barges and boats, welders, generators, etc.
- **Facilities**
Central office complex, district headquarters, resident engineer offices, area headquarters, welcome centers, rest areas, weigh stations, chemical storages, bulk salt houses, brine storages, inspection barns, yard barns, equipment shops, etc.
