

IT IS ORDERED that a meeting of the Arkansas State Highway Commission be opened at 10:00 a.m., December 3, 2025.

WHEREAS, the Purchasing Committee has awarded purchases on October 17, and October 30, 2025, in the amounts of \$1,125,625.00, and \$199,750.00, respectively, totaling \$1,325,375.00, and supply and service contracts, in accordance with authority previously conveyed, all of which have been documented by official minutes which are of record in the files of the Commission and Equipment and Procurement Division.

WHEREAS, this pooled fund study is eligible for State Planning and Research funds.

WHEREAS, this work is eligible for Federal-aid Highway Safety Improvement Program funds.

OTHER DISCUSSION ITEMS

Patrick Patton, Chief Fiscal Officer, provided the October 2025 State Highway Revenue update. For State Fiscal Year (SFY) 2026 Budgeted vs. Actual Operating Expenses for ARDOT, overall expenses (maintenance, operations, administrative, and construction) were below budget by -13.2% (-\$9.2 million). Mr. Patton noted that State Highway Revenues to the Department from traditional sources for the year are higher than budgeted, a total of 7.1% (\$16.4 million) in SFY 2026 compared to the same period for SFY 2025. Revenue from the Natural Gas Severance Tax was higher this year compared to last year, resulting in total revenues available being 7.4% (\$17.5 million) above last year. Actual revenue received in SFY 2026 is 2.8% (\$6.9 million) above projected (budgeted) revenue for this year. October revenue from the Amendment 101 of 2021 Sales Tax was 4.1% (\$3.8 million) above this year compared to last year.

Kevin Thornton, Chief of Administration, provided an update on Federal legislative activities.

Crystal Woods, Assistant Chief of Administration, provided an update on the Arkansas Legislative Council Efficiency Study Recommendations Rules for Implementation. To date, the Department has completed 86 of the 90 individual rules, bringing the Department to a 96% completion rate. Ten of the thirteen recommendations have been fully implemented.

Jessie Jones, Chief Engineer – Preconstruction provided the bid letting update from the October 15, and November 5, 2025, bid lettings.

Rex Vines, Chief Engineer – Operations provided construction and maintenance activity updates.

Director Wiley updated the Commission on recent Department activities.

Joseph Hawkins, Division Head of the Transportation Systems Management and Operations Division, presented on the Division's roles and responsibilities.

Director Wiley presented on the Department's accomplishments in 2025.

Director Wiley provided a list of upcoming events including the December Service Awards schedule.

In closing, Director Wiley recognized two ARDOT employees who were recently presented with an Arkansas Asphalt Paving Association (AAPA) Partnering coin. In August 2025, Bryan Brown, Senior Inspector in the Searcy RE 55 office was presented a coin from Delta Companies for his work on the Highway 31 Pavement Preservation Project from Beebe to Lonoke. In September 2025, Adam Watson, Resident Engineer for the Batesville RE 53 office was presented a coin from Atlas Asphalt for his work on the Myers Street Widening project in Batesville. Additionally, Director Wiley informed the Commission that the 30 Crossing Project in Little Rock received a Regional 2025 Best Projects Award in the “Best Highway/Bridge” Category from the Engineering News Record. This project is now in the running for a national Best of the Best Award, which will be announced in Spring 2026. Director Wiley also informed the Commission of the proceeds from the Fall 2025 Equipment Auction held on November 5.

Chairman Taldo closed the meeting by congratulating Commissioner Jerry Halsey and Director Wiley for being featured in Arkansas Business annual Arkansas 250 list, which highlights the 250 most influential business, government and community leaders in Arkansas.
