The project proposes extending Community Drive to West Mississippi Street and extending West Mississippi Street to the west to support a commercial development project in Beebe, White County. The total approximate length of the project is 0.33 mile. A project location map is attached.

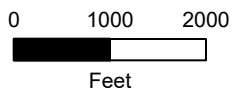
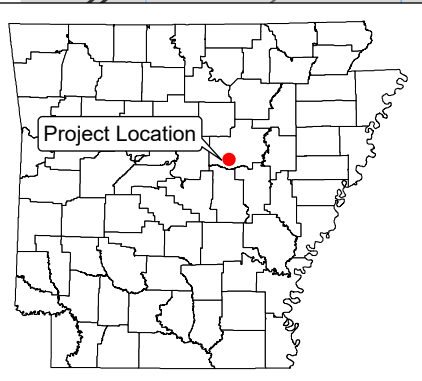
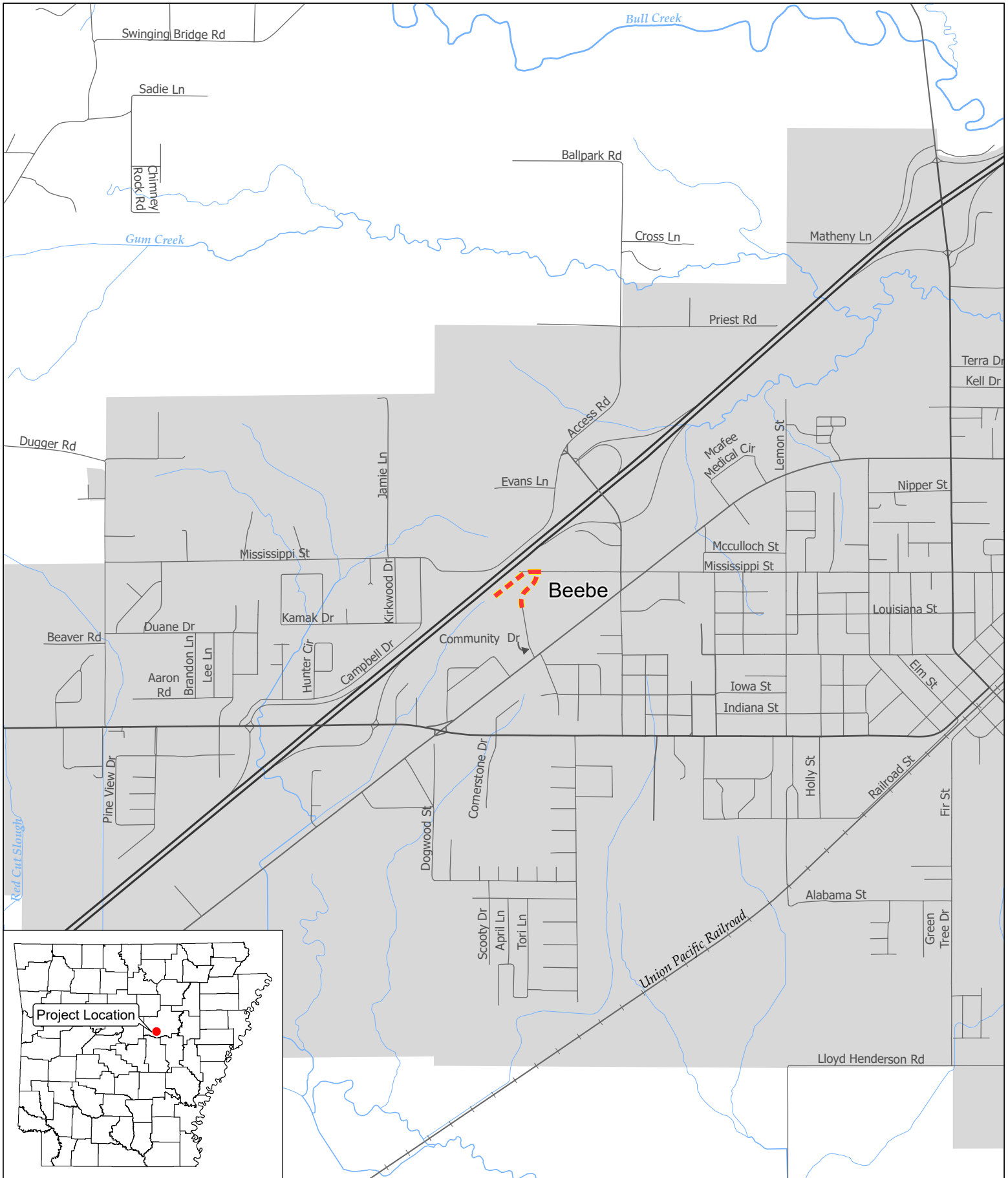
Proposed improvements for the Community Drive extension include two 15' paved travel lanes with 4' paved shoulders. The average right of way (ROW) width will be approximately 84'. Proposed improvements for the West Mississippi Street extension include two 12' paved travel lanes with 4' paved shoulders. The average ROW width will be approximately 74'. The majority of the project is within existing ROW; however, approximately 0.04 acre of new ROW will be required.

After appropriate environmental review, it has been determined that the subject job would not involve any relocations, impacts to underground storage tanks, hazardous materials, public water supplies, floodplains, wetlands, or streams.


There are no federal funds or permits associated with this project. The project is not considered an undertaking under Section 106 of the National Preservation Act and is exempt from the Farmland Protection Policy Act and Section 7 of the Endangered Species Act. Waters of the U.S. will not be impacted by this project; therefore, a Section 404 permit is not required.
