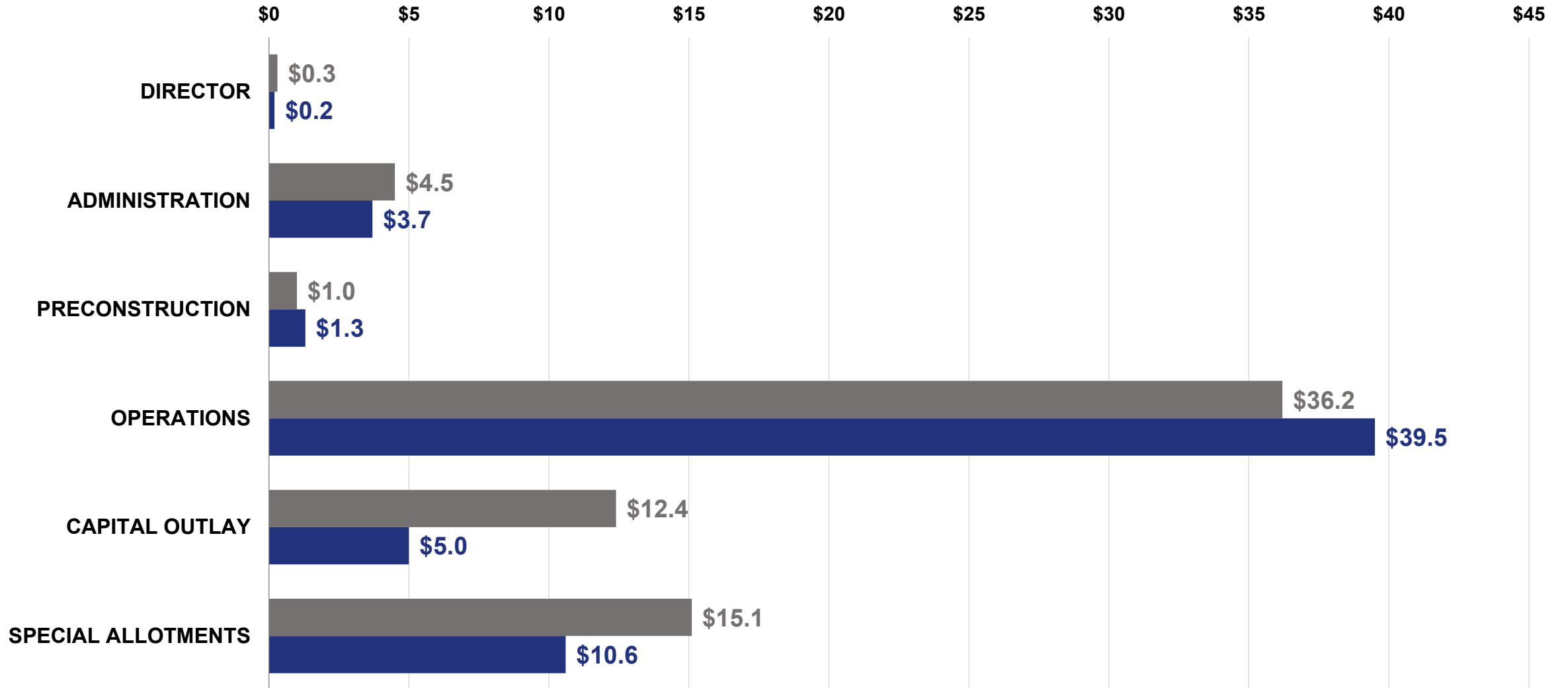

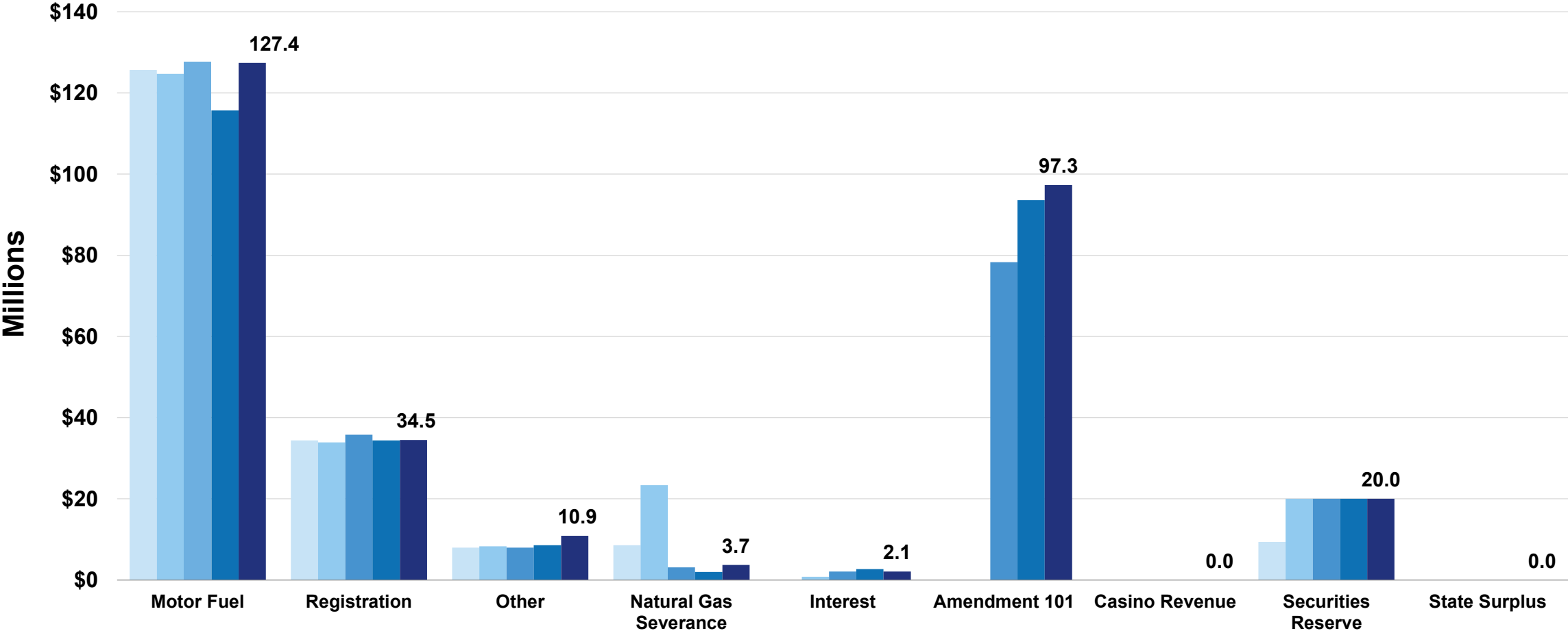

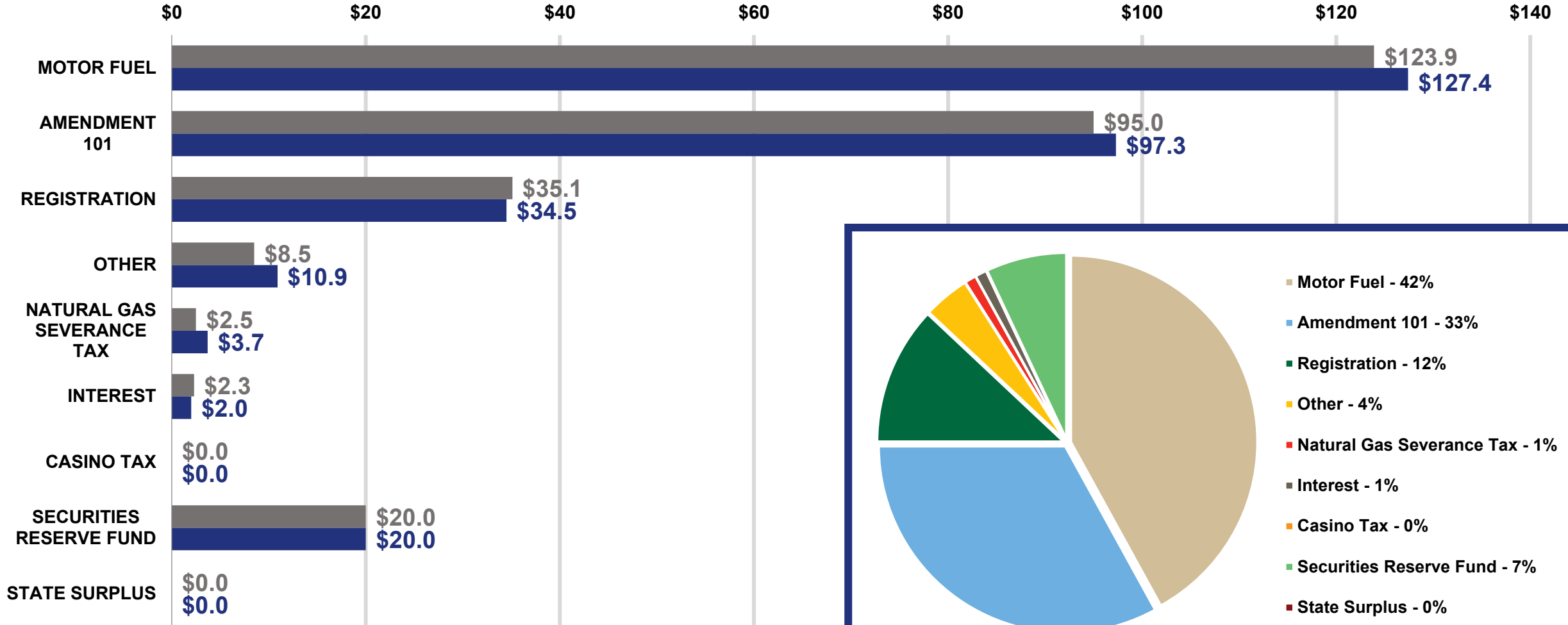
Motor Fuel and Registration Revenue includes Act 416 of 2019

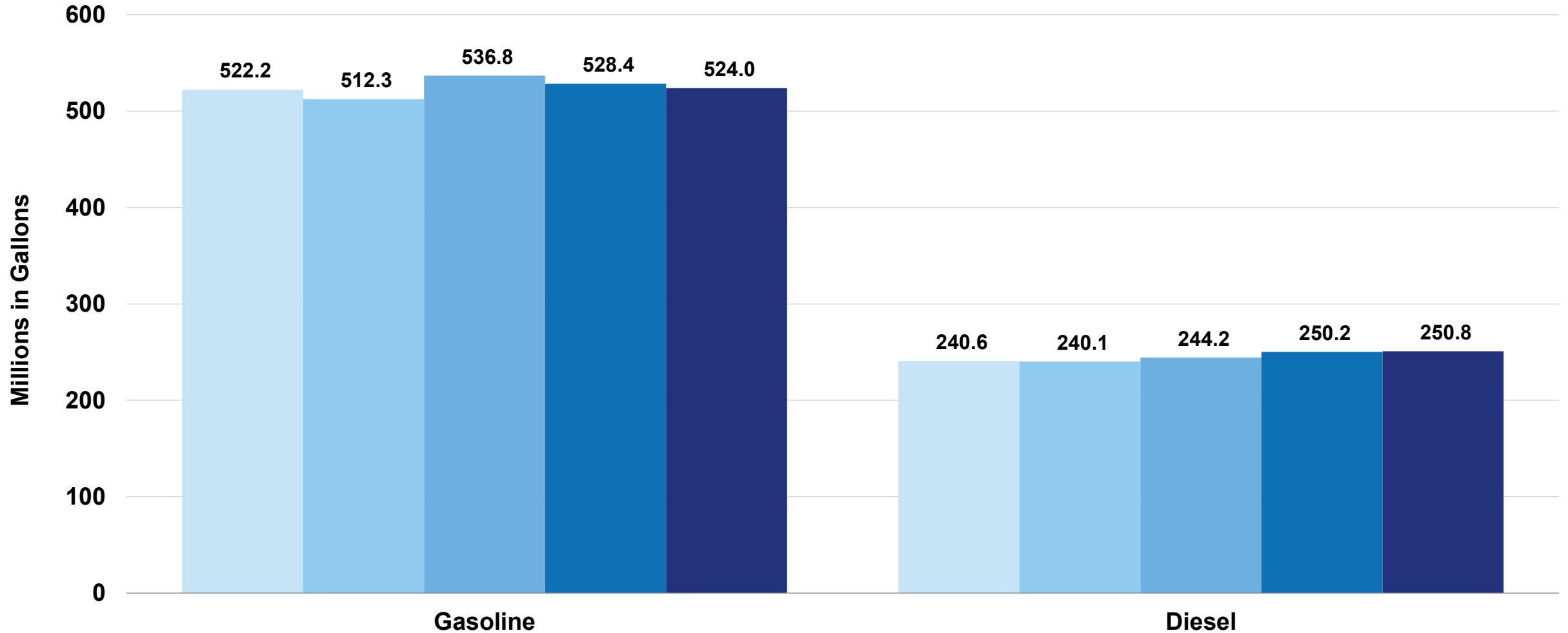

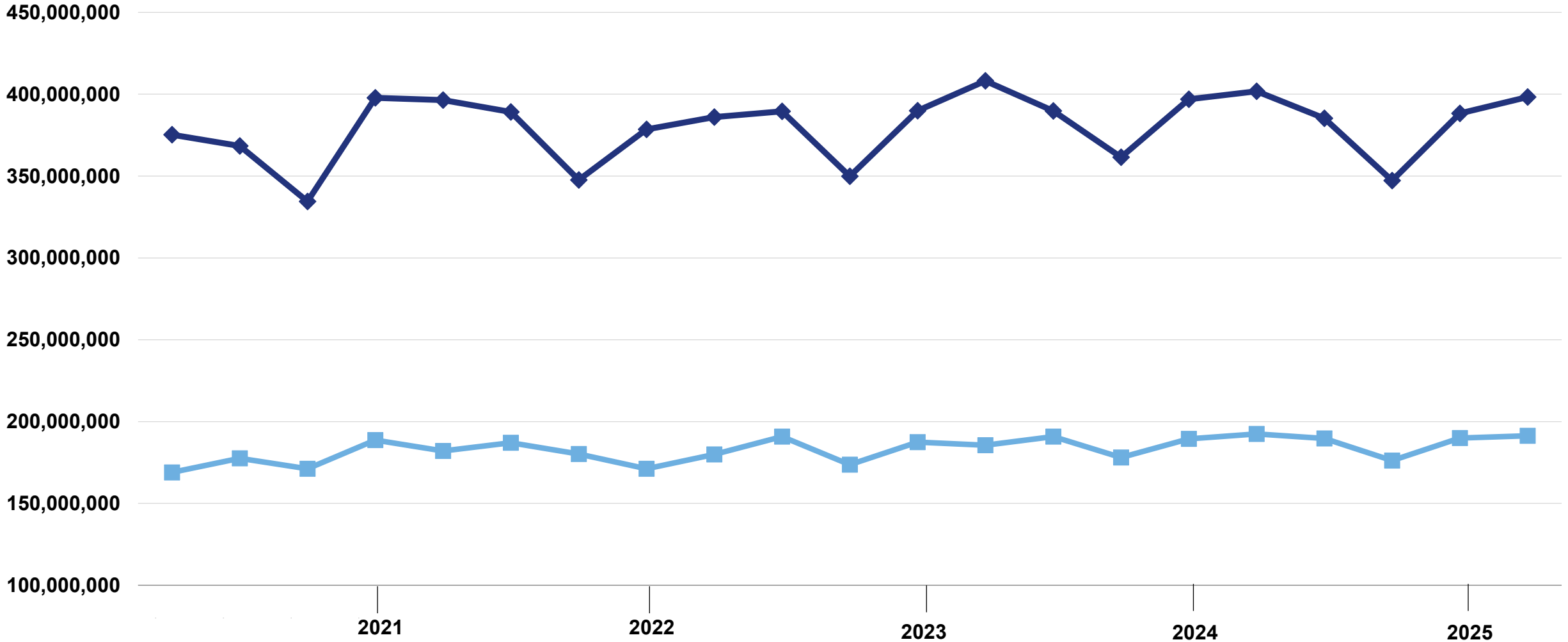
