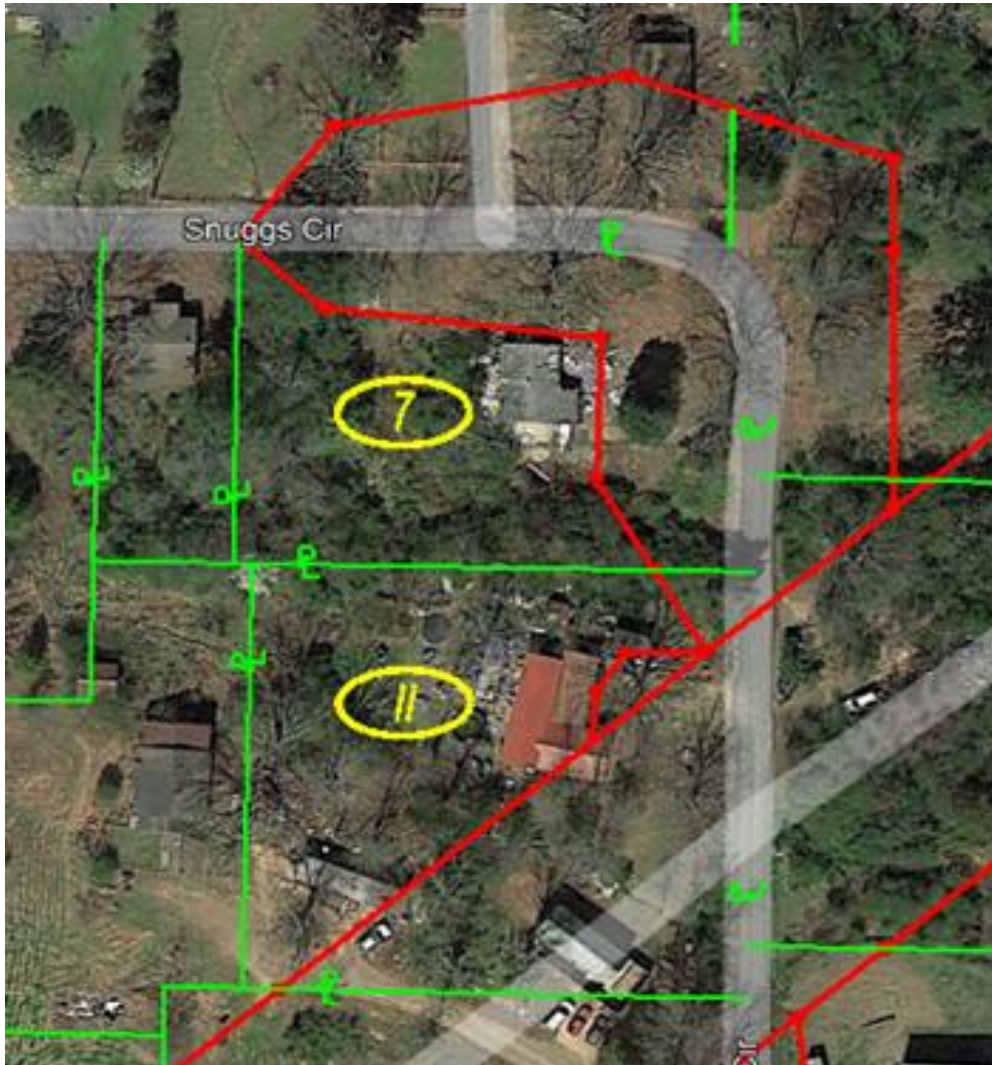
ENVIRONMENTAL PROCESS
