



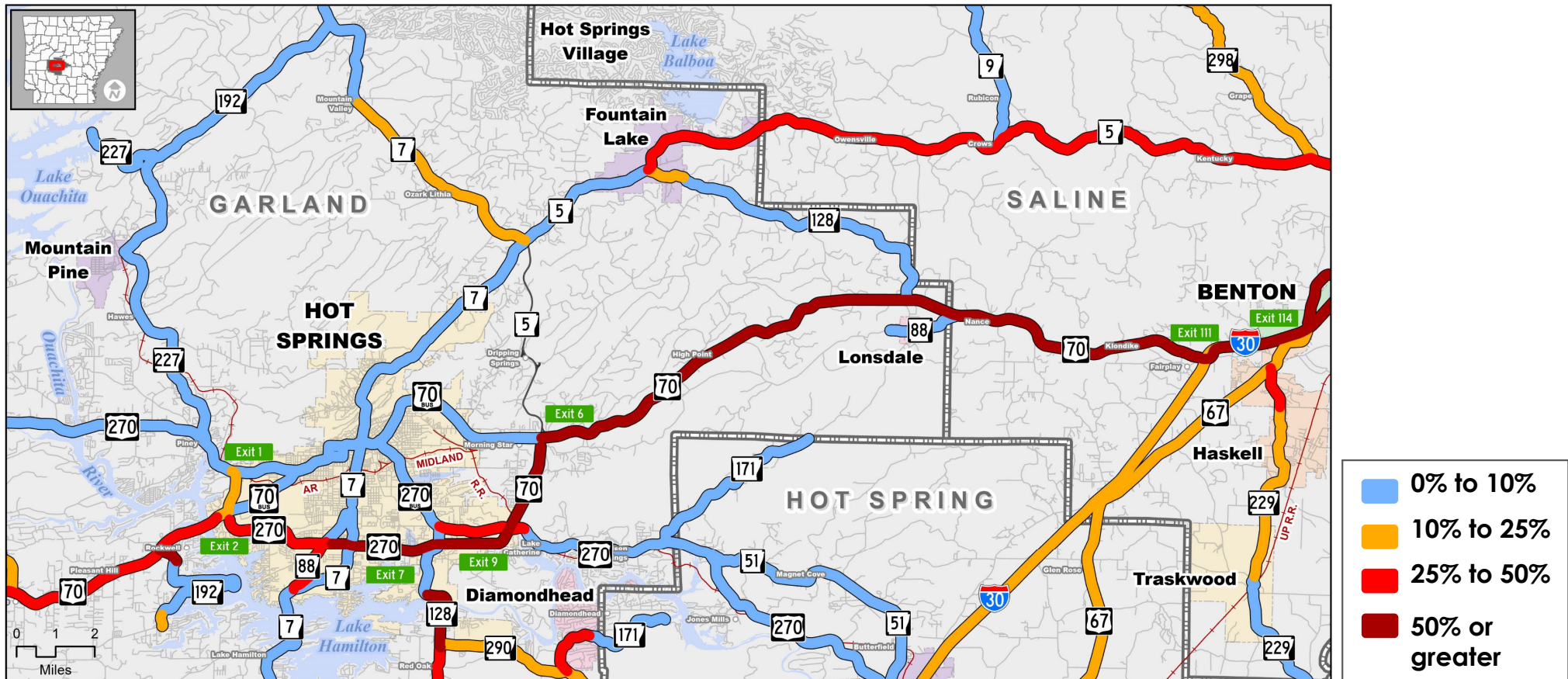

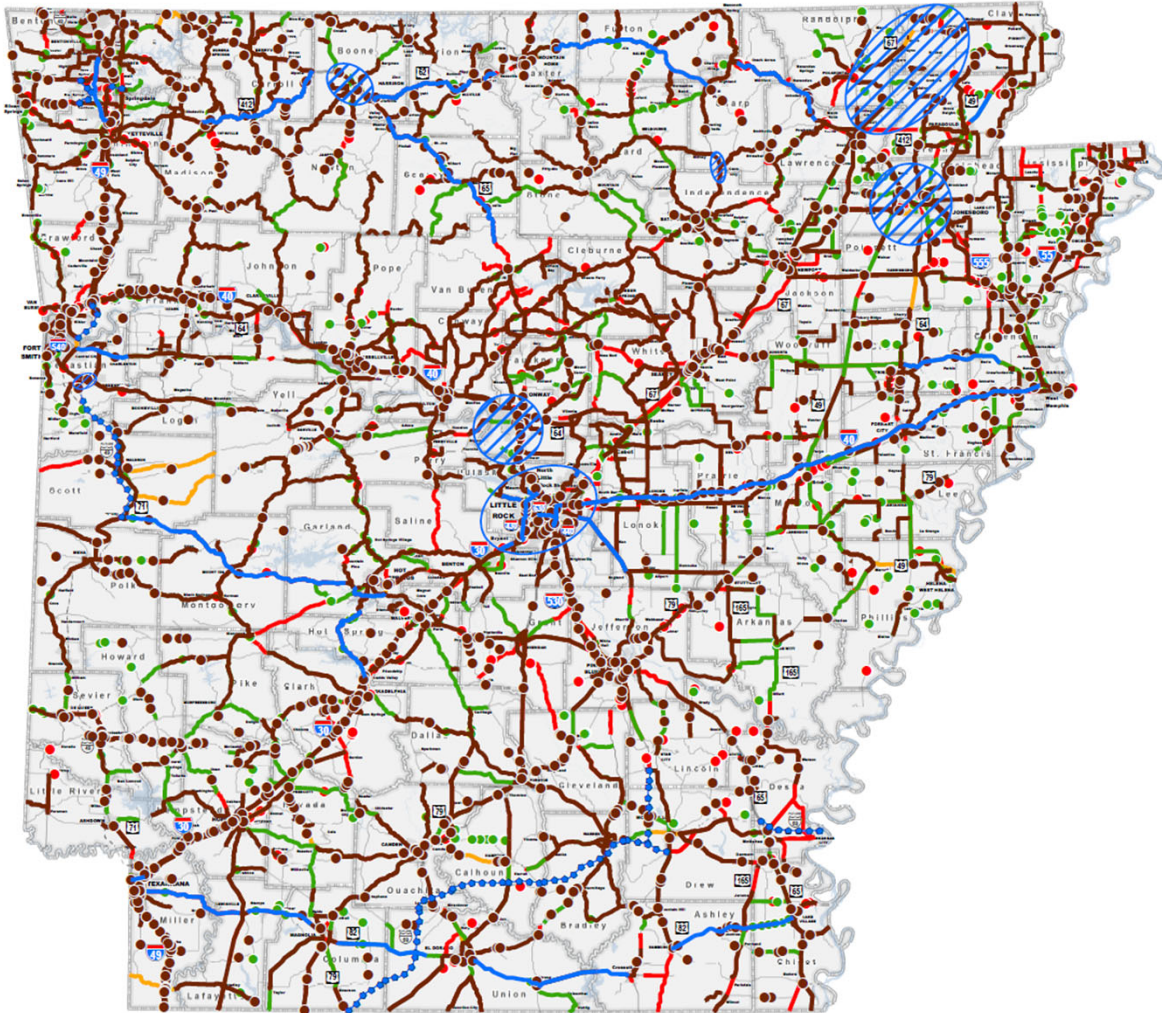

AVERAGE DAILY TRAFFIC IN THE CENTRAL ARKANSAS AREA 2004-2024





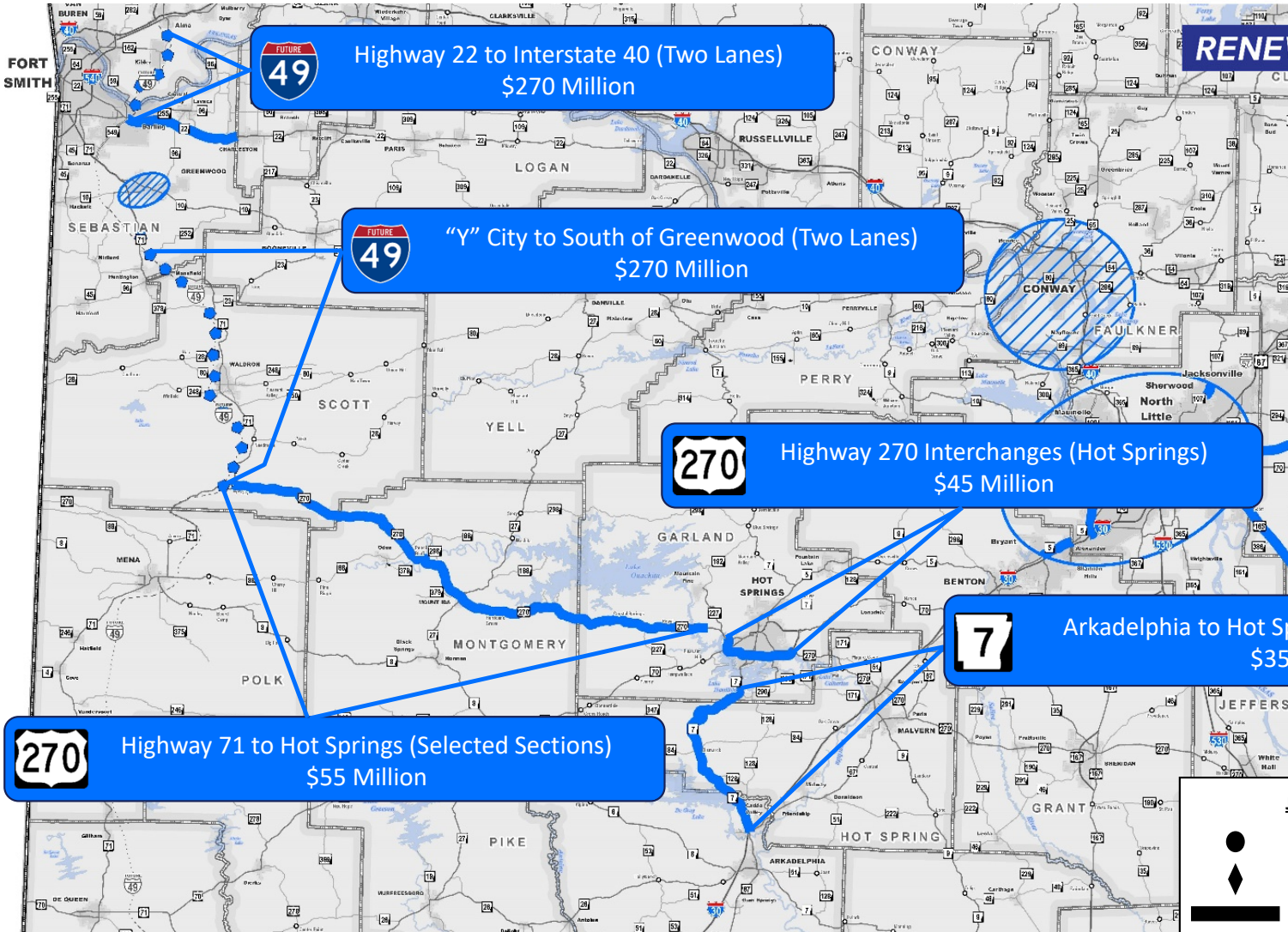

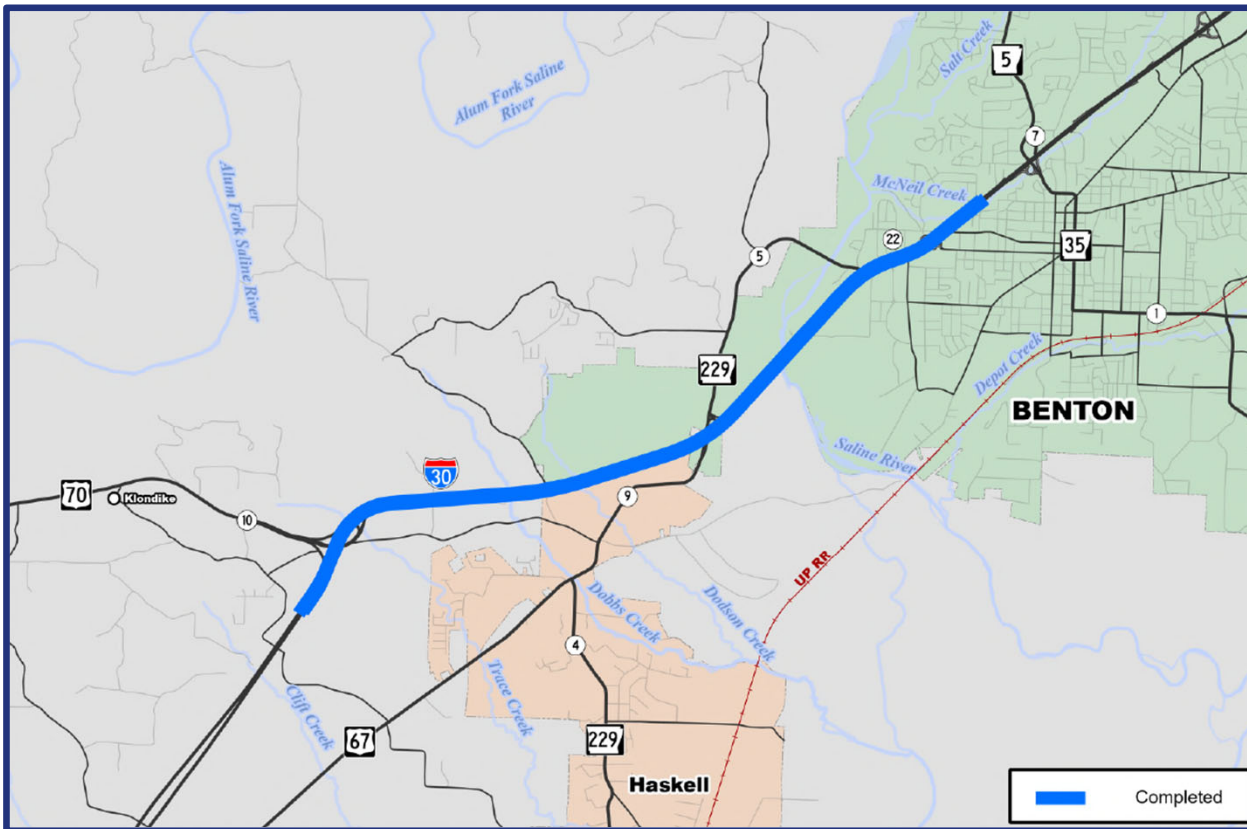

SALINE COUNTY

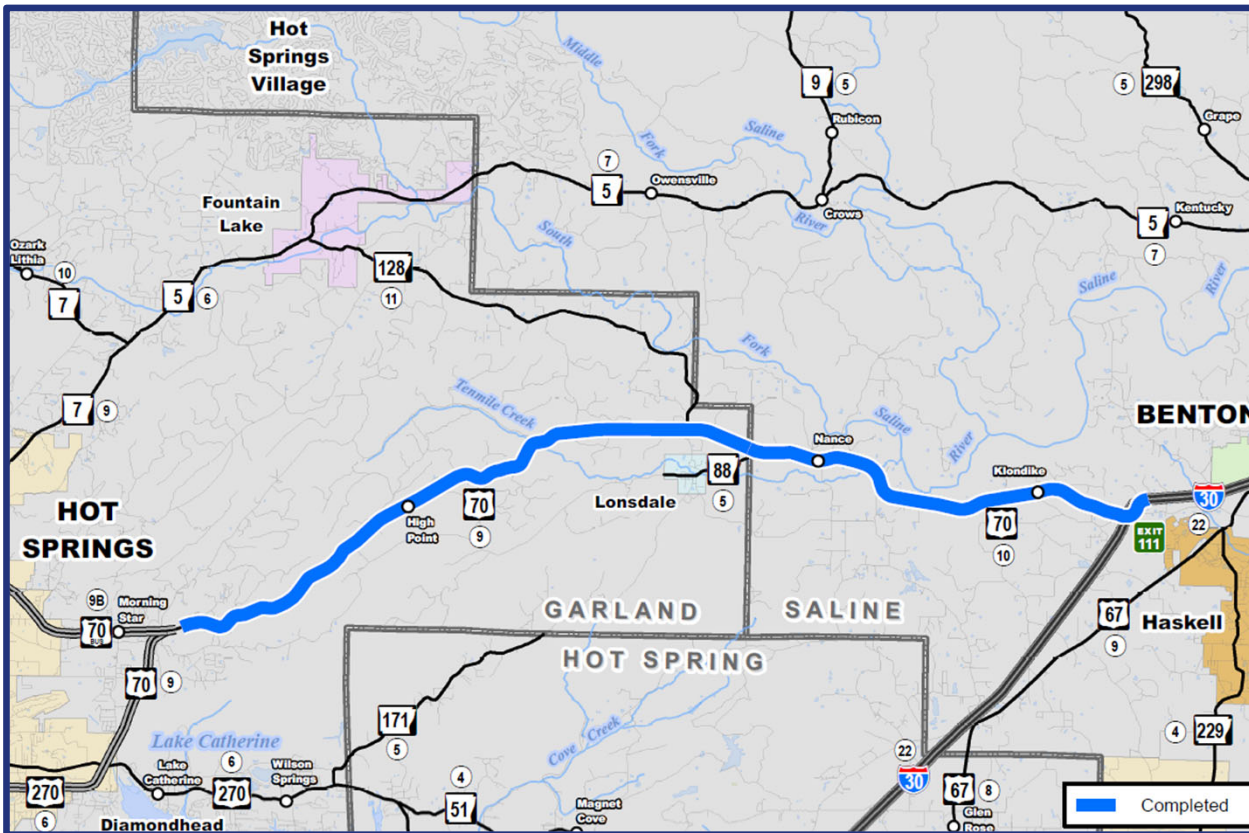


- **Objective:** Widened 5 miles of Interstate 30 to 6 lanes, reconstructed 3 interchanges and replaced 5 bridges
- **Awarded:** Johnson Brothers Corporation for \$187.3 million
- **Status:** Substantially complete early 2025

GARLAND & SALINE COUNTIES

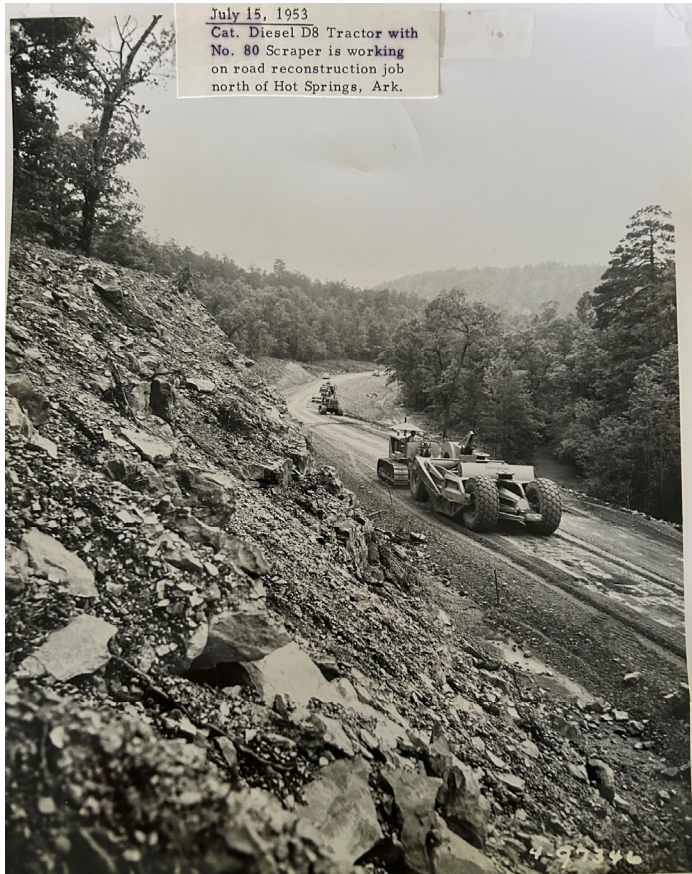


- **Objective:** Widened 18 miles of Highway 70 between Benton and Hot Springs

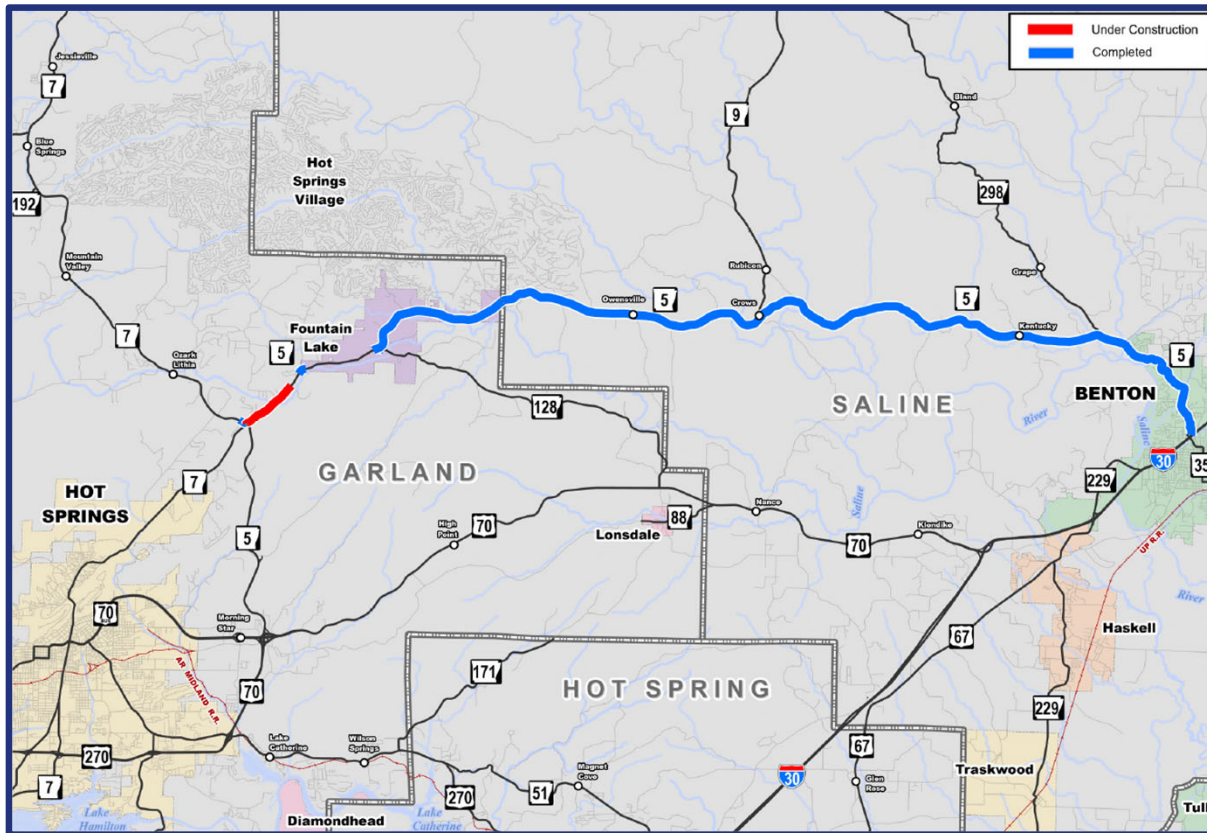

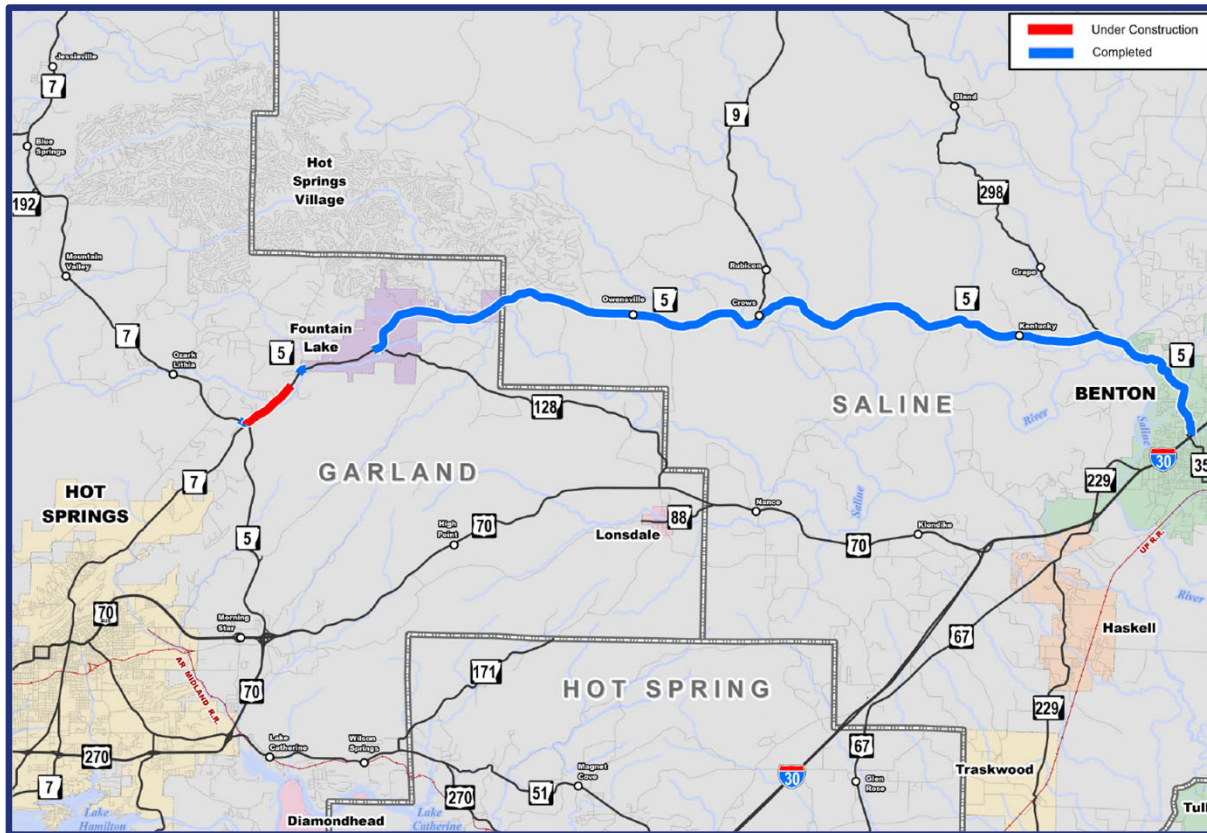

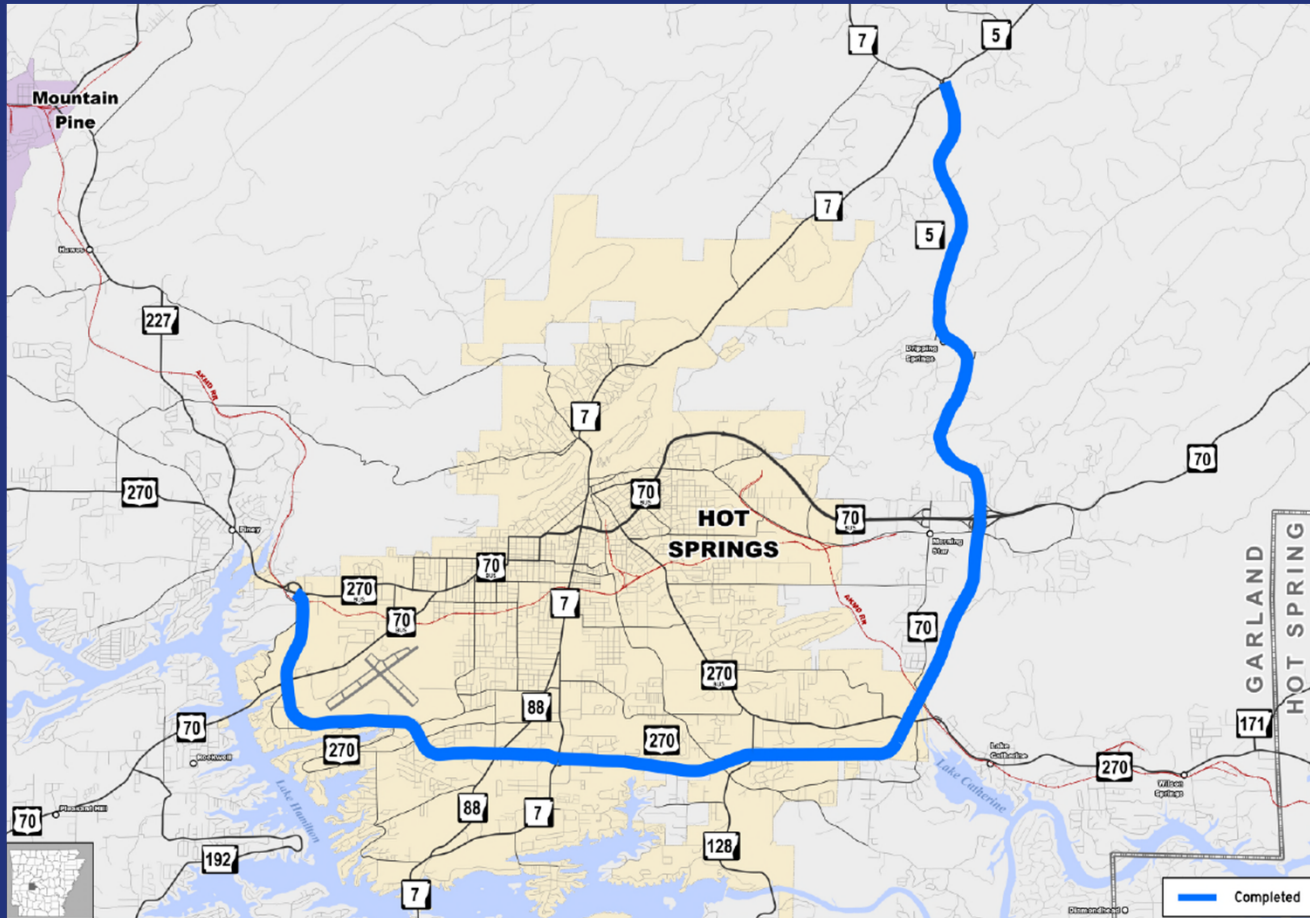

- **Estimated Completion:** Mid 2027

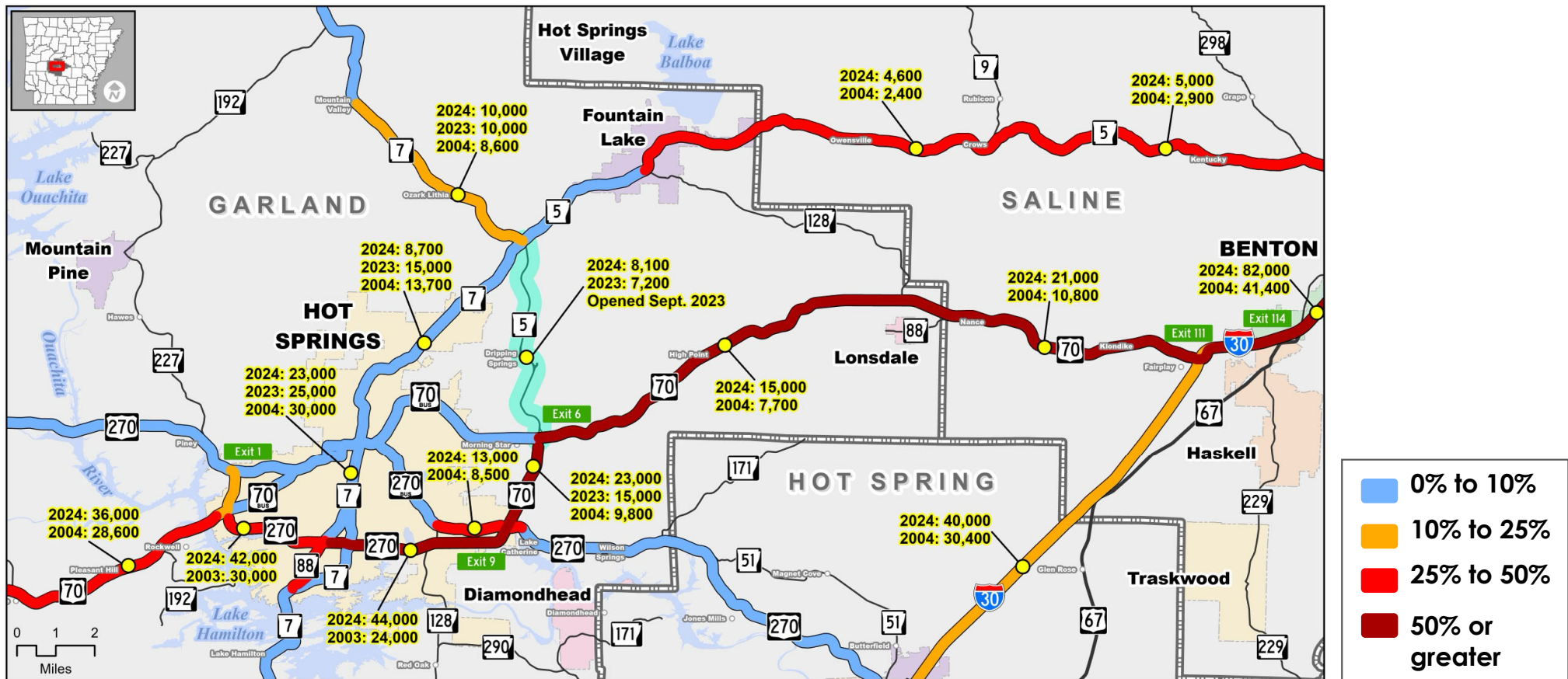
HOT SPRINGS BYPASS

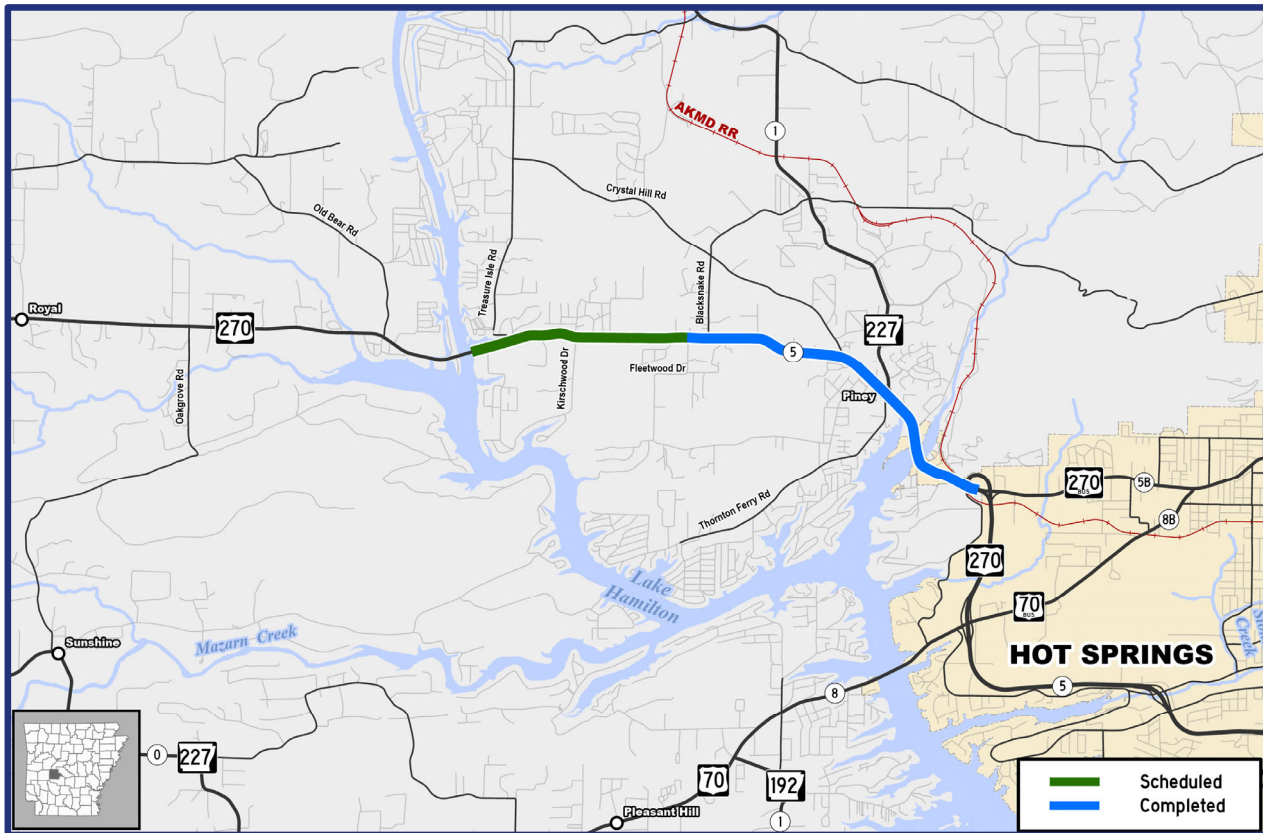

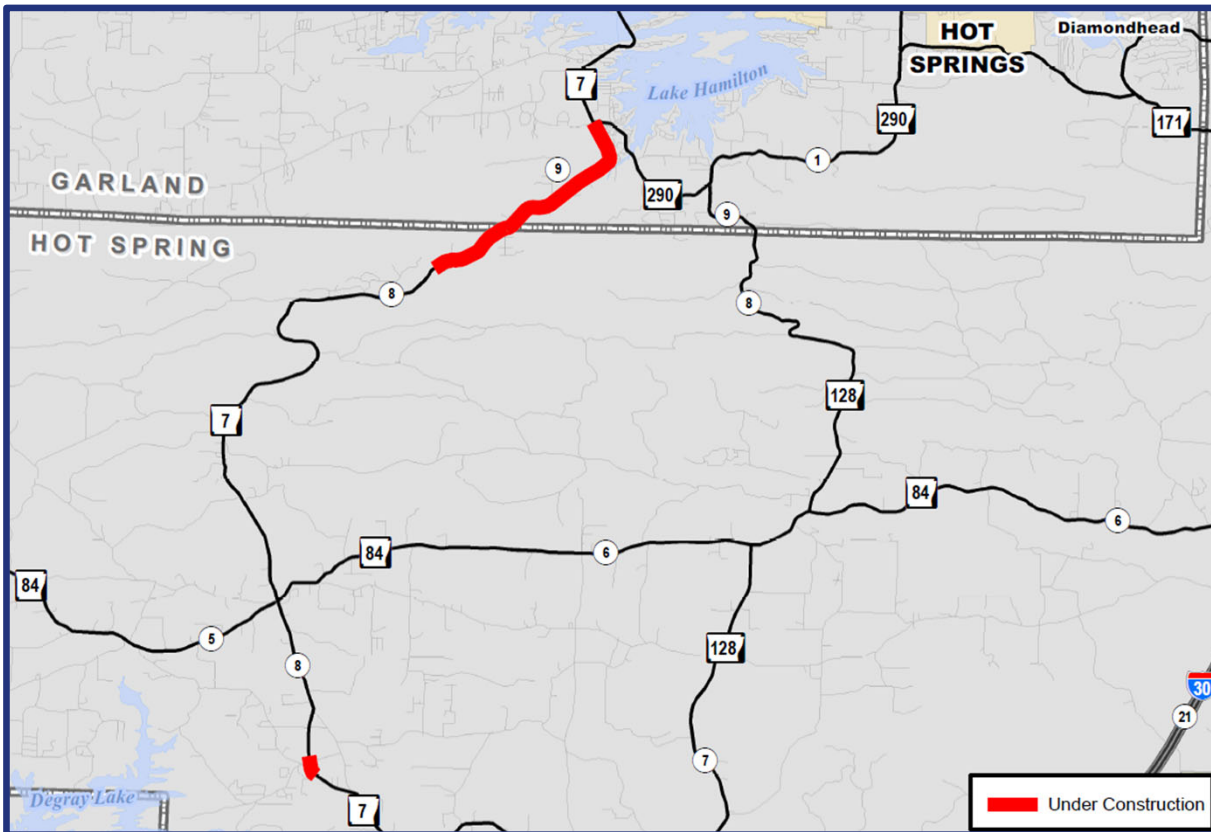

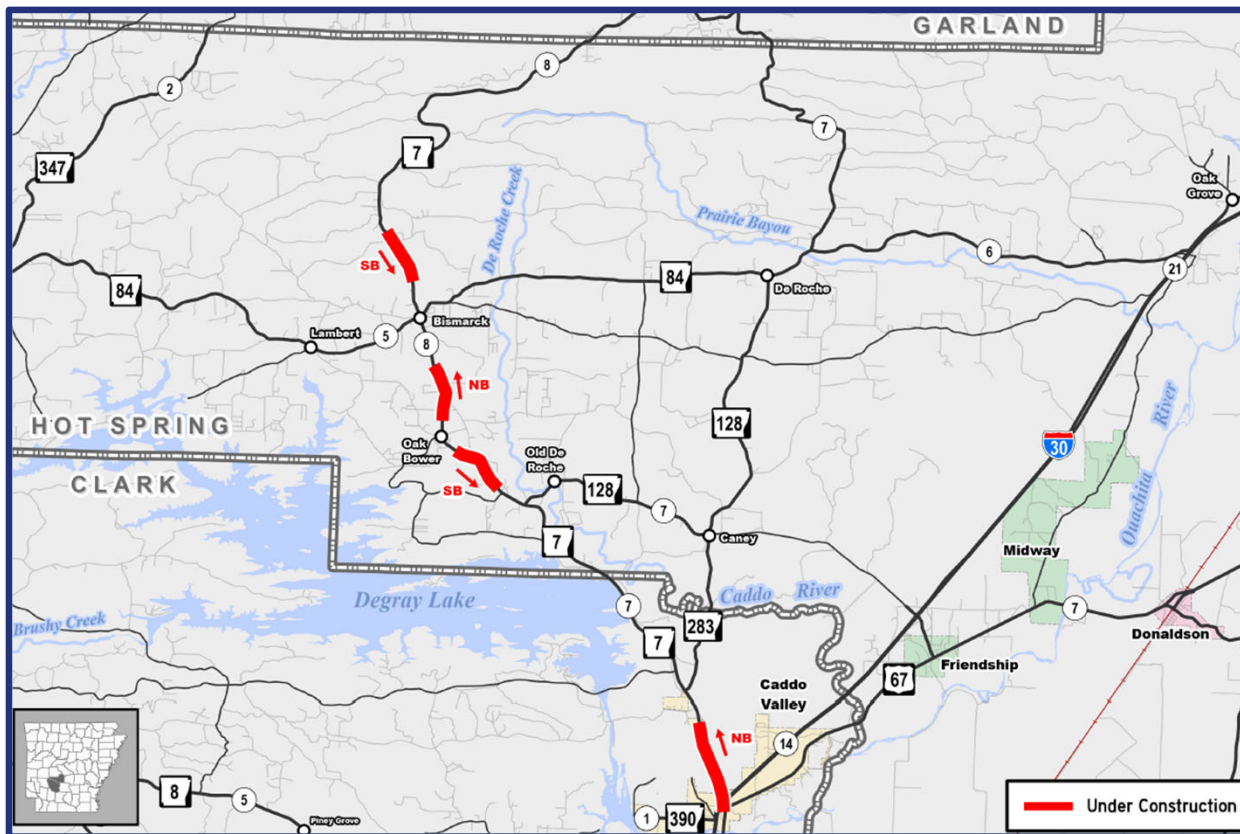


- **Objective:** Constructing a center turn lane and replacing 1 bridge

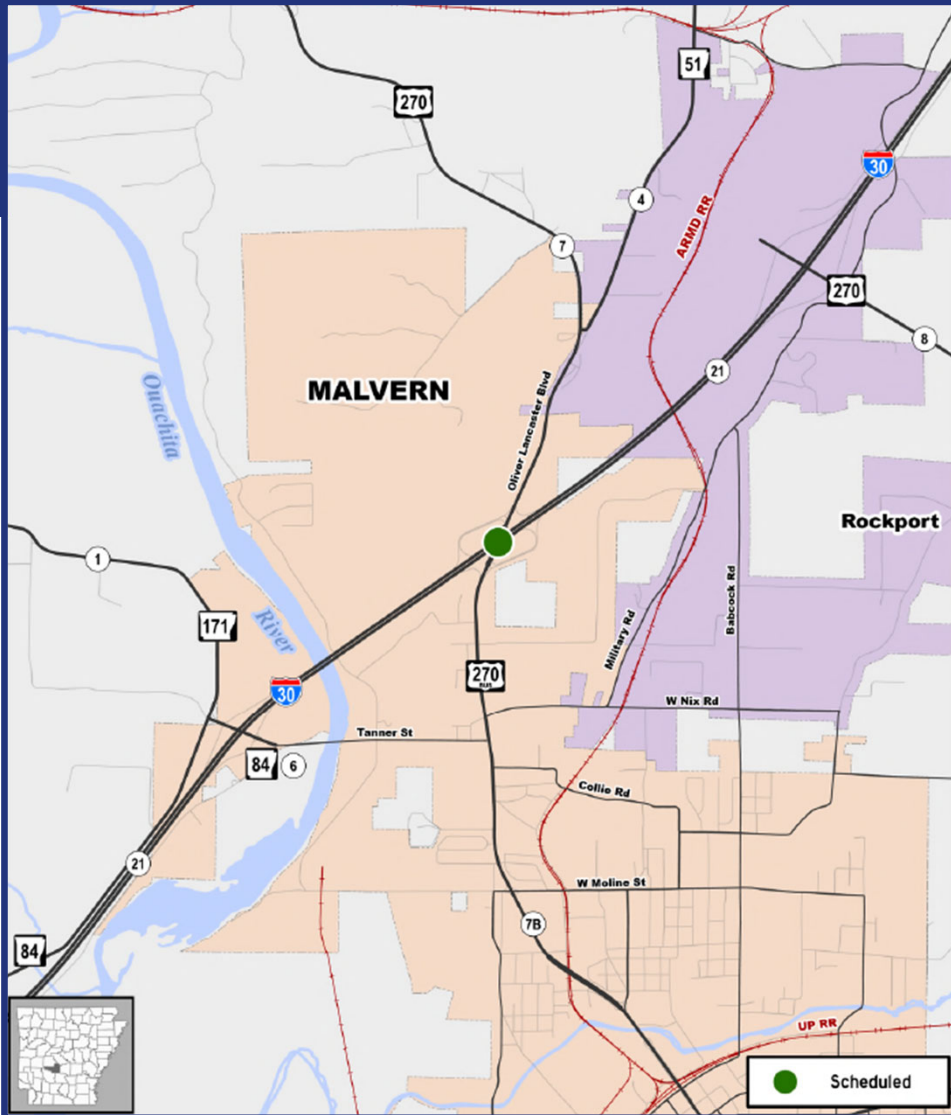


- **Objective:** Constructing passing lanes & completing resurfacing

- **Estimated Completion:** Late 2025

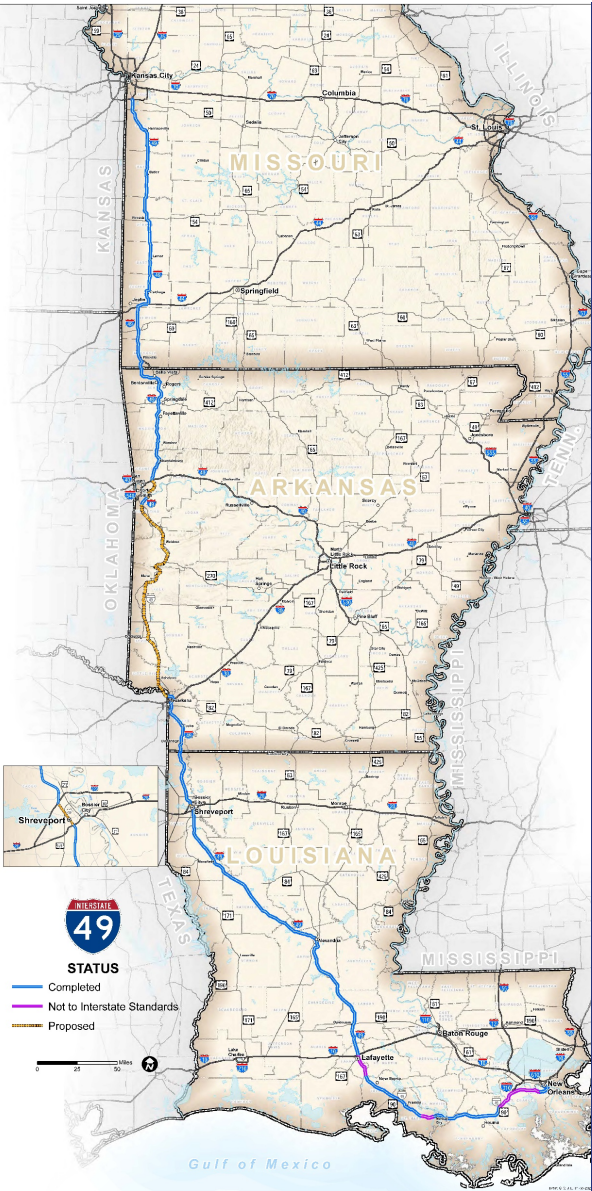

 Phase 3	Grading, Paving, Grade Separations and Cross Drainage Structures (Gun Club Road to Clear Creek Road)
 Phase 4	Base, Surfacing, and Six Structures and Approaches (Clear Creek Road to I-40)

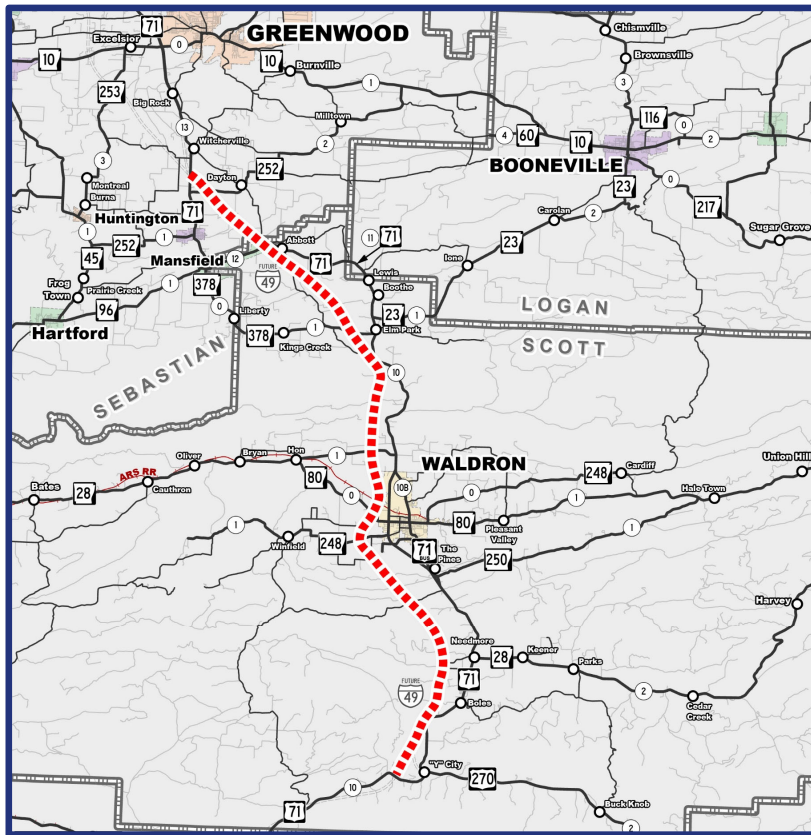
