

PUBLIC INVOLVEMENT SYNOPSIS

Phase II – An “In-Person” Public Involvement Meeting was held on Thursday, March 17, 2022, at the First Baptist Church Alma, 211 N. Mountain Grove Rd., Alma, AR. The project information was made available on the ARDOT’s website from March 11, 2022, through April 1, 2022. Efforts to involve minorities and the public in the meeting included:

- Display advertisement placed in *Southwest Times* and ran on Sunday, March 6, 2022, and Sunday, March 13, 2022.
- Public Service Announcement was placed with La Raza 95.7 and ran from March 14, 2022, through March 17, 2022.
- Letters were mailed to Public Officials on March 8, 2022
- Letters were mailed to Minority Leaders on March 8, 2022.
- Flyers mailed to citizens.

A listing of general comments concerning the proposed project follows:

- Requested that entire property be acquired rather than splitting up property
- Drainage concerns near Richland Road, New Town Road, western areas of Alma, along Frog Bayou and the streams that flow into Frog Bayou
- Requested a grade separation at H Street for emergency services
- Notified that there are projects planned east of the corridor, south of H Street extended
- Concerned with maintenance a new road will require
- Requested the alignment go on the westside of Kibler rather than a big loop that goes east of Kibler
- Request for a full interchange, both on and off ramps, south of Alma providing access to SH 162
- The City of Alma is working on a Land Use Plan
- Concerns with not providing an overpass over Westville Road
- Does not think an interchange at US 64 is feasible with nearby I-40, Frog Bayou, and UP railroad
- The project will be increase tourism and commercialism within the region and the State will benefit as a result
- Request that overpasses be built at New Town Road and Westville Road, rather than closing the roads
- Requested that in section 31-9-30 the 1/2 mile stretch be put straight down the fence line between the two landowners thus not land locking either side
- Existing gas well in production in section 31-9-30 and existing transmission line in place
- Requested that the bridge that crosses May's Branch be lengthened in order to get equipment/etc. through there in order to farm the North side of that field. Bridge needs to be a minimum height of 22' tall underneath and a width of at least 60'
- Request made for protective guardrails and noise abatement acoustic panels
- Noise walls requested near Newtown Road
- Requests to begin construction at I-40 and move south towards the Arkansas River
- Requested an exit to Highway 64 in Alma
- Notified that there is a family cemetery that is unmarked and located between Clear Creek Road and the Creek.

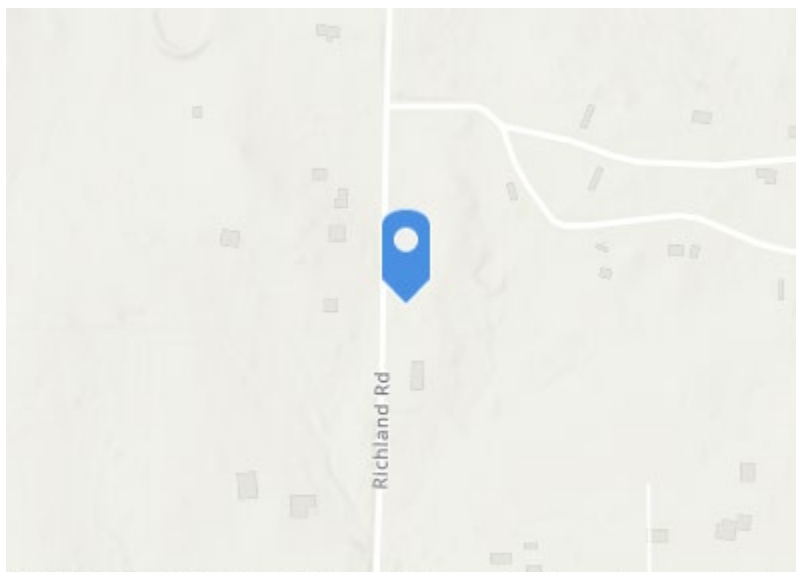

I know that there is a push for some in Alma to include a US-64 interchange, but with the proximity of I-40, Frog Bayou, and the U.P. railroad, there isn't logistically enough room for any kind of interchange with I-49, which is still a bridge from the top stack level by the time it crosses it, and necessarily so with the need to also cross the railroad and Frog Bayou. This wishful addition cannot come at the expense of the ability to actually build 4 full lanes of I-49 between I-40 and AR-22 this decade. It would only save having to go half a mile down I-40 to the east to the US-71 interchange, which should be adequate for the local traffic needs for decades.

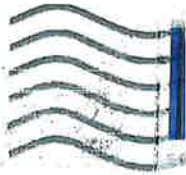

I am writing to report multiple concerns that my family has about the new highway 49 project. My family and I are aware that this project will improve the economy and the residents of the great state of Arkansas, especially around Crawford County. But, this project greatly concerns my residency of 544 Richland Road. It also will destroy the livelihood/income of my family. I purchased the land on Richland Road for my parents and future family to start a farm. We have owned this property for almost 30 years during this time have made tons of improvement by building a pond, a corral, fenced and crossed fenced and have raised dozens of heads of cattle. We have put our blood, sweat and love into making this property a farm home.

Since I have married and have children of my own. My elderly father of 81 and my mother of 80 still reside at the house on Richland Road. They are worried sick about what this highway project will do to the livelihood of the farm. Plus, the daily care of a farm has kept my father active and interested in daily life skills. Since the concerns of this highway project both of my parents have become depressed and withdrawn in the care or upkeep of the farm. This mental concern and daily worry of the unknown has taking a toll on my parents.

Recently, I attended a meeting which as heightened my concerns about what the highway project will do to my residence and farm:

- As a local cattle farmer who has raised cattle on this property for over 20 years. The free range cattle is raised, feed and then sold for income. If the property has no pond or land how are we supposed to continue raising cattle or provide for my family?
- Highway 49 map/plans show an off ramp going to clear creek road. This off ramp will be within a 100- 150 ft. of my elderly parents' front door. I am worried about vagrants and looting. There will not be any friends or neighbors close to them. They will be all alone there. My parents' safety is of utmost importance to me! What about their safety?
- What are the plans for relocation?
- Will the state take the whole house or just the land?
- How are we supposed to carry on with the farm?
