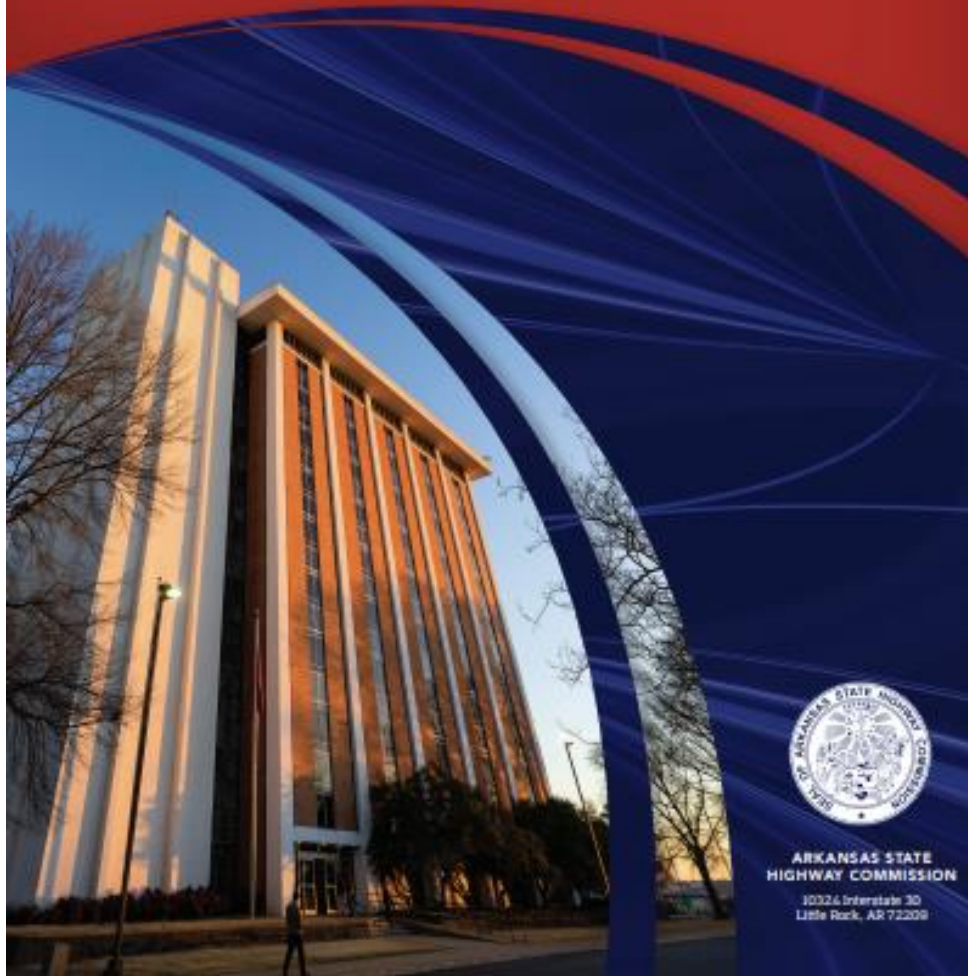

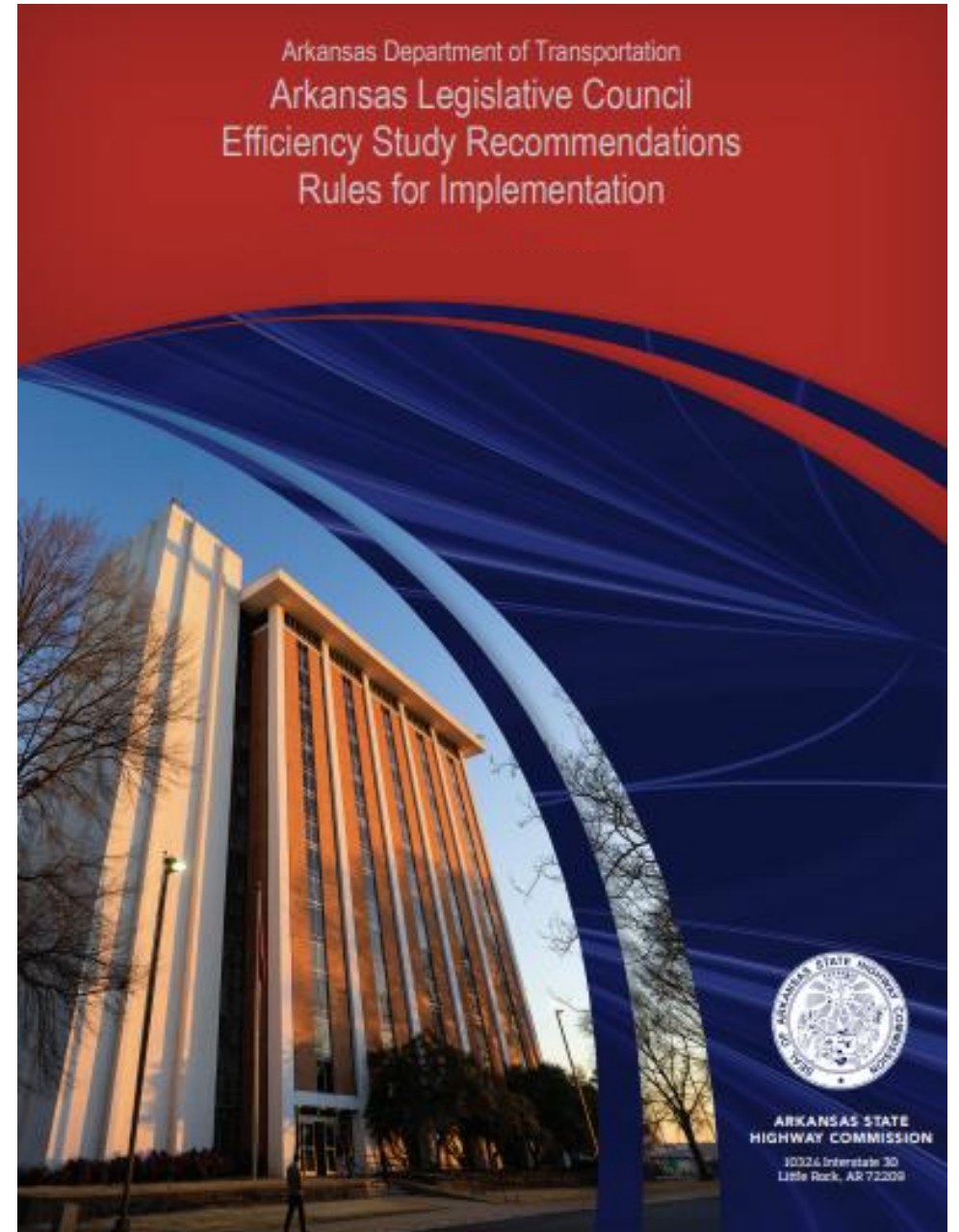

- Instructional video explains how to navigate the dashboard

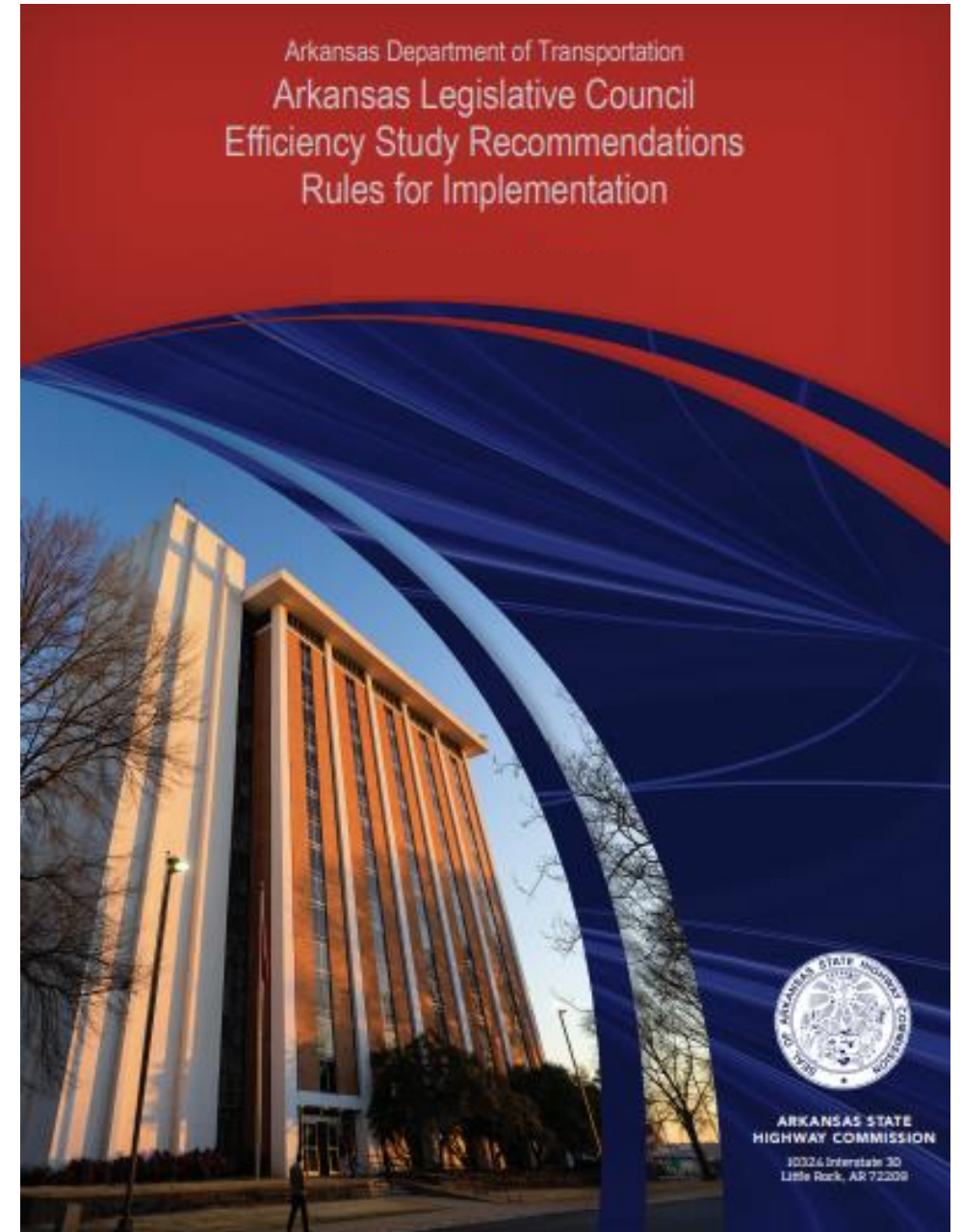

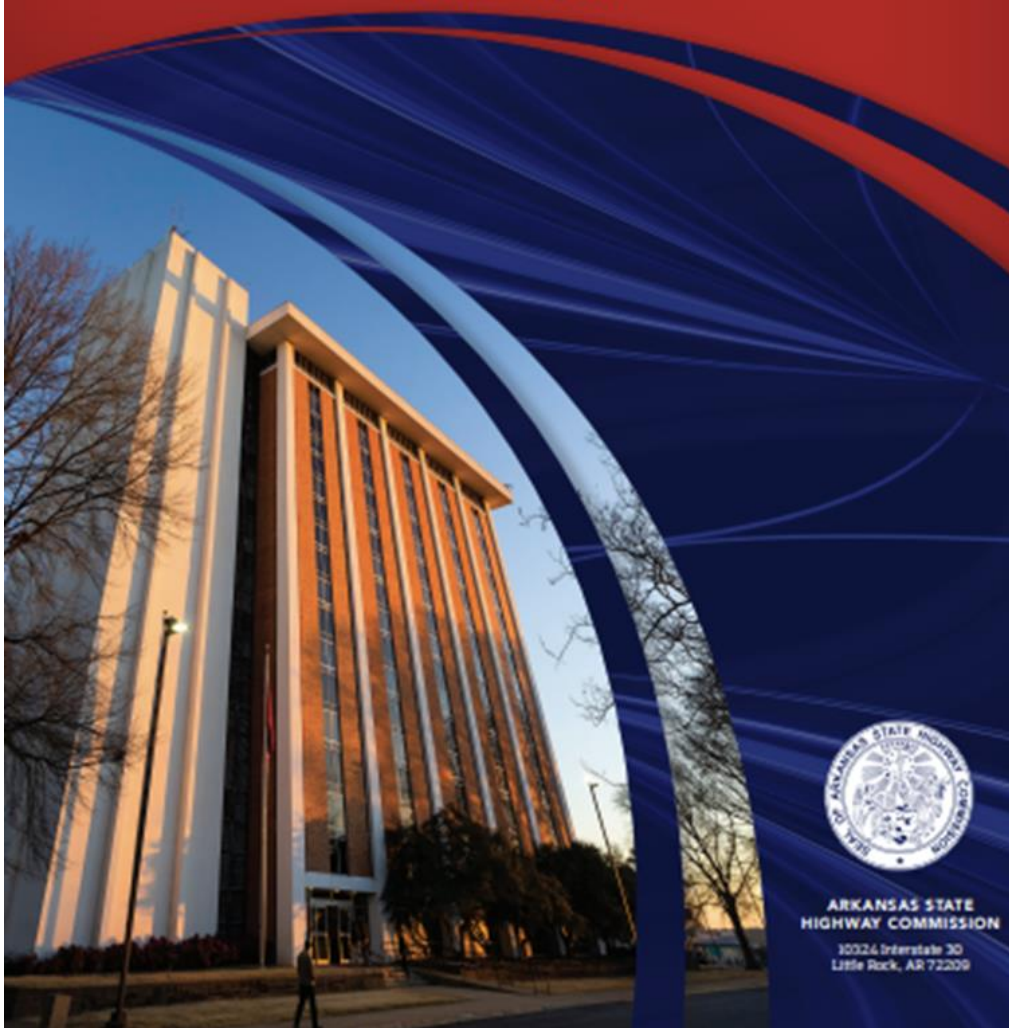

- Committee will soon be completing evaluation reports on the contractors

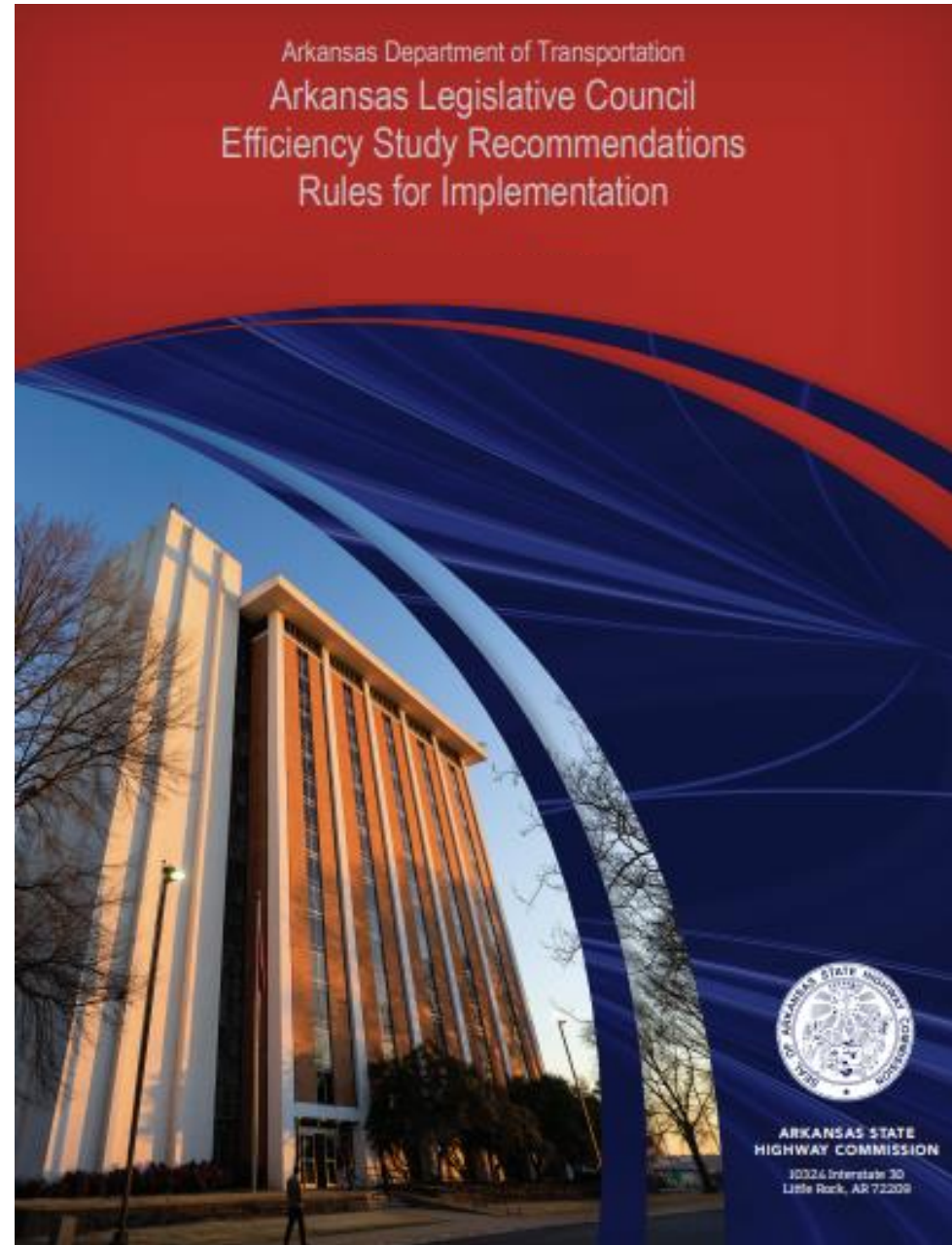

RECOMMENDATIONS #12 AND #13

Ensure staff can develop in their careers and improve staff capabilities to align with current/future organizational needs.

- Will soon launch the full Leadership Development Program, allowing employees who consider themselves future leaders to apply for entry
- Those accepted will participate in more focused leadership development activities
