Approval of minutes from October 25, 2024

A motion was made by Mr. Larry McCredy and seconded by Mr. Robert Husong. The motion was passed unanimously.

Chair Annabelle Tuck opened the meeting with a brief synopsis that Commissioners had agreed to give Arkansas Judges a 6% increase, to continue the historical increases of 95% of District Judges salaries for Division A Prosecutors and 85% of the Division A Prosecutors' salaries for Division B Prosecutors, and to increase salaries for Constitutional Officers and the General Assembly by 2%. She stated that this meeting is a formal approval of that recommendation and signing of the Resolution.

Chair Tuck then asked for oral public comments on the Proposed Salary Adjustment Resolution and there were none. Next, she asked if any written comments were received regarding the resolution and it was reported that none had been received.

Commissioners then reviewed the Salary Adjustment Resolution and Chair Tuck asked if there were any changes that needed to be made. Seeing that there were no changes the Resolution was signed by all members.

The next meeting date is set for Friday, October 17, 2025, at 10:00 a.m., in room 130 of the State Capitol Building.
