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
March Highlights

CTE Update

- March was a very successful month with 28 program completions and an additional 16 certificates issued.
- Since July 1, 2021, a total of 256 (127 program completions and 129 other certificates) have been issued.

This student is working on the Financial Literacy component of his program. Financial Literacy is a part of all 300+ hour CTE programs. Creating a budget, banking services, and borrowing basics are covered.
