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CTE Changes for the 2022-2023 School Year

- Horticulture at McPherson will close after currently enrolled students complete the program. Reasons for closing the program include:
 - Horticulture had the least student interest of the programs offered at McPherson.
 - Shorter programs and Industry Recognized Certifications will give previously ineligible inmates the opportunity to enroll in a CTE program.
 - Since the greenhouse needed extensive repairs, it made sense to make anticipated changes now.
- Building and Grounds Maintenance and Residential Carpentry at Varner will be taught by the same instructor. The programs are very similar. Students will choose which track they want to complete.
- Computer Applications Technology (ORCU, McP, PB) will transition from exclusively desktop computers to primarily iCEV on thin clients. This change will allow us to keep content up to date.
- The Computer Applications Technology lab will be a multipurpose lab. Some of the seats will be designated CAT (600 hour program), others will be for Industry Recognized Certifications offered through iCEV and NCCER
- Computer Science-Coding & Cybersecurity and Heavy Equipment Operator are both new, 600 hour programs
- Barbering will begin this fall at Grimes.
- Short courses such as Building Trades-Basics and Basic Residential Mechanics will be taught by existing staff in conjunction with other programs
- Pet Care & Management is currently offered at McPherson, but will soon be offered to PAWS trainers at other units.
- Installation of an iCEV lab at the Cummins Farm will make it possible for the farm workers to earn a variety of farm related industry recognized certifications such as: AMSA Meat Evaluation Certification, BASF Plant Science Certification, Unlimited Ecology Conservation & Management Certification, Elanco Veterinary Medical Applications, Elanco Fundamentals of Animal Science Certification, NCLCA Principles of Livestock Selection & Evaluation Certification, National Horse Judging Team Coaches Association Equine Management & Evaluation Certification
