COMMUNITY SUPERVISION AREA HIGHLIGHTS:

AREA 1

In June 2026, DEA Task Force Officer/Agent of the Arkansas Department of Corrections – Division of Community Correction, Community Supervision Services, Area 1 (Benton County), participated in an operational briefing with personnel from the Drug Enforcement Administration (DEA) and the Benton County Special Operations Unit (BCSOU) regarding a residence check and narcotics investigation involving an active parolee. Offender was in custody and identified their most recent residence. On the same date, TFO, along with BCSOU, and another Agent (ACC), responded to the residence to conduct a warrantless search pursuant to Offender's search waiver. Upon our arrival, we knocked on the door and were eventually greeted by a resident later identified as confirmed convicted felon. Prior to conducting the search, we identified the common areas of the residence and Offender's bedroom, which was shared with other felon. During the search of the bedroom, numerous male and female clothing items and personal hygiene products were observed. Concealed beneath a bathtub near the bedroom door, we located two firearms. The first firearm was identified as a Taurus .38 Special revolver contained inside a black holster. The second firearm was identified as a .410 two-shot Derringer contained inside a metal tin container. Additionally, located on a small table in the bedroom were numerous items of marijuana paraphernalia, approximately 10 grams of marijuana, and a metal spoon containing suspected methamphetamine residue. On the right side of the bed opposite the bathtub, between two pictures, was located a small container containing suspected methamphetamine. Offender was subsequently placed under arrest and transported to the Benton County Detention Center.

AREA 2

During the week of June 15, Arkansas Division of Community Corrections officers from the Mountain Home office, along with Community Supervision Officer Chris McGowan from the Mountain View office, Community Supervision Officer Hunter Boles from the Melbourne office, and Community Supervision Officers Denise Thormann and Paul Kirkdoffer, Community Supervision Supervisor/Expert Kenny Kendrick, and Community Supervision Manager Jennifer Dean from Sex Offender Services, joined forces with the United States Marshals Service and local county and city law enforcement officers in Baxter, Marion, and Searcy Counties for Operation "Eyes On" to conduct compliance checks on supervised and unsupervised registered sex offenders in the multi-county area. As a result of the compliance operation, a number of both supervised and unsupervised registered sex offenders were arrested and charged with offenses; including, Possession of a Firearm by Certain Persons, Failure to Maintain Sex Offender Registration Requirements, and Possession of Child

Pornography. Evidence that was collected by and/or turned over to law enforcement for further investigation included multiple unregistered electronic devices, cellphones, videogame consoles, external hard drives, and firearms. In preparation for this compliance operation, CSO Jeremy Wilson compiled information and built multiple probation and parole files for Baxter and Marion County supervised offenders. These files were used to ensure that the supervised offenders had warrantless search waivers on file, standard, as well as special, conditions were known, and to identify each offender's victim criminology so that teams would be prepared in their compliance searches.

AREA 3

On June 7th, 2026, the Area 4 Drug court team was invited by Jonesboro Juneor Harold Copenhaver to attend a meeting at his office where he recognized our staff for their service and dedication to treatment. A Proclamation was signed by the Juneor and a copy was presented to us. The Hon. Judge Melissa Richardson, members of her staff, and several local dignitaries were also in attendance. Refreshments were enjoyed. Those in attendance from our office were CSO III Ashley Self, CSO III Michael Hopkins, Program Specialist Kady Greer, and Administrative Specialist Angela Hopewell.

AREA 4

On Tuesday, June 16, 2026, Agents with the Area 4 Osceola Office were invited to attend the President's Council Luncheon at Arkansas Northeastern College. During the luncheon, CSO III Mary Marshall, CSO III Drug Court Stephanie Wofford, and CSO III Amanda Cutler were presented with a plaque recognizing this office for "Outstanding Service as a Community Partner with Arkansas Northeastern College".

Completed ACA Audit at the Clarksville Office.

AREA 6

On June 3, 2026, Agent Chelsea Slechta and Officer Chris Jones took offenders out in the community to assist Morrilton Parks and Recreation with cleaning up the Morrilton City Park. Offenders scaped and painted the gazebo, picnic

tables, bathroom floors, and helped move bleachers from the tennis court and pickleball court in preparation for the pickleball tournament coming up at the end of June.

AREA 7/8

On Thursday, June 11, 2026, made their way to 116 Johnson Dr. Sherwood, AR 72120, regarding the whereabouts of Vontrel Cochran (PID 242030) a level 2 Sex Offender, who was believed to be living at the address without registering with the city of Sherwood. Research revealed that the address was the reported address for Alexandra Coulter (PID 379494) and active probationer. It was discovered that Coulter was under a no contact order from Jacksonville Circuit Court with Cochran, due to a case out of Jacksonville where she is the defendant and Cochran was the victim of Aggravated Assault and Battery 2nd. Officers observed Coulter's vehicle parked a block away from her reported address at the Casey's Gas Station located at 10340 AR-107, Sherwood, AR 72120 on pump 15. Coulter and Cochran were observed inside the vehicle, LR-ISP contacted Sherwood PD for assistance in case of the offenders fleeing. Upon arrival of Sherwood PD, Coulter's vehicle was blocked in and contact was made. Both offenders were taken into custody and searched. A search was conducted of the offenders and the vehicle. A Colt BB gun was located in the trunk of the vehicle with Cochran's belongings. Coulter was taken into custody for violation of her Protection Order. Cochran was instructed to register his new address and the replica firearm was taken, and a verbal warning was issued.

AREA 9

June 8, 2026, Administrative Specialist II, Shantranique Batton coordinated with the County Extension. Agent - Family & Consumer Science, Tori Luker wo (2) Life and Social Skills classes. The class focused on teaching offenders about personal finance and how to manage their money to sustain their household. There were a total of 6 participants. .

AREA 10

06/24/2026: CSA Tiffani Childers and CSA Jennifer Starkey conducted a home visit on Jacob Vandergrift PID#0356606 listed residence after a female called the office stating that Vandergrift was passed out coming off drugs and that he would not let his girlfriend leave the house. As I was attempting to call MPD, Officer Norton called and I advised him I was on my way. After arriving at the residence, Life Net was already there. Officers made contact with Vandergrift and three females. One was his mother, one his girlfriend and one a cousin. The cousin and girlfriend told us where the drugs were. There was a black box with stickers on it, under the table in Vandergrift's bedroom. Inside the box was a red pipe, a metal pipe, a glass pipe, a weed grinder and a pill grinder with a partial pill inside. There was also a clear container that had a glass pipe, rolling papers and a baggie with suspected meth inside. There was a bag of syringes located on the table. There was also a broken glass pipe in a small wooden box with drawers that was on a shelf. Malvern PD took the drugs and paraphernalia as evidence. Vandergrift was cleared by medical and refused to go to the hospital. He was transported to the HSC jail. Parole hold placed and will complete a VR. Drugs seized weighed approximately 0.8grams of methamphetamine.

AREA 11

On 6-15-26 Agent Parker and Agent Graydon conducted a home visit at offender Heidi Cash PID 0032378 listed residence of 2850 Rodgers Road W, Rison, Arkansas 71665. Contact was made with offender Cash and as Agent Parker was entering the residence to conduct a home inspection he spotted Probation absconder Lance Lea PID 0222256 attempting to flee out of the back door Agent Parker gave pursuit exiting the back of the residence and ordering offender Lea to stop. Offender Lea stopped. Agent Parker ordered him to return he walked back over and when he came back over to the back porch Agent Parker saw offender Lea pull an object from his pocket and throw it toward the direction underneath the porch. Agent Parker placed offender Lea in hand restraints Agent Graydon came around the corner and held security on offender Lea while Agent Parker conducted a search. Underneath the porch Agent Parker located a clear plastic baggie with a white crystal like substance suspected of being methamphetamine. Agent Parker also searched a vehicle in the back yard that Cash identified as hers but no contraband was located. A search was conducted of the residence and inside offender Cash's bedroom Agent Parker located a pill bottle with offender Heidi Cash's name on it. It was covered by a plastic wrap and the lid a hole cut in it. In it was urine used to adulterate drug specimens. Offender Cash said it was old and it must be offender Leas. Agent Parker called the Cleveland County Sheriffs department and Spoke to Chief Deputy Gary Young. He requested Agents transport offender Lea and the evidence to the sheriffs department. Agents Graydon and Parker transported Offender Lea and the evidence to the Cleveland County Sheriffs department where he was charged with possession of methamphetamine a supplemental violation report will be submitted to the Cleveland County prosecutors office.

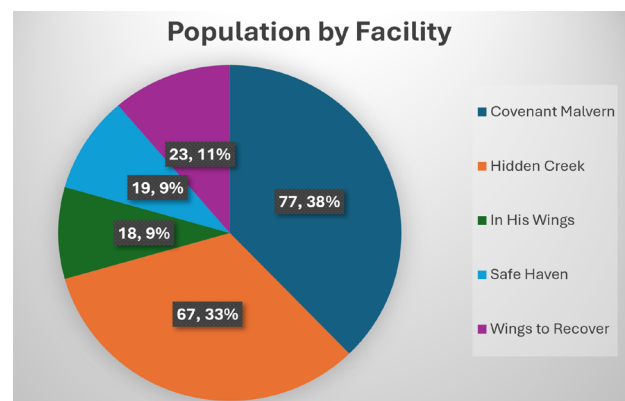

REENTRY PROGRAM CONTINUED:

REENTRY OFFICERS:

In June, 150 Reentry residents was reported to be employed and 19 residents were reported to be ineligible for employment at this time. Reentry Officers reported 4 education referrals, which resulted in enrollments.

Reentry Officers conducted 19 reentry facility office visits, 131 Phase IV office visits, 31 Phase IV home visits and 79 pre-parole plan verifications. Reentry Officers made 28 community contacts within their assigned area during the month and conducted 45 office visits in their area. There was 1 Good Grid class conducted across the state with 7 in attendance, 7 job fairs were held with 90 in attendance and 3 Department workforce class was held with 68 in attendance



TRANSITIONAL HOUSING:

There are 13 licensed vendor facilities with 493 beds (406 DOC funded) in the facilities. Within the transitional facilities, there are 226 residents who have obtained full-time employment.

In June, 293 residents who previously received their GED or high school diploma and 5 were enrolled in GED programs. During the month, there were 27 registered sex offenders living in transitional facilities. A total of 23 residents received their driver's license, 95 received an ID card, 116 received their Social Security card and 13 received birth certificates.

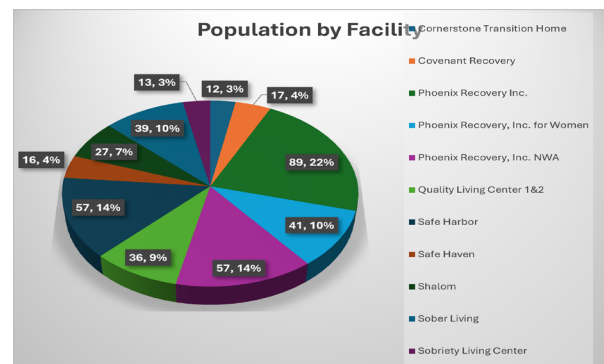
A total of 60 residents graduated from the Transitional Housing program, 32 absconded and 19 were dismissed.

REENTRY PROGRAM:

REENTRY FACILITIES:

As of June 30, ACC had five licensed Reentry Facilities with 204 total residents in Phases I-IV of the Reentry program. Since the program began, there have been 3,477 individuals who have successfully completed and graduated from the program.

During the month, 1 residents were enrolled in GED. 2 residents enrolled in Wage with 2 completing. A total of 8 Reentry Facility residents received their driver's license, 15 received an ID card, 18 received their Social Security Cards, 7 received birth certificates.

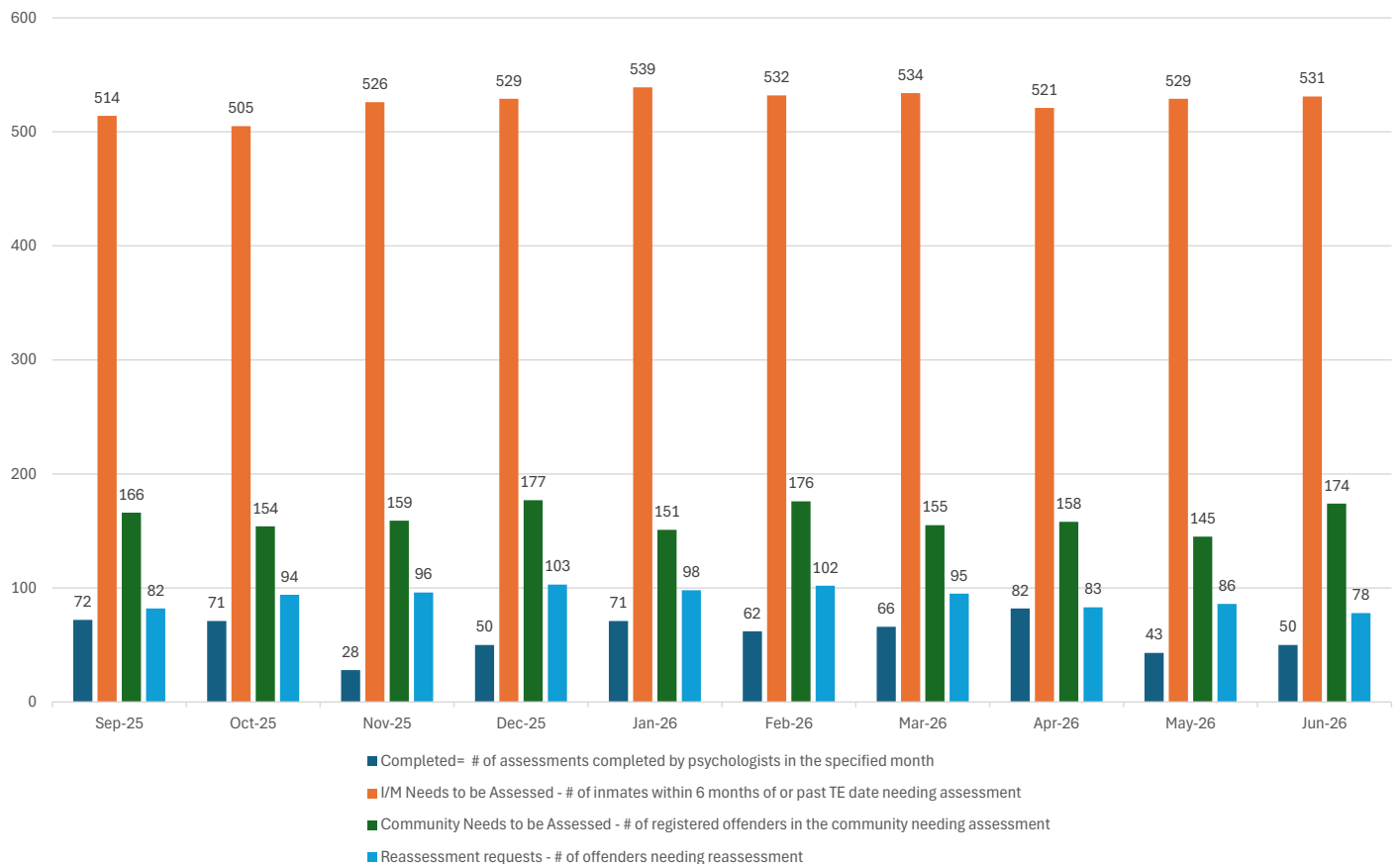

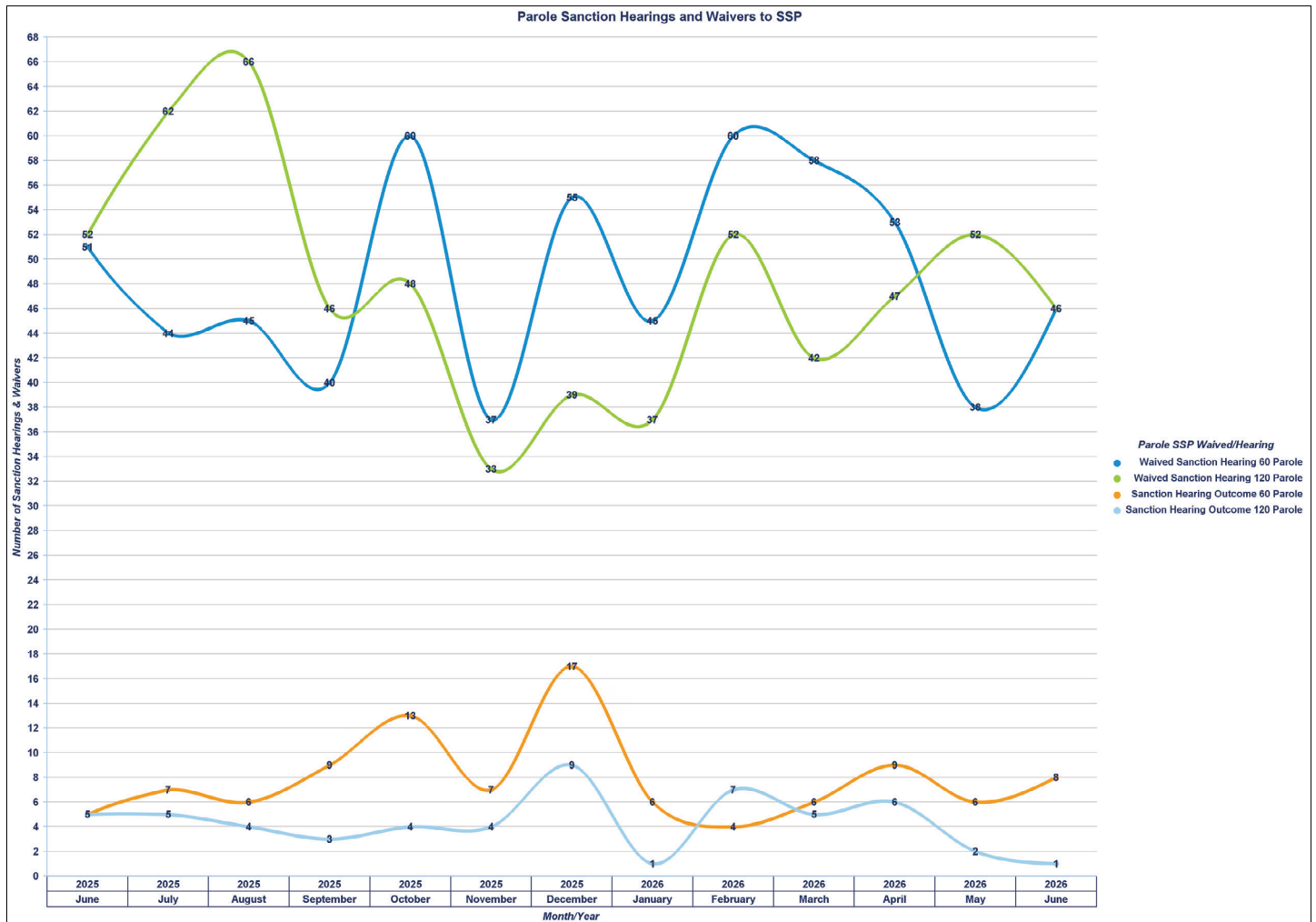
