COMMUNITY SUPERVISION AREA HIGHLIGHTS:

AREA 1

Area 1 has transitioned to MIN/MAX officer caseloads in all applicable offices. All Area 1 staff have enrolled or taken the new ICOTS training.

AREA 2

On February 26, Community Supervision Officers Cody Bruyette, Zach Perry, and Hunter Boles conducted a home visit in IZARD County with the assistance of an IZARD County sheriff's deputy. The home visit was initiated by an office visit in which an offender admitted to using illegal controlled substances. Officers intended to search the offender's vehicle, but the offender was dropped off by another supervised offender who had left in the vehicle. The offender willingly provided information which made it possible to locate the vehicle. Officers drove to the location of the vehicle, which happened to be the residence of yet another supervised offender. Officers were granted entry to the residence and multiple items of drug paraphernalia were discovered. The offender provided his cellular device for search and photos were discovered containing illegal controlled substances, drug paraphernalia, and firearms. Also, messages were found where the offender had made several deals involving the purchase and sale of illegal controlled substances. Three individuals were taken into custody by IZARD County Sheriff's Department, and all evidence was turned over to the 16th Judicial District Drug Task Force.

AREA 3

On March 24, 2026, CSO III Mike Jones and CSO III Jonathan Johnson assisted Newport Police Department with the execution of a search warrant at parole/probationer Stoney Storey's residence. Upon entry, contact was made with Storey, his fiancée (Samantha Jones), and two minor children. Storey and Jones were detained in handcuffs while residence was searched. Officers with Newport Police Department located a large quantity of methamphetamine inside the master bath. Some were packaged in ziplock style baggies, and a significant amount was located in a purple Crown Royal bag that was wrapped in tape. Various items of drug paraphernalia were also located during the search. Newport Police Department and Jackson County Sheriff's Office documented all evidence and contraband found. The estimated amount of methamphetamine located during the search was approximately 593 grams.

AREA 4

The Craighead County Drug Court held a graduation ceremony on Tuesday, March 17, 2026 for 5 participants. These 5 participants put in hard work and dedication to complete this program. Guest speakers included Jennifer Barber from His Mercy House and Shane Gulley, a graduate of the Craighead County Drug Court.

AREA 5

On March 18, representatives from Restore Hope and 100 Families of

Crawford and Sebastian Counties met with representatives from the Arkansas Department of Corrections, Division of Community Correction (DCC), to strengthen their partnership in support of Governor Sarah Huckabee Sanders' Recidivism Reduction Pilot Program.

AREA 6

Community Supervision Officers Scott Mercer and Deidre Thurman helped raise over 6,000.00 for local scholarships with a fundraiser at the Rover Fire Department. This event is one of many sponsored by the Buffton Masonic Lodge that was awarded college scholarships to local Yell County graduates. The community came out in support, many dinners were served and a pie auction was held.

AREA 7/8

On Thursday, March 12th, 2026, I, Officer J. Fernandez received a telephone call from Barbara Douglas at approximately 1630 HRS regarding Offender Gabriel Castaneda (PID 259509). Ms. Douglas stated that she was the aunt of Castaneda's girlfriend Erika Vallejo, who was assaulted by Castaneda on this date. Ms. Douglas provided me with the contact information for Vallejo and contact was attempted successfully. Ms. Vallejo provided a brief account of the incident, and provided me with the Little Rock Police Incident Report number (2026-02-9826) and the Detective taking over her case. At approximately 1930 HRS, contact was made with the LRPD Major Crimes Detective in charge of the case. The Detective provided me with a brief of the case and advised that Castaneda had fled on foot when LRPD officers attempted to apprehend him. At approximately 0237 HRS on Friday, March 13, 2026, Ms. Vallejo contacted this officer and advised that Castaneda had been trying to contact her from a new phone number (501-485-2355). Ms. Vallejo was advised to ignore the calls and stay away from Castaneda. At approximately 0745 HRS, Castaneda texted this officer from the afore given number, stating that he was aware of the situation that he was being alleged of being a part of and that they were false allegations against him. I advised Castaneda, that LRPD Detectives wanted to speak with him regarding his side of the story, but Castaneda refused to cooperate and turn himself in. At

approximately 0755 HRS contact was made with LRPD Detectives, and they were advised that Castaneda was reaching out to this Officer. The Detective stated that he had other Officers monitoring the area, and they had seen Castaneda return to the house earlier that morning. I advised the Detective that I would be en-route to 8406 Seymour Dr. Little Rock AR 72209 (Castaneda's listed address on file), to meet up with LRPD Officers and Detectives. At approximately 0845, I, and the LRPD Officers and Detectives met up and conducted a pre-operations briefing. At approximately 0853 HRS, I called Castaneda at the aforementioned number and simultaneously knocked on the door. Castaneda answered the phone and was instructed to open the door, as I could hear the knocking from my phone. Castaneda opened the door, LRPD Officers and I made contact and apprehended Castaneda without incident. Castaneda was transported to LRPD 12th St. Station where he was Mirandized, questioned and subsequently charged and booked for Domestic Battery 1st; Kidnapping; and Terroristic Threatening 1st, by LRPD.

AREA 9

On 03/12/2026, Area 9 Transport Team CSO Charles Maxwell and CSO Melvin Pitts transported Offenders Cory Martinez ADC#660814 and Nathan McAfee ADC#173204 from Dallas Texas back to Hope Arkansas for Area 6 to transport back to their area and for Area 2 to transport back to their area.

AREA 11

On 3/12/26 at approximately 9:43 AM, this Agent and Agent Katrina Barrow conducted a home visit 516 W Shelton in Monticello. This is the reported residence of Parolee Arnold White. Agents made contact with White and Probationer Cynimon Harris. A search of the residence was conducted. Agent Barrow located a silver "ipsy" zipper bag. She alerted this Agent that she had located syringes. Harris stated that the syringes were for her diabetes. This Agent inquired when she was diagnosed with diabetes. Harris replied that it was recent. This Agent then inquired where Harris' insulin was and she stated that she didn't have any with her. This Agent examined the contents of the bag. It contained 2 syringes, a glass bottle with clear liquid, a glass jar with leafy green residue, and feminine hygiene products. Harris stated that the clear liquid was water for her knee and the leafy green was Marijuana. This Agent inquired if the syringes were sent to the Crime Lab would they test positive for methamphetamine or insulin. Harris dropped her head and did not answer. Agent Barrow also located a small plastic bag with crystalline residue in the ash tray. All items were confiscated to be turned over to Drug Task Force. Upon arrival the office, this Agent more closely examined the syringes and noticed that one contained liquid. On 3/13/26, Sgt Parker Carter used the TruNarc on the confiscated items. The syringe showed to be positive for amphetamine/methamphetamine. The bottle of the clear liquid was inconclusive.

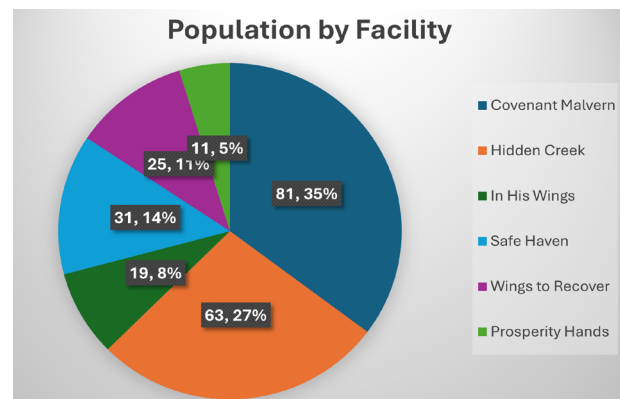

REENTRY PROGRAM CONTINUED:**REENTRY OFFICERS:**

In March, 164 Reentry residents was reported to be employed and 25 residents were reported to be ineligible for employment at this time. Reentry Officers reported 3 education referrals, which resulted in enrollments.

Reentry Officers conducted 205 reentry facility office visits, 116 Phase IV office visits, 20 Phase IV home visits and 69 pre-parole plan verifications. Reentry Officers made 58 community contacts within their assigned area during the month and conducted 56 office visits in their area. There was 1 Good Grid class conducted across the state with 4 in attendance, 3 job fairs were held with 18 in attendance and 1 Department workforce class was held.

TRANSITIONAL HOUSING:

There are 13 licensed vendor facilities with 495 beds (409 DOC funded) in the facilities. Within the transitional facilities, there are 208 residents who have obtained full-time employment.

In March, 309 residents who previously received their GED or high school diploma. During the month, there were 43 registered sex offenders living in transitional facilities.

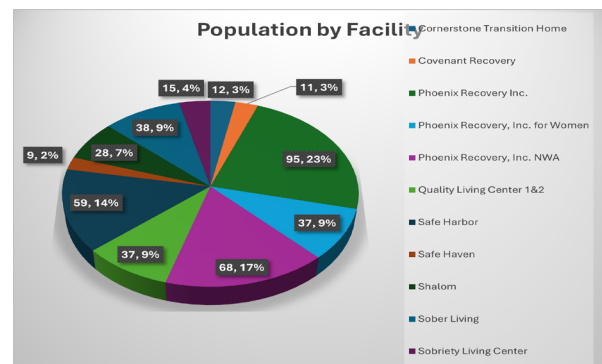
A total of 14 residents received their driver's license, 134 received an ID card, 122 received their Social Security card and 24 received birth certificates.

A total of 69 residents graduated from the Transitional Housing program, 29 absconded and 14 were dismissed.

REENTRY PROGRAM:**REENTRY FACILITIES:**

As of March 31, ACC had six licensed Reentry Facilities with 230 total residents in Phases I-IV of the Reentry program. Since the program began, there have been 3,477 individuals who have successfully completed and graduated from the program.

During the month, 14 residents were enrolled in CRC with 3 completed CRC. 6 residents were enrolled in GED. 5 residents enrolled in Wage with 8 completing. A total of 25 Reentry Facility residents received their driver's license, 32 received an ID card, 44 received their Social Security Cards, 26 received birth certificates.

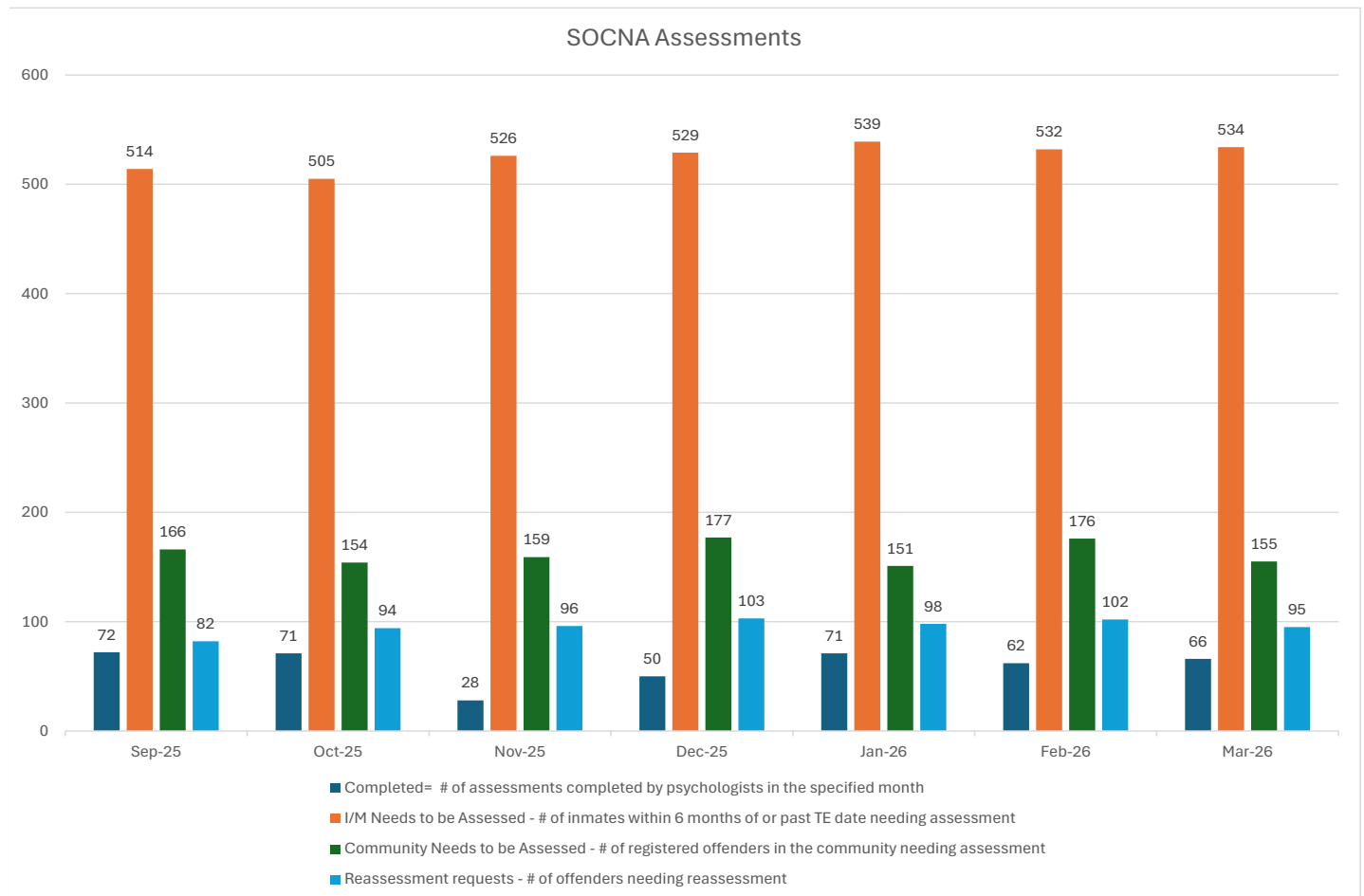

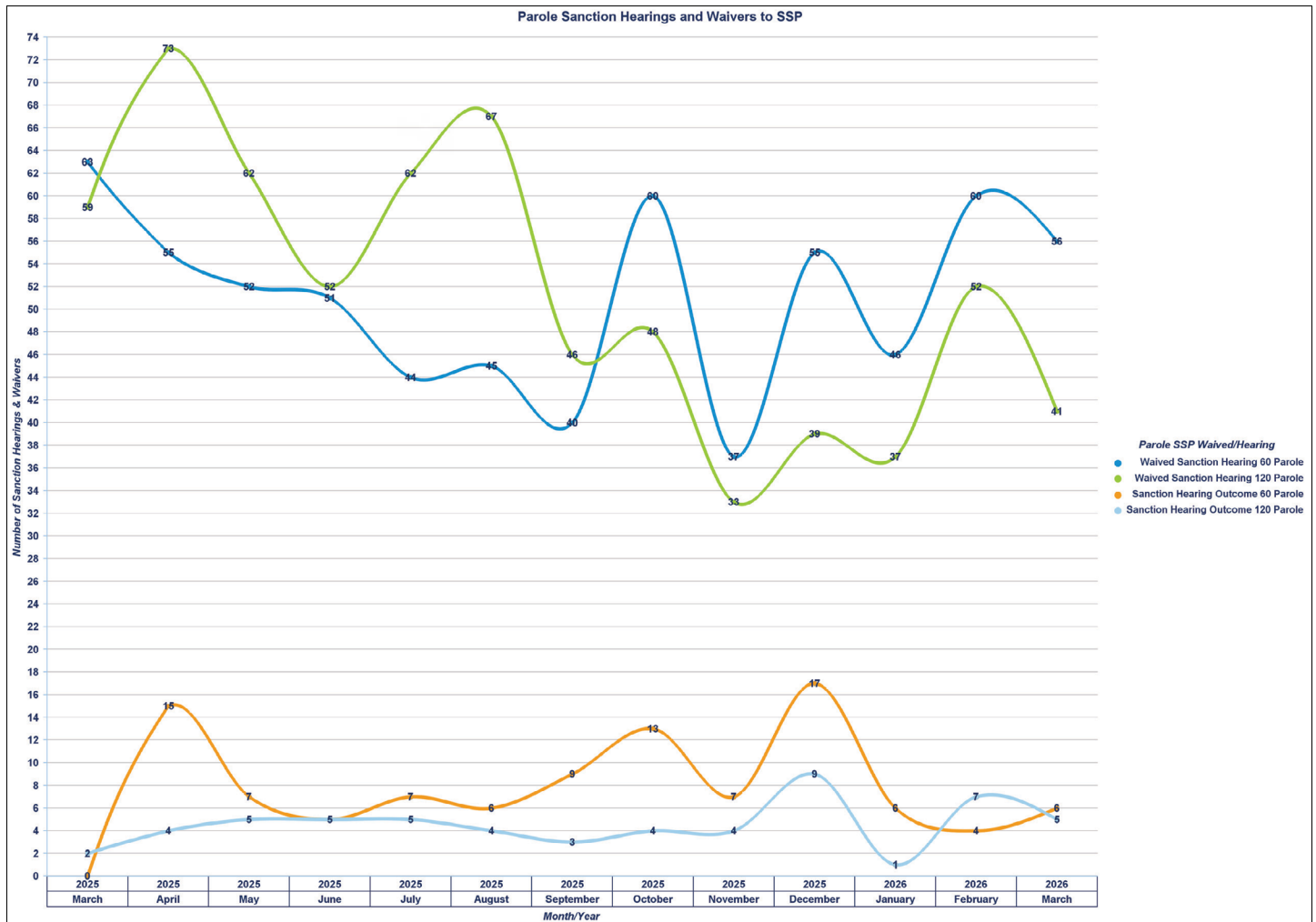
