POPULATION REPORT

RESEARCH/PLANNING

June 2026 Admissions and Releases – Admissions for June 2026 totaled 383 (345-males and 38-females) while releases totaled 336 (289-males and 47-females) for a net increase of 47 inmates.

Inmate Population Growth/Projection – At the end of June 2026, the jurisdictional population for the Division of Correction totaled **19,454**, representing an increase of **395** inmates since the first of January 2026. At reporting time, calendar year 2026 has seen a increase of **66** inmates per month, which is down from an average monthly increase of 18 inmates per month during calendar year 2025.

Average County Jail Backup – The backup in the county jails averaged **2,360** inmates per day during the month of June 2026, which was up from the per-day average of **2,307** inmates during the month of May 2026. Of the **2,360** average, short-term revocations averaged **97** during the month of June 2026.

House Bill 1530/Restrictive Housing (RH) - April thru June 2026 -

There was a 6.5% increase in the overall RH assignments the 2nd Quarter of 2026 compared to the 1st Quarter of 2026
There was a 19.3% increase in the number of guilty major disciplinarys this Quarter compared to the 1st Quarter of 2026
There was an increase in the assigned to RH for protective custody, who are twenty-one and younger, who are fifty-five & older and those with SMI diagnosis
There was one suicide and thirty-three attempted suicides this Quarter of those assigned to RH
The number of deaths remained the same this Quarter of those who were assigned to RH

INSTITUTIONS

INMATE INSTITUTIONAL GRIEVANCES

Inmate Formal/Informal Grievances: During June, a total of 1,175 formal grievances and 1,439 informal grievances were filed at various ADC Facilities.

Institutional Grievances Appeals: There was a total of 523 appeals of institutional grievances received in June. Of those, 380 were acknowledged and 143 were rejected for various reasons. Of the total, 440 appeals answered, 440 had no merit and 0 had merit.

Resident Formal/Informal Grievances: During June, a total of 69 formal grievances and 308 informal grievances were filed at various Residential Centers.

Institutional Grievances Appeals: There was 56 appeals of institutional grievances received in June. Of those, 23 was acknowledged and 33 were rejected for various reasons.

FARM DIVISION

Row Crop/Garden Division - June had increased yields and Cummins inmate manhours increased to over 2,000 more than last month.

Beef-herd/hay Division- Sold 300 cows & heifers from the Cummin and Wrightville herds.

Dairy Division- Milk production dipped slightly.

Poultry Division- Egg production has increased to over 19,000 laid per day. Hen population is slowly decreasing due to the heat, down approximately 3,000 since May 2026.

There are 2,719 males on the waiting list for RSVP and 30 females on the waiting list for SOFT who are within five years of their TE date. Of those, two (2) inmates are mandated by the Post Prison Transfer Board.

The average time on the waiting list from request is between one and two months for those stipulated.

*The total on the waiting list, including those not currently within the identified time frame, is 2,719 males and zero females. Of these, 1,031 is eligible and 1,523 are ineligible for the program. There are zero (0) PREA inmate in the program at this time.

*Ineligibility is due to being in restrictive housing, having class IV status, or receiving a major disciplinary within the last 60 days.

Ouachita River Correctional Unit (ORCU) Residential Program Unit (RPU):

The RPU had 4 admissions and 13 discharges in June for an end-of-month count of 193.

McPherson Unit Mental Health Residential Program Unit (RPU):

There were 2 admissions and 3 discharges in June for an end-of-month count of 30.

Habilitation Program:

The Habilitation Program at the Ouachita River Correctional Unit provided treatment services to 38 inmates in June. There was no admissions or discharges, which resulted in an end-of-month count of 38.

Suicide:

There were 156 suicidal threats in June. There were 4 attempts, 1 of which resulted in death.

County Jail Back-up Average for June 2026 - 2,360

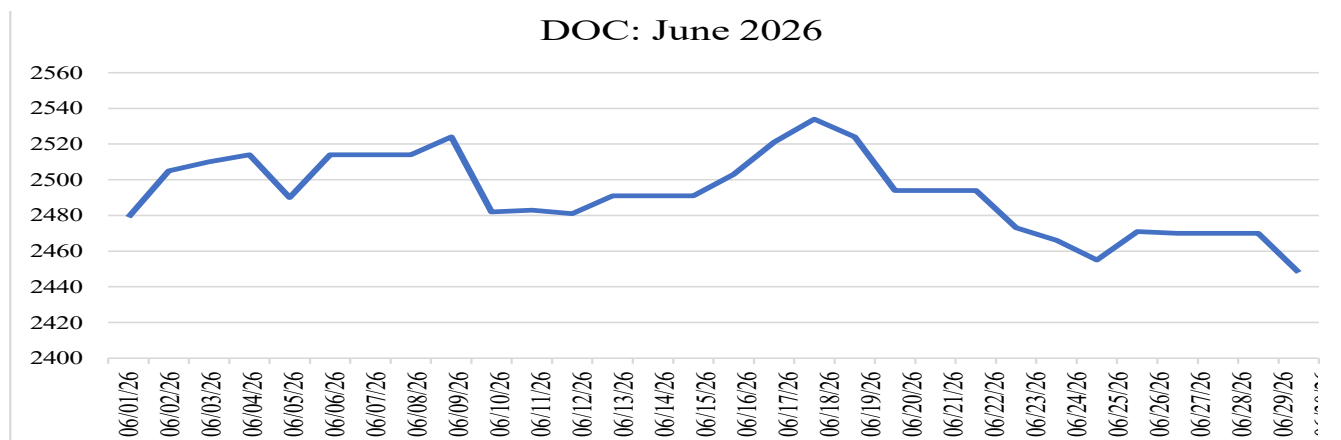
County Jail Back-up Fiscal Year Average as of June 30, 2026 - 1,956

Short-Term Revocation Program Fiscal Year Average as of June 30, 2026 - 92

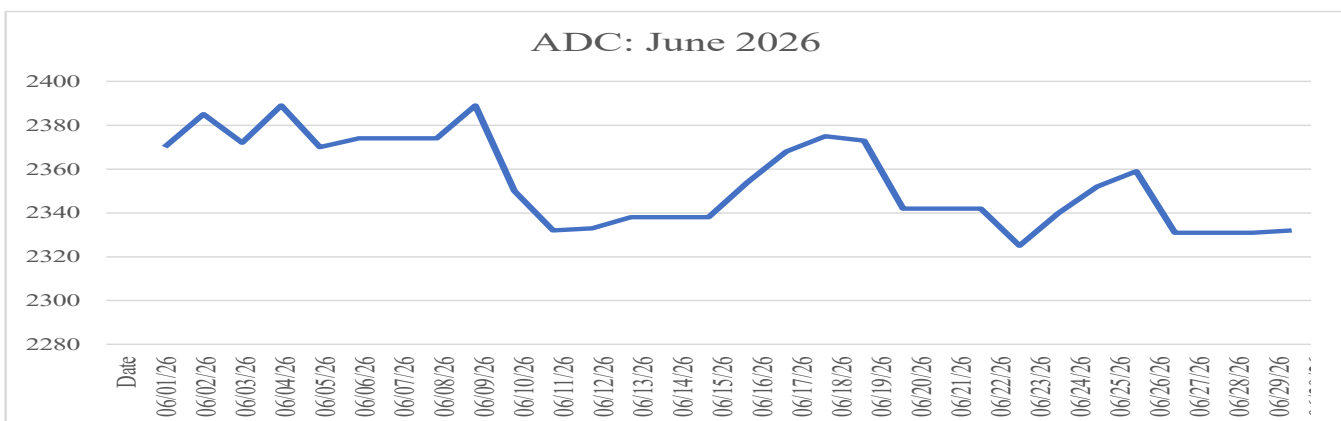
COUNTY JAIL BACKUP - JUNE 2026

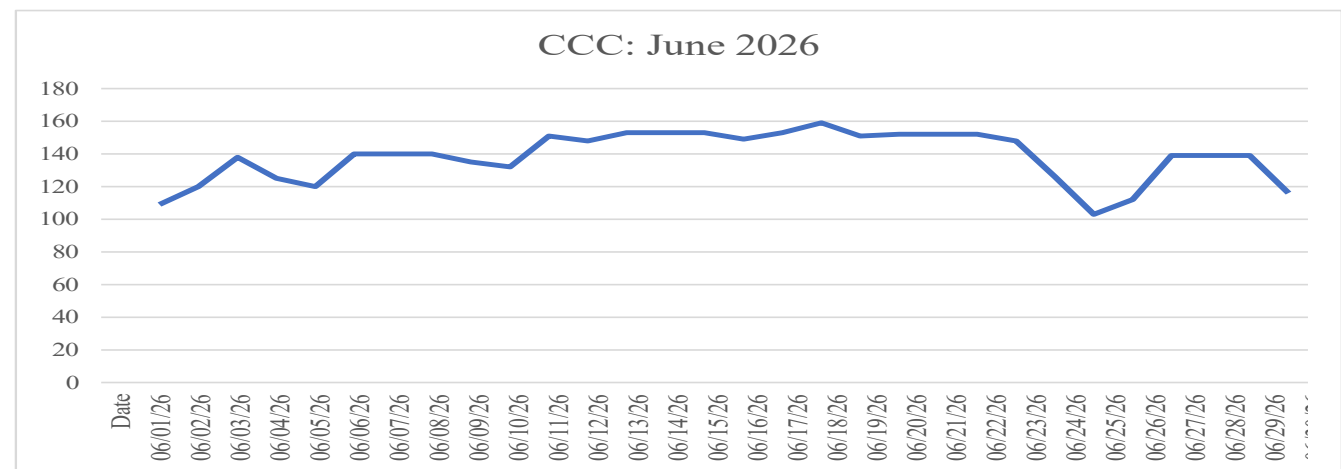

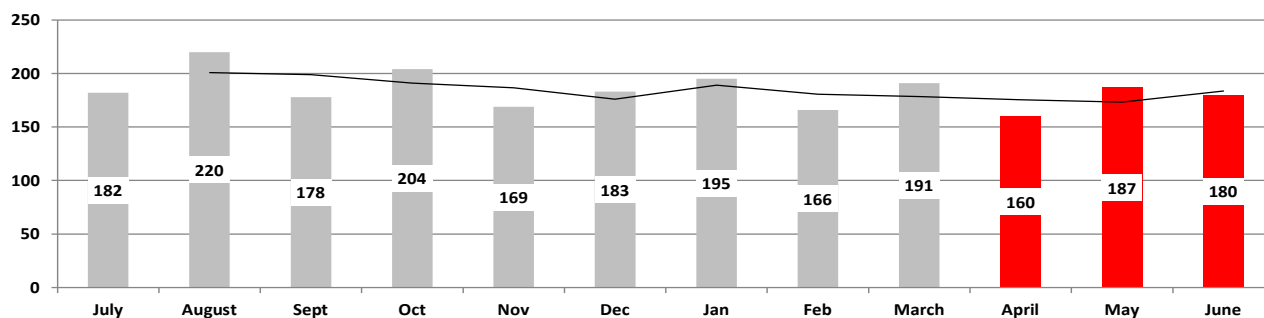
ADC Admissions & Hospital Days

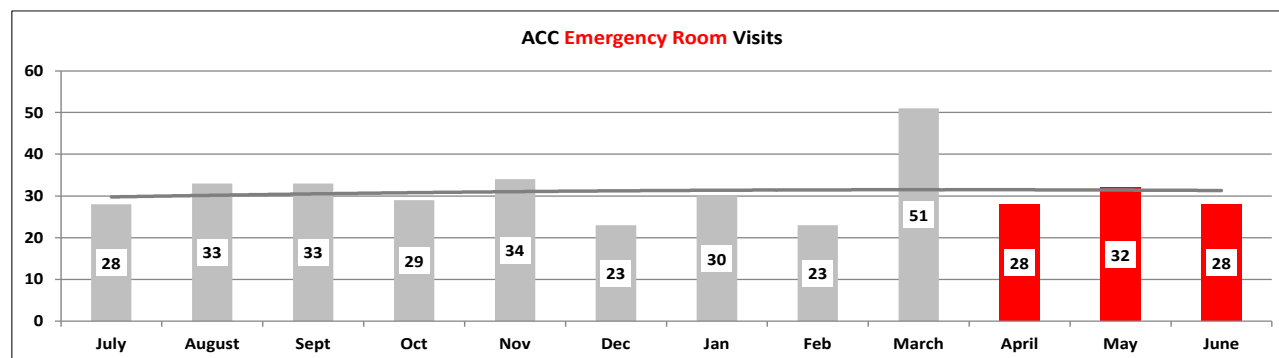
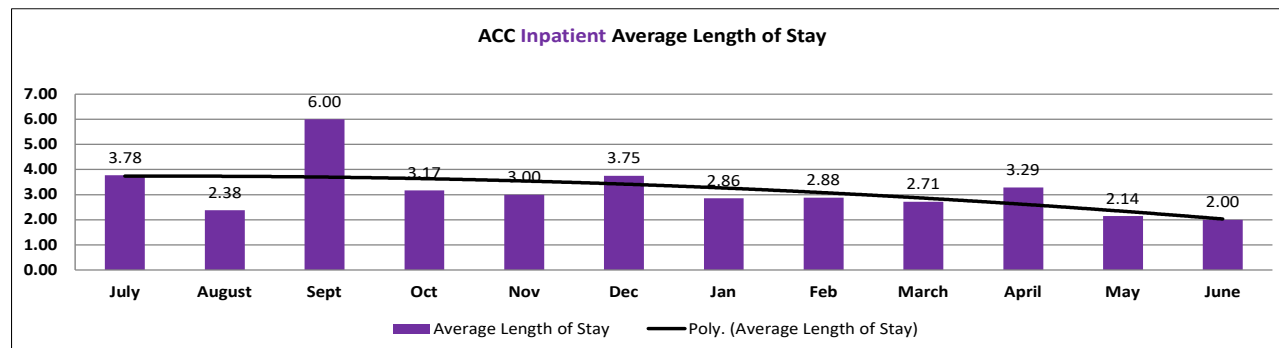
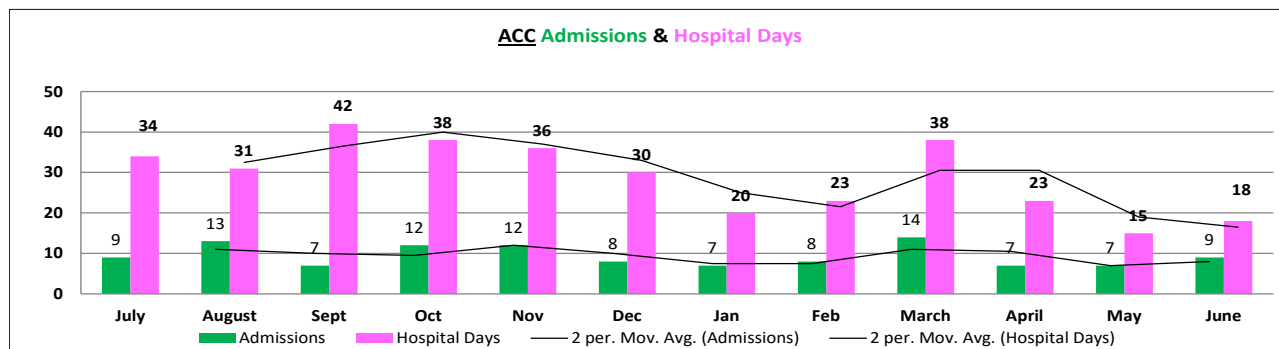
