POPULATION REPORT

RESEARCH/PLANNING

February 2026 Admissions and Releases – Admissions for February 2026 totaled **332** (276-males and 56-females) while releases totaled 293 (249-males and 44-females) for a net increase of 39 inmates.

Inmate Population Growth/Projection – At the end of February 2026, the jurisdictional population for the Division of Correction totaled **19,190**, representing an increase of **131** inmates since the first of January 2026. At reporting time, calendar year 2026 has seen a increase of **66** inmates per month, which is down from an average monthly increase of **18** inmates per month during calendar year 2025.

Average County Jail Backup – The backup in the county jails averaged **2,066** inmates per day during the month of February 2026, which was up from the per-day average of **1,1,936** inmates during the month of January 2026. Of the **2,066** average, short-term revocations averaged **33** during the month of January 2026.

INSTITUTIONS

INMATE INSTITUTIONAL GRIEVANCES

Inmate Formal/Informal Grievances: During February, a total of 1,370 formal grievances and 1,780 informal grievances were filed at various ADC Facilities.

Institutional Grievances Appeals: There was a total of 440 appeals of institutional grievances received in February. Of those, 299 were acknowledged and 141 were rejected for various reasons. Of the total, 275 appeals answered, 273 had no merit and 2 had merit.

Resident Formal/Informal Grievances: During February, a total of 30 formal grievances and 180 informal grievances were filed at various Residential Centers.

Institutional Grievances Appeals: There was 67 appeals of institutional grievances received in February. Of those, 31 was acknowledged and 36 were rejected for various reasons.

FARM DIVISION

Row Crop/Garden Division - Spent the month in the shops getting equipment ready for planting and working up the garden ground to be planted.

Beef-herd/hay Division- Calving should start early March.

Dairy Division- Consistently milking approx. 60 head with consistent production.

Poultry Division- operations continues to struggle with no supervisors that have poultry experience.

Notes- Seed bids went out for corn, soybeans and rice. We decided against having a horse sale this year due to the horse demand going up at units to accommodate new officer.

There are 1053 males on the waiting list for RSVP and 32 females on the waiting list for SOFT who are within five years of their TE date. Of those, four (4) inmates are mandated by the Post Prison Transfer Board.

The average time on the waiting list from request is between one and two months for those stipulated.

*The total on the waiting list, including those not currently within the identified time frame, is 1,994 males and zero females. Of these, 1 is eligible and 1,053 are ineligible for the program. There is one (1) PREA inmate in the program at this time.

***Ineligibility is due to being in restrictive housing, having class IV status, or receiving a major disciplinary within the last 60 days.**

Ouachita River Correctional Unit (ORCU) Residential Program Unit (RPU):

The RPU had 14 admissions and 9 discharge in February for an end-of-month count of 112.

McPherson Unit Mental Health Residential Program Unit (RPU):

There were 3 admissions and 2 discharges in February for an end-of-month count of 23.

Habilitation Program:

The Habilitation Program at the Ouachita River Correctional Unit provided treatment services to 39 inmates in February. There was 1 admissions and 3 discharges, which resulted in an end-of-month count of 37.

Suicide:

There were 145 suicidal threats in February. There were 10 attempts, none of which resulted in death.

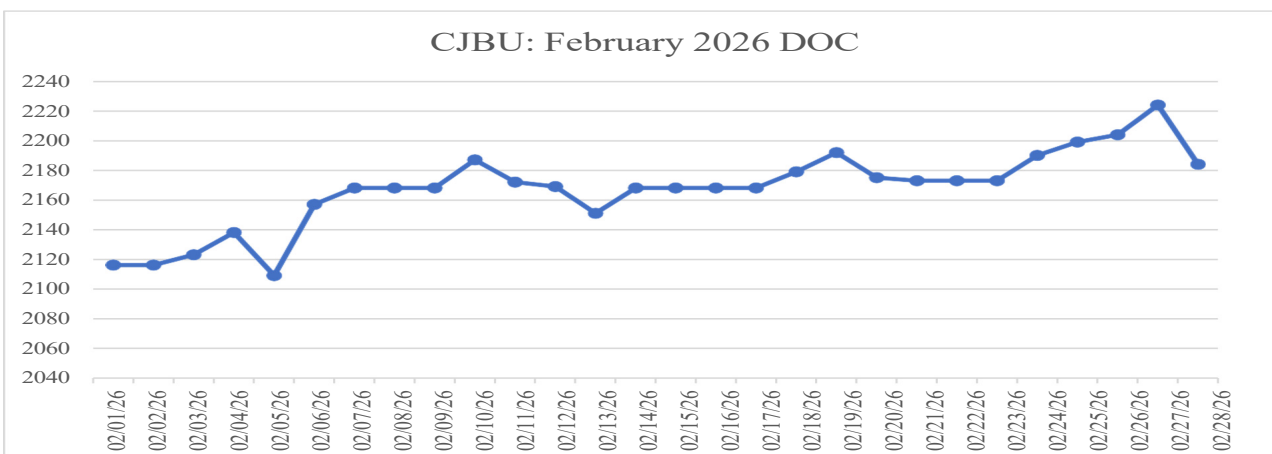
County Jail Back-up Average for February, 2026 - 2,066

County Jail Back-up Fiscal Year Average as of February 28, 2026 - 1,814

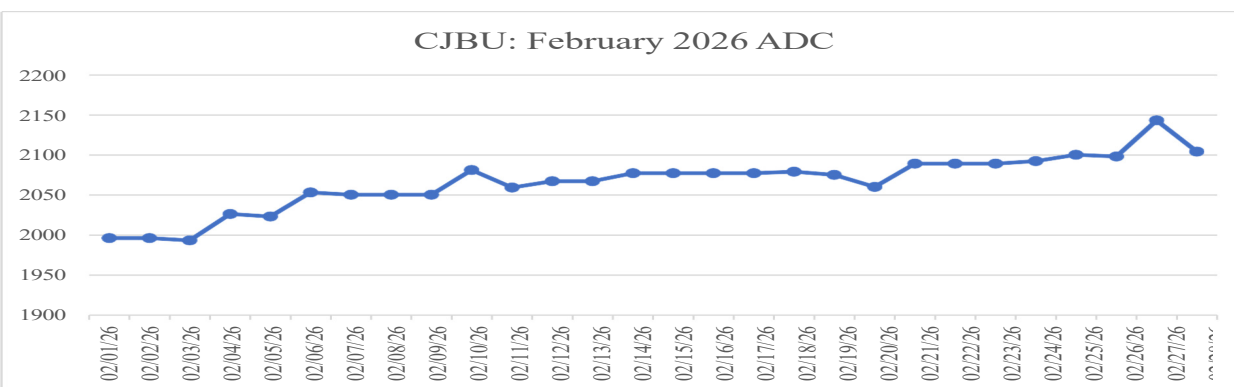
Short-Term Revocation Program Average for February, 2026 - 33

Short-Term Revocation Fiscal Year Average as of February 28, 2026 - 112

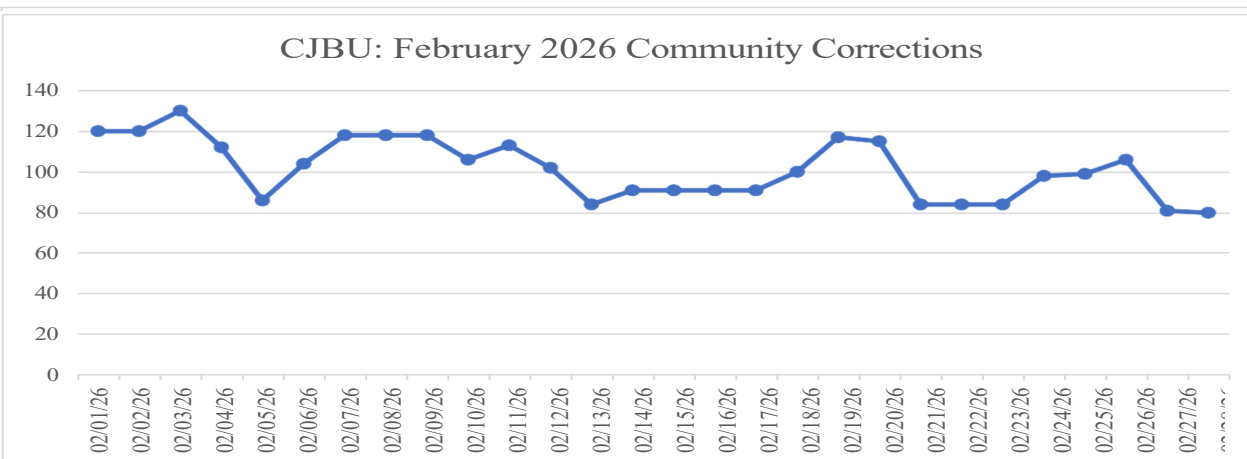
COUNTY JAIL BACKUP - JANUARY 2026

ORAS Prison Intake Tool (PIT) Assessments

Per Act 769, every incarcerated individual must be assessed by January 1, 2027. Therefore, the Quality Improvement and Program Evaluation (QI/PE) team has been organizing mass assessments throughout ADC. As of March 1, 2026, the QI/PE team and ACC- and ADC-ORAS certified staff have assessed 7,614 individuals.

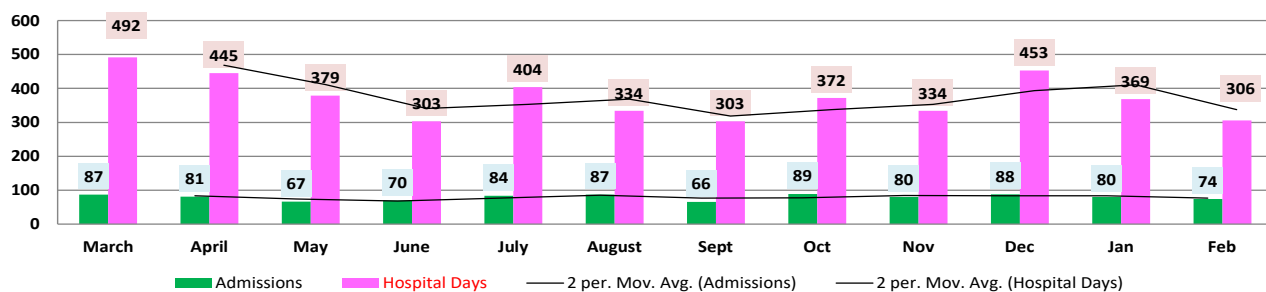

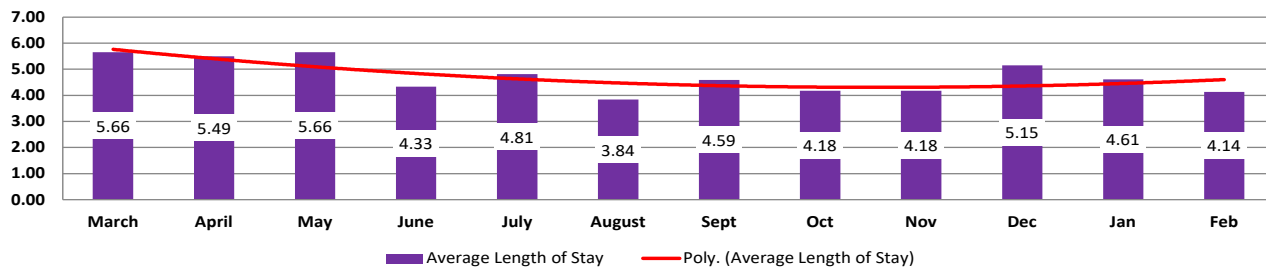

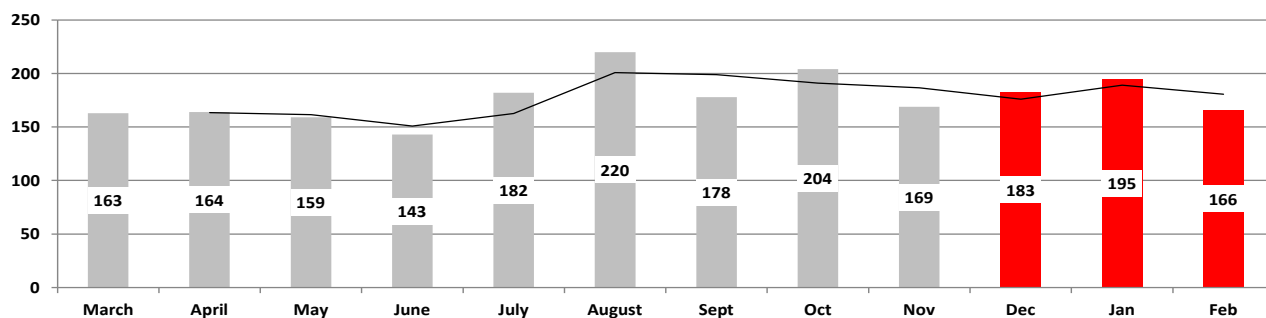
ADC Admissions & Hospital Days

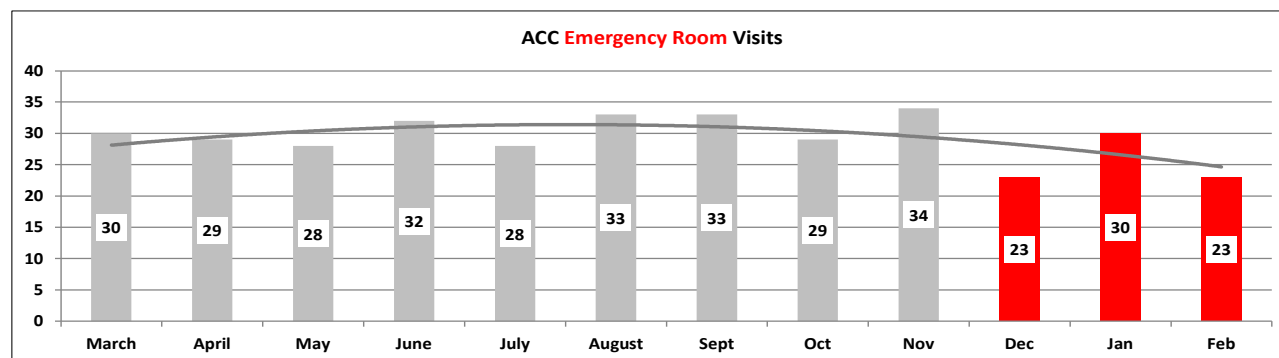
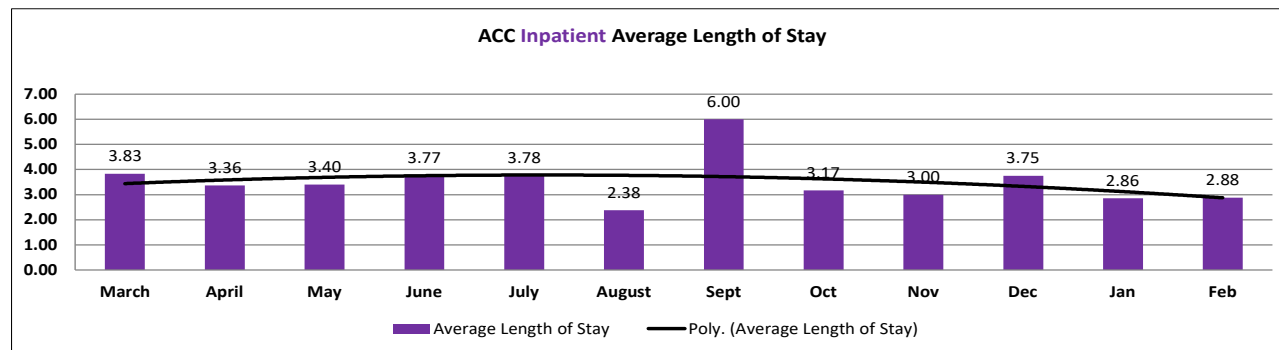
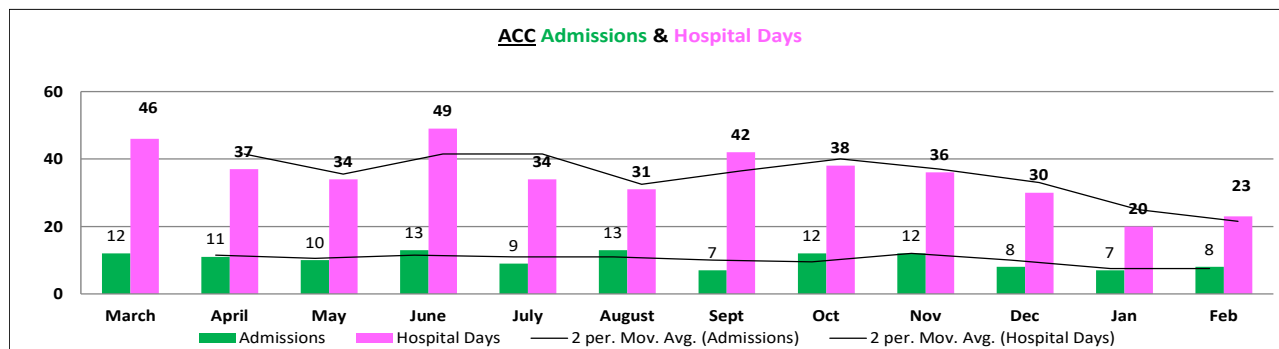
