Preparing for Election Day: Information for Pulaski County Voters

Polls open from 7:30 a.m.-7:30 p.m. on Election Day.

(PULASKI, ARK.) – As election day approaches tomorrow, March 3, 2026, for the Preferential Primary Election, the Pulaski County Clerk’s office shares some important voting information for registered voters.

“We’ve seen over 32,000 voters cast ballots in the Primary Election and nearly 3,700 in the Special General Election for House District 70. We thank every voter in Pulaski County who has already made their voice heard, but we need to show up strong and continue that momentum on Election Day,” said Clerk Terri Hollingsworth. “Every ballot truly makes a difference.”

ELECTION DAY

Polls will be open from 7:30 a.m. until 7:30 p.m. at all 93 locations in the County. Eligible voters must vote at their assigned polling location. Address changes within Pulaski County can be made at the polls, and for county-to-county transfers, but be mindful that the change may affect the voting location.

Important reminder: For those in District 70, you will vote in TWO elections, the Preferential Primary Election and the Special Election for District 70. You will check in *TWO* times at the polls and get *ONE* ballot for each check-in.

ABSENTEE VOTING

All mailed-in absentee ballots must be received by the county clerk by **7:30 p.m.** on Tuesday, March 3. Voters are encouraged to drop off their ballots at the main United States Post Office at 600 E Capitol Ave, Little Rock, AR.



ELECTION DAY NEW POLLING LOCATIONS

Several changes have been made to polling locations. The election commission has selected 93 polling locations in Pulaski County: 54 in Little Rock, 17 in North Little Rock, seven in Jacksonville, seven in Sherwood, three in Maumelle, two in Roland, and one each in Mabelvale, Wrightsville, and Scott. Be sure to check the Arkansas Secretary of State's Voter View website for the correct polling location for Election Day.
