RESTORING VOTING RIGHTS

Arkansas law affords persons convicted of a felony the unique opportunity to have their voting rights restored under certain conditions.

Ark. Code Ann. Amend. 51 §11(d)(2)(A-D)

STEPS TO RESTORING VOTING RIGHTS

- 1: Obtain proof from the appropriate state or local agencies that all of the requirements have been completed **OR** proof that the record has been sealed.
- 2: Submit proof to the Voter Registration Department of the county clerk's office where the returning citizen now resides.
- 3: Complete an Arkansas Voter Registration Application and return it to the Voter Registration Department of the county clerk's office.



PROVIDE TO THE COUNTY CLERK

- discharged from probation or parole;
- paid all probation or parole fees;
- satisfied all terms of imprisonment;
- paid all applicable court costs, fines, or restitution
